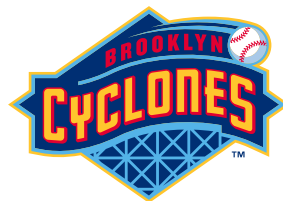

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn blanked Aberdeen on Saturday night, 5-0...RHP **Blade Tidwell** tossed a career-high 7.0 innings of 3-hit, shutout baseball, earning his 3rd win and 1st career quality start...The 22-year-old walked 2 and struck out 6...RHP **Dylan Tebrake** yielded 1 hit over 2.0 innings to close out the 4-hitter...C **Drake Osborn** powered a pair of home runs and drove in 4 as part of a 3-hit night...The Corpus Christi, Texas native hammered a solo home run to leadoff the 6th to break up a no-hit bid...Osborn added a 2-run single in the 7th and another solo blast in the 9th...RHP **Alex Pham** permitted just 1 hit over a team-season-high 6.0 innings, striking out 9 for Aberdeen...He took his 3rd defeat.

LOVE THE DRAKE! C **Drake Osborn** posted a career-best performance in Saturday's win at Aberdeen...The 24-year-old tallied a professional-high-tying 3 hits and collected his 1st career multi-home run game...Osborn added a season-best 4 RBI, as well...His 1st 3-hit night came on April 30, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie vs. Daytona...The multi-home run performance was the first by a Cyclone since RF **Alex Ramirez** blasted two long balls on July 31, 2022, at Hudson Valley...Osborn is the first 'Clone to record 2+ home runs, 3+ hits, and 4+ RBI in a single game since DH **Brett Baty** (3/4, 2 HR, 4 RBI) accomplished the feat on June 3, 2021, at Jersey Shore...Each of Osborn's last 3 hits have been home runs and 4 of his last 5 have left the ballpark, as well...He holds a 130 wRC+ and .419 ISO since being reinstated from the injured list on June 2...Osborn is tied for the team lead in home runs with 6...This is despite having 40 fewer plate appearances than INF **Mateo Gil** (6 HR/127 PA), 60 fewer than OF **Stanley Consuegra** (5 HR/147 PA), and 150 fewer than OF **Alex Ramirez** (5 HR/237 PA).

BLADE RUNNER: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old registered a career-high 7.0 innings of shutout ball, earning the win on Saturday night at Aberdeen...Tidwell is the first Cyclone to post 7+ innings in a shutout victory since RHP **Jeffrey Colón** did the same in a 3-0 win at Winston-Salem on September 9, 2022...He tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts in his previous start last Sunday vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 6 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 3-0 with a 1.32 ERA (4 ER in 27.1 IP) with just 13 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 22 and struck out 39 (12.84 K/9)...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 34.2% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .141 batting average (13-92) against him...Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (.141) and is tied for 2nd in ERA (1.32) since that date (min. 25.0 IP)...He is also tied for 4th in strikeouts (39).

DINKY DONUTS: RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7.0 IP) and RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (2.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout in Brooklyn's 5-0 win at Aberdeen on Saturday night...That marked the Cyclones' 1st donut of an opponent since an 8-0 victory at Jersey Shore on May 30...Tidwell (3.2 IP) also started that night...RHP **Jace Beck** (2.1), RHP **Brendan Hardy** (1.2), RHP **Michael Krausz** (0.1), and RHP **Joshua Cornielli** (1.0) also united on a 5-hit blanking of the BlueClaws...The 'Clones have accumulated 5 shutouts through the first 61 games of 2023...Brooklyn pitching tallied 7 shutouts throughout the entirety of the 2022 campaign.

DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 9 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 1.23 ERA (2 ER in 14.2 IP) on 5 hits and 6 walks, registering 24 strikeouts (14.73 K/9)...That equates to a 42.9 K% (24/56).

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.26) in the entire South Atlantic League and 2nd-best among all High-A teams...The Twins' High-A Cedar Rapids leads (3.16) lead the classification...Hudson Valley (3.29) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 4th best in all of MiLB...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (3.06).

TY-NAMIC: RHP **Tyler Stuart** tossed 6.0 innings of 1-run ball on Friday night and is as imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.47)...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (88.2%) and FIP (2.90), 5th in xFIP (3.38), 6th in strikeouts per 9 innings (10.96), 8th in batting average against (.218) and strikeout rate (30.0%), and 9th in WHIP (1.15) and innings pitched (55.0).

OH YEAH, OMAR: OF **Omar De Los Santos** has picked up steam at the plate in June...The 23-year-old tallied a season-high-tying 3 hits in Wednesday's win over the IronBirds and added 2 more knocks on Thursday...Omar is 7-for-19 (.368) in the series with 2 extra-base hits and 3 RBI...Since the beginning of the month, De Los Santos is batting .300 (18-60) with 9 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 9 RBI, and 7 stolen bases...The right-handed swinger is tied for 4th in the SAL in stolen bases (7) and 5th in hits (18) during June...Additionally, De Los Santos has added 25 stolen bases in 2022 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 95 stolen bases in that span, which is 6th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (103), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (99), Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (97), Mariners prospect OF **Jonathan Clase** (96), and D'Backs prospect of **Wilderd Patiño** (96) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 55 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 40...Omar is already 7 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

HAIL CÉSAR: INF **César Berbesi** enters Saturday's contest on a roll offensively...The 23-year-old has picked up a base-hit in 4-straight ballgames (6-for-12) and is slashing .389/.476/.667 in his last 6 games dating back to last Saturday's doubleheader vs. Greenville...In 11 contests during the month of June, Berbesi is 11-for-33 (.333) with the bat, tallying 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, a home run, 4 RBI, 4 walks, and 4 stolen bases.

