RIDERS SECURE SWEEP OF CORPUS CHRISTI BEHIND DOMINANT ARMS:

On a soaked Saturday at Whataburger Field, the Frisco RoughRiders sunk the Corpus Christi Hooks 1-0 to secure a series sweep and the franchise's first 3-0 start in five seasons. Frisco (3-0) starter **David Davaillo** set the tone. Davaillo, Texas' 2025 Nolan Ryan Minor League Pitcher of the Year, started his 2026 season with 5.1 dominant, shutout frames. He allowed only four hits – all singles – and struck out seven while walking two. After surrendering 26 hits and 15 runs over the first two games to Frisco, Corpus Christi (0-3) got a strong start from righty **Brett Gillis**, who tossed four scoreless innings with five strikeouts. The offense did not spark up until the eighth inning for the Riders, when **Frainyer Chavez** and **Dylan Dreiling** both singled off of **Nic Swanson** (0-1). **Keyber Rodriguez** then rolled a single of his own through the right side of the infield, collecting his third hit of the night and delivering the game's first lead to Frisco, 1-0. After the RoughRiders stranded the bases loaded with nobody out, **Ricardo Velez** and **Janser Lara** ensured one run would be enough with scoreless eighth and ninth innings respectively. Velez (1-0) nabbed the win with two innings in relief, as Lara logged his first save. It was Frisco's first 1-0 win since September 7th, 2024 at Wichita.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through three games the RoughRiders are first in Double-A with 34 hits and second in all of Double-A, High-A and Low-A. Among teams with at least three games played, they are leading all of Double-A in batting average (.298) and sixth in runs (16). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Their 34 hits are the most in the first three games in recorded franchise history (since 2005), breaking the record of 31 in 2008 and 2017. Their 15 runs scored are also tied for the fifth-most in franchise history (since 2005) through the first three games of a season. **Tucker Mitchell** and **Keyber Rodriguez** have both tied the franchise record for most hits through the first three games of a season with six, a mark which is also tied for the Double-A lead. The franchise record for most hits through four games is eight.

QUITE THE START:

Frisco starter **Leandro Lopez** poured in 4.2 no-hit innings on Thursday night, **Dylan MacLean** followed with 5.0 innings, allowing one run in his Double-A debut on Friday and **David Davaillo** tossed 5.1 innings of shutout baseball on Saturday. Frisco's overall 0.67 ERA through three games is tied for the best mark in Double-A and Minor League Baseball among teams with at least three games played, while they are third in hits allowed (14) and first in WHIP (0.93) in the minors. They are also the only team in the minors to not allow an extra-base hit through three games. Since 2005, their 0.67 ERA is the second-best in the Texas League through three games, trailing only 2016 Corpus Christi (0.00 ERA through three games) and it is the best in franchise history. Among starting pitching staffs with at least 11.0 innings through three games, they lead all of MiLB with a 0.60 ERA (15.0 IP/1 ER).

SWEEP IN THE SPARKLING CITY:

The Riders swept Corpus Christi over the opening weekend to start 3-0 for the first time since 2021 and the fourth time in franchise history (2026, 2021, 2016 and 2008). The longest winning streak to start a season in franchise history is five games, in both 2016 and 2008. The sweep was Frisco's first brooming since they swept a six-game series against Amarillo from June 11th-16th, 2024.

MONSTER INNING:

On Friday at Corpus, the Riders scored 10 runs in the fifth inning, tying the second-biggest output in a single inning in franchise history. It was the second time the Riders had scored 10 in an inning at Corpus Christi (May 8th, 2008) and came up one run shy of the franchise record of 11 at Amarillo on September 2nd, 2022. In the inning, **Dylan Dreiling** became the third player in franchise history to knock in four runs in a frame without a grand slam, belting a three-run home run and an RBI single. He joined **Trevor Hauver** (solo HR, three-run triple) in 2023 and **Casey Benjamin** (two-run double, two-run single) in 2007.

SOUTHERN SUCCESS:

Since 2021, the Riders have been very good against their South Division opponents, going 253-185 (.578) against their division teams. The only problem is that they have gone just 55-53 against Midland while they went a combined 197-132 (.599) against Corpus Christi, Amarillo and San Antonio.

CLASS OF THE LEAGUE:

Since 2021, the RoughRiders have been the best team in the Texas League. Over the last six seasons, Frisco has a 362-308 (.540) record. Their .540 winning percentage is the top mark in the Texas League and the fifth-best in Double-A during that span. Somerser (Yankees affiliate) has the best record in Double-A, going 388-281 (.580) in that stretch. On the opposite end, Corpus Christi has had the worst winning percentage in the Texas League over the last six years, going 287-383 (.428), the third-worst in Double-A.

FAMILIAR AND NEW FACES IN FRISCO:

The RoughRiders welcome 16 returning players in 2026, but will have just three players on the roster (infielder **John Taylor**, outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** and RHP **Dylan MacLean**) made their Double-A debut in the season-opening series. Of the 28, 10 players made their Rangers organization debut with the RoughRiders in Corpus Christi.

-Mills Godwin High School in Virginia, where he helped guide the Eagles to a VHSL state finals berth during his 2019 junior season. Same high school as former RoughRiders pitcher and current Major Leaguer **Reed Garrett**.

-College of Southern Idaho. Was named Region 18 Pitcher of the year and NJCAA All-American after leading the country with 16.0 K/9. His junior season, he went 8-3 with a 2.04 ERA and set single-season record with 118 K at CSI over his 66.1 IP.

-Before being drafted by the Rangers, he was committed to transfer to Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) for baseball.

-Enjoys fishing, playing basketball and eating sushi in his free time.

2026 SEASON

-No. 23 prospect in the Rangers organization.

-Made one relief appearance on Friday, 4/3 before starting the home opener on 4/7.

2025 SEASON

-Dominated for High-A Hub City, owning a 1.15 ERA over 15 outings.

-Among those who threw at least 50 innings in the South Atlantic League, he led the league in ERA (1.15) and batting average against (.147), while he was third in strikeout rate (33.6%), second in WHIP (0.84), and second in LOB rate (82.3%).

-As a starting pitcher with Hub City, he went 0-2 with a 0.74 ERA over nine starts while holding opponents to a .128 batting average. As a reliever, he owned a 2.00 ERA in six appearances.

-In his last nine games (six starts) with Hub City, he owned a 0.83 ERA, striking out 48 to 12 walks in 32.2 innings while allowing just a .118 batting average.

2024 SEASON

-Spent all season with Low-A Down East Wood Ducks as a swingman. As a starter, owned 7.01 ERA while he garnered a 3.00 ERA as a reliever.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

PITCHING COACH



THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH



JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

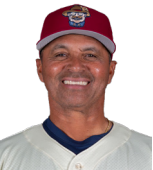
Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

BENCH COACH



JORGE HERNANDEZ

Pronounced "George"

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

DEVELOPMENT COACH



JAY SULLENGER

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

ATHLETIC TRAINER



KILEY BROWN

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).

BRETT PLATTS

Platts is back with the RoughRiders for his third season and his fourth in the Rangers organization in 2026.

In his first year, he was the strength and conditioning coach for the Low-A Down East Wood Ducks before spending a season with the Cubs, working in the Dominican Summer League. The Canadian completed his strength and conditioning internship with the University of Iowa athletic department in 2022 and spent four years with the Okotoks Dawgs Baseball Academy from 2019 through 2022.
