LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn overcame a pair of deficits to snatch a 3-2, 11-inning victory over Wilmington on Saturday... LF **Alex Ramírez** provided the walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 11th... 1B **Joe Suozzi** collected a pair of game-tying singles in the 8th and 10th... RHP **Jordan Geber** hurled the 'Clones first quality start of the year, tallying 6.0 innings of 1-run ball... RHP **Wilkin Ramos** and RHP **Manny Rodríguez** did not allow an earned run (1 total) and punched out 8 in 5.0 combined innings in relief.

WASHED AWAY: The Cyclones endured their first postponement of the 2023 season on Sunday afternoon due to wet grounds... It was Brooklyn's first postponed game since September 10, 2022, at Winston-Salem... It was the first for the Cyclones at home since May 20, 2022, vs. Hudson Valley... Brooklyn and Wilmington will make up the game as part of a doubleheader during their series at Frawley Stadium from May 9-14.

WIZARD OF SUOZZ: OF **Joe Suozzi** extended his season-best hitting streak to 4 games with a 2-for-4 performance on Saturday vs. Wilmington... During the stretch, the 25-year-old is 6-for-16 (.375) with a double and 3 RBI... Suozzi has recorded consecutive multi-hit games and has picked up at least 1 RBI in each of those affairs... The Glen Cove, N.Y. enters Tuesday 3rd on the team in batting average (.267) and tied for 3rd in hits (12).

IT'S A WALK OFF: Brooklyn garnered their 2nd walk-off victory of 2023 on Saturday afternoon... The Cyclones erased a pair of deficits to win it on LF **Alex Ramírez's** RBI single in the 11th... Brooklyn also won in walk-off fashion on Opening Day (April 7) on a bases-loaded RBI walk by 1B **Chase Estep**... Last season, Brooklyn had 4 walk-off victories at Maimonides Park.

THUNDERBOLT: The Cyclones have been active on the base paths to start the 2023 season... Coming to Tuesday, Brooklyn poses 2 of the South Atlantic League leaders in stolen bags... OF **Omar De Los Santos** is tied with Hudson Valley's **Caleb Durbin** for the league-lead with 9... IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is currently tied for 3rd with 8... More importantly, both are a combined 17-for-17 on attempts... While the 'Clones are only 10th in the league with 25 team stolen bases, the squad is 2nd in success rate (.893)... Only Hudson Valley (.927) has been more successful.

A-RAM A-HERO: OF **Alex Ramírez** extended his team season-long hitting streak to 9 with a walk-off RBI single in the 11th on Saturday... The stretch is also good for the second-longest active streak in the SAL... The 20-year-old is 13-for-his-last-38 (.342) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 9 RBI, 3 walks, and 2 stolen bases... Since the start of last season, Ramírez leads all Mets' minor leaguers in batting average (.281) and is tied with teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** for the lead in triples (7)... He is also tied with former Cyclone INF **Ronny Mauricio** for the most doubles (33)... Ramírez is 2nd in on-base percentage (.343) and hits (156), 3rd in OPS (.774), slugging (.431) and total bases (239), and tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (52).

GO DJ: LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023... In his first 5 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 1-0 record with 1 save... He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and a walk, striking out 11... In 10 regular season appearances with the

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game set against the Phillies' High-A affiliate... The BlueClaws claim 2 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*... INF **Hao Yu Lee** comes in at No. 6, while RHP **Tommy McCollum** is deemed the 29th-best farmhand... The Cyclones captured 2-of-3 from Jersey Shore at Maimonides Park from April 7-9... Brooklyn dominated the 2022 season series, winning 22-of-27 meetings... The Cyclones went 12-3 in 15 games at ShoreTown Ballpark last season.

'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 10.1 innings... The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 18-straight appearances dating back to last year... Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach... Since then, he is 3-0 with 8 hits allowed, 10 walks, and 26 strikeouts in 20.2 innings.

BER-BEST-I: INF **César Berbesi** has bounced back from an injury-plagued 2022 in style... The 23-year-old has reached base in each of his first 8 games in 2023... Berbesi is 10-for-26 (.385) at the plate with 10 runs scored, a double, a triple, and 4 RBI... If he had enough plate appearances to qualify, Berbesi would enter Tuesday's game 2nd in the SAL in on-base percentage (.568)... He would also be tied for 2nd in batting average (.385) and 9th in OPS (1.068)... Berbesi has walked 76 times compared to only 84 strikeouts in 104 career games.

SUPER STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** was named South Atlantic League Player of the Week for Week 2 (April 10-16)... During that week's series in Winston-Salem, Consuegra was 9-for-24 (.375) with 2 doubles, 3 home runs, and 10 RBI... Consuegra enters Tuesday's series opener on a 9-game on-base streak dated back to April 12... Since then, the right-handed swinger is slashing .343/.425/.743 with a stellar 1.168 OPS... Consuegra has 7 extra-base hits, 3 home runs, and 10 RBI in that span... He is tied for 2nd in the league in extra-base hits (8), tied for 3rd in homers (3), and 5th in total bases (29).

ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL: Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball... The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)... Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022... Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19... The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)... Including 2023, holds a career record of 108-100 (.519).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*... They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)... OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision last Sunday at Winston-Salem...Did not allow a run on 1 hit over 2.0 innings...Struck out 4 without permitting a walk...Tossed 28 pitches (21 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Jordan Geber** to start the bottom of the 3rd with Brooklyn leading, 1-0...Winston-Salem scored 3 in the 7th and 4 in the 8th and defeated the Cyclones, 10-4.

TOP PROSPECT: Tidwell enters the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' top pitching prospect per MLB Pipeline...Comes at No. 7 overall on the Top 30 list... The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 9 overall farmhand by *Baseball America*...Only RHP **Kodai Senga** is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list... Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

2022: Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27... Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16... Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts...Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League play-offs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

VOLUNTEER SERVICE: Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game.

LORETTO LIGHTNING: Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent...At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 first-round pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP **Ryan Weathers**...Ryan's father, **David**, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.