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn hits the road to begin a 6-game road trip against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds posses 7 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: SS **Jackson Holliday** (1), OF **Jud Fabian** (13), 3B **Max Wagner** (14), OF **Dylan Beavers** (19), C **Creed Willems** (21), RHP **Trace Bright** (27), and RHP **Jean Pinto** (28)...Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Leidos Field at Ripken Stadium for the first time since the 2022 SAL Postseason...Aberdeen won both postseason contests at home to defeat Brooklyn, 2-1, in a Best-of-3 series from September 13-16...In 2023, the IronBirds and Cyclones have split the first 6 games of the season series...Both teams won 3 contests in their matchup at Maimonides Park from May 2-7.

D'ANDRE DELIVERS: 2B **D'Andre Smith** set a career-high with 4 hits in Brooklyn's victory over Aberdeen on Wednesday...The 22-year-old also added 2 RBI and 2 stolen bases in the win...Since being reinstated from the injured list before last week's series vs. Greenville, Smith is 11-for-29 (.379) at the plate in 8 games...The former USC Trojan has added a double, 3 RBI, a walk, and 3 stolen bases...Smith has also registered at least 1 hit in 6-of-his-7 games played.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: DH **Kevin Parada** delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenville...C **José Mena**'s added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...LB **Chase Estep** delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF **Alex Ramirez** registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF **Omar De Los Santos** provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...In addition to 5 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after Friday's loss at Aberdeen...23.0% (14-of-61) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion and 39.3% (24-of-61) have been determined by just 1 run, including 6 of the team's last 7 affairs.

POWER OF PAUL: RHP **Paul Gervase** garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on Friday evening vs. Greenville and added another 2 more scoreless frames out of the bullpen at Aberdeen on Tuesday and Thursday...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 20.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase ranks 2nd in ERA (1.35)...Only Rome's RHP **Luis Vargas** (1.11) has registered a better ERA in relief this season...Gervase averages 13.84 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 33.9% strikeout rate.

WILKIN'S WAY: RHP **Wilkin Ramos** has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2023...The 22-year-old tossed 3.2 innings of spotless work on Thursday night at Aberdeen...Over his last 2 outings, Ramos has not permitted a run over 6.2 innings, allowing only 3 hits and 1 walk, striking out 7...For the season, the right-hander is averaging 10.58 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 29.2% strikeout rate with a 10.0% walk rate.

CROWN PRINCE OF CONEY ISLAND: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Sunday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (195), at-bats (639), plate appearances (765), runs scored (98), walks (105), and stolen bases (47)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (67) on May 23 and is 2 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (197), 4th in home runs (16), and tied for 4th in hits (116).

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP **Jeffrey Colón** did not receive a decision after permitting 1 earned run (2 total) over 4.1 innings on Thursday at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 5 appearances (4 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 1.96 ERA (5 ER in 23.0 IP), allowing 17 hits and 10 walks, striking out 24...In his last 3 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 18.2 innings, allowing 6 runs (4 earned) on 13 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 1.93 ERA and permitted only 6 walks and punched out 20 in that span.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Monday...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2), OF **Alex Ramirez** (5), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (15), RHP **Christian Scott** (16), and RHP **Tyler Stuart** (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), RHP **Mike Vasil** (4), OF **Matt Rudick** (13), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (14), RHP **Junior Santos** (19), RHP **José Butto** (23), RHP **Luis Montas** (24), OF **Rowdy Jordan** (25), and RHP **Matt Allan** (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: After dropping Saturday's twinbill to Greenville, Brooklyn dropped to 1-9 in doubleheader games in 2023...4-of-5 doubleheaders Brooklyn has played have been in visiting ballparks...This year, the 'Clones are 25-26 in regularly scheduled 9-inning games.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision on Tuesday night at Aberdeen...Permitted 3 runs on 3 hits over 4.0-plus innings...Walked a career-high 6 and struck out 2...Tossed 87 pitches and 48 strikes (55.1%)...Relieved by RHP **Paul Ger-vase** with a man at 2nd and 2 out in the bottom of the 5th and the game tied at 2...Bequeathed runner scored...The IronBirds went on to defeat the Cyclones, 8-7, on a walk-off wild pitch.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Despite Maimonides Park’s pitcher-friendly tendencies, Foster has faired slightly better away from Coney Island in 2023...The 24-year-old holds an 1-2 mark, but a 4.74 ERA (16 ER in 30.1 IP) with 16 walks and 27 strikeouts in 7 road starts...At home, Foster is 1-2 with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER in 15.2 IP), 9 walks, and 15 strikeouts.

2022: Composed a 4-2 record with a 1.86 ERA (13 ER in 63.0 IP), 12 saves, and 84 strikeouts in 29 appearances at McNeese State University...Named Southland Conference Reliever of the Year...Recognized on the All-Southland Conference First Team...Selected by the New York Mets in the 14th round...Signed on August 1 for \$40,000...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets, but did not pitch.

START ME UP: Foster is slated to make the 9th start of his season and pro career on Thursday night...The 24-year-old did not start at McNeese State in 2022 and only made 4 total over 3 seasons...During 2 campaigns at Wharton (Texas) County Junior College registered just 8 starts in 23 appearances...Prior to this season, his last official start came on February 28, 2021, for McNeese State vs. Prairie View A&M University.
