FINDING A WAY ON BASE: INF Michael Massey has extended his on-base streak to 20 games yesterday with three hits. Massey joins INF Ryan McBroom as the only Storm Chasers to eclipse the 20-game on-base benchmark in the last two seasons. During the streak, the University of Illinois product holds an on-base percentage of .421 that he pairs with a .692 slugging percentage. Massey has had six homers and eight doubles during the streak that began on June 16 against lowa.

DYNAMIC DAIRON: OF Dairon Blanco is riding a 12-game hit streak that started on May 15. The streak is tied for the longest active streak in the International League with Kevin Newman from Indianapolis holding the other 12-game active hit streak. Blanco is one game shy of matching **INF Michael Massey's** 13-game hit streak that was snapped on Sunday against St. Paul. Blanco's 12-game on-base streak is tied for the 10th longest active streak in the league with Toledo's Akil Baddoo being one of the three other players tied with Blanco. The Cuban native has also stolen 18 bases, the sixth most in the International League, getting caught just twice this season.

WINNING STREAK: Omaha has started their series with Toledo by winning the first four games. That ties the longest winning streak by the Storm Chasers this season, with the last time happening when Omaha started 4-0 in their mid-May series against St. Paul. This week, Omaha has launched 12 home runs, failing to hit a dinger in just one of the four games. Omaha broke a modern franchise (dating back to 2005) record on Monday by hitting nine home runs in a single game. The four wins to start the series also clinches the series win for the Storm Chasers who last outright won a series against Indianapolis when they took 3-of-5. Omaha is hitting .417 this series and is averaging 8.25 runs per game. The Storm Chasers' pitching holds an overall ERA of 3.52 this week while the bullpen has allowed just two earned runs for a 1.64 ERA.

CASTILLO POWER: INF Iván Castillo has recorded an extra-base hit and an RBI in each of the last three games. Both of those streaks are third longest active streak in the International League with Castillo the only player to be in the top three on both lists. During the streak, Castillo is hitting .667 with four doubles and one home run. With an extra-base hit and an RBI tonight, Castillo would tie the longest such streaks by a Chaser this season.

SCORELESS: RHP Ándres Núñez tossed 0.2 scoreless innings last night and is now tied with RHP Colten Brewer for the longest active streak of games not allowing an earned run in the International League at 17 games. Núñez has thrown 19.2 innings since last allowing an earned run, now just one out behind RHP Brad Peacock's 20.0-inning streak for longest on the team this season.

FOR OMAHA: LHP Drew Parrish toes the rubber for the Chasers today, making his sixth start for Triple-A Omaha after being transferred from Double-A Northwest Arkansas in early June. Parrish is coming off back-to-back games in which he tied a career-high seven hits against St. Paul. The first game was a quality start in which he won and the second was a loss. Parrish has three quality starts between the two levels this year, going 3-0 in those starts. The 24-year-old was drafted by the Royals in 2019, out of Florida State, making it to Triple-A in his third professional season.

FOR TOLEDO: RHP Elvin Rodriguez gets the ball to make his 10th start for the Mud Hen and 11th overall appearance. Rodriguez went 4.0 innings in his last start, allowing three earned runs on seven hits with four strikeouts. Despite having three wins this season, Rodriguez has yet to throw a quality start. His longest outing of the season was a 5.1-inning start on June 22. Rodriguez made an appearance against Omaha at the end of April, allowing 3 earned runs in 1.2 innings out of the bullpen. Rodriguez has appeared in five games in The Show this season, making four starts for the Tigers with an ERA of 11.51. The 24-year-old was signed as an international free agent by the Los Angeles Angels in July of 2014 and was traded to Detroit in September of 2017. Rodriguez had his contract purchased by the Tigers after the 2021 season, making Detroit's Opening Day roster this year before making his MLB debut on April 10.
