The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series tonight against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is the 16th-of-17 matchups between the teams this season and 11th-of-12 at FirstEnergy Stadium. The Rumble Ponies hold a 10-5 edge in the season-series after taking four-of-six from Reading in April at FirstEnergy Stadium and three-of-five from the R-Phils in May at Mirabito Stadium.

Game 92 Recap

The Fightin Phils dropped their third-straight game in a high-scoring affair on Friday night, falling 12-9. After the Rumble Ponies scored two runs in the top of the second, the Fightin Phils responded with two runs of their own in the bottom of the second, with one coming on a RBI single from Alex Binelas. After Brighamton went down quietly in the top of the third, Felix Reyes launched a two-run home run to right field, his ninth of the season, to put the R-Phils up 4-2 From there, Binghamton pounced on Reading for 10-unanswered runs over the fourth and fifth inning. Chuck King lasted just three-plus innings on the night, allowing five runs on six hits, with five walks and two strikeouts. Gunner Mayer followed with three runs over an inning, and Jaydenn Estenista surrendered four runs (three-earned) acorss an inning of work. With Reading down 12-4 after five innings, the bullpen was able to keep the Rumble Ponies bats quiet the rest of the way. Nelson Alvarez tossed two-shutout innings, with three strikeouts and Jack Dallas followed with two-scoreless and hitless frames. Reading scored three runs in the sixth and two in the seventh to make it 12-9. Dylan Campbell launched his third home run of the season, a two-run shot in the seventh. But, Felipe De La Cruz and Anthony Nunez combined to keep Reading off the board in the final-two innings to secure Binghamton's third win of the week.

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller is alone in first in the Eastern League with 37 stolen bases on the season. Miller also ranks first in the Phillies minor leagues with his 37 stolen bases on the season. Thursday was the ninth time this season that Miller had two stolen bases in a game. After his 37th stolen base on Thursday, Miller has stolen the most bases in a season by a R-Phil since Quintin Berry stole 48 in 2009. The last Fightin Phil to steal 30+ in a season was Johan Rojas in 2023 and the last to swipe 31 or more in a year was Roman Quinn in 2016.

Mashing McIntosh

Paul McIntosh stayed red-hot at the plate two hits on Thursday. The catcher is on an 10-game hitting streak dating back to July 3 and is slashing .486/.550/.743 (1.293 OPS), with six doubles, one home run and six RBI over the streak. He's also currently riding a 14-game on-base streak, dating back to June 21, and has a .545 on-base percentage over that stretch. His 10-game on-base streak is the third-longest active hitting streak in the Eastern League and his 14-game on-base streak is tied for the fourth-longest active on-base streak in the league.

Hendry Keeps Hitting

Hendry Mendez is currently riding a season-best six-game hitting streak, dating back to July 12. Over the streak, Mendez is slashing .474/.565/.632 (1.197 OPS) with just two strikeouts over 19 at bats. Mendez enters play tonight holding the following Eastern League rankings: 3rd AVG (.291), 5th OBP (.373), 9th OPS (.806) and 8th hits (82). Amongst all Phillies Minor Leaguers, Mendez is 4th in AVG (.291), 8th RBI (42), 4th OBP (.373), 5th SLG (.433), 6th OPS (.806), 5th hits (82), T-2nd 3B (3) and 8th in total bases (122).

After turning two-more double plays on Friday night, the Fighitn Phils are tied for first in the Eastern League with Richmond with five doubles play turned so far on the week. Reading entered the series last in the league in double plays turned this season and are now tied for 10th in the league entering today.

Ponies Rumbling Into Baseballtown

Binghamton enters play today with a 62-30 overall record and 17-8 mark in the second half, which is in first place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. The Rumble Ponies captured a first-half championship and qualified for the Eastern League postseason in September. Binghamton took two-of-three games at New Hampshire last weekend and after this week, Binghamton returns home to host Harrisburg. Binghamton's roster features 10 of the New York Mets' top-30 prospects: Jett Williams (1), Jonah Tong (2), Carson Benge (4), Jacob Reimer (6), Ryan Clifford (7), Jonathan Santucci (13), Jack Wenninger (14), Nick Morabito (15), Anthony Nunez (18) and Chris Suero (21).

Ponies Pitcher

Lefty, and Mets' No. 13 prospect, Jonathan Santucci makes his third Double-A start tonight. He start the season with Brooklyn (A+), and between the Cyclones and Binghamton, Santucci is 6-4m with a 3.46 ERA (29 ER, 75.1 IP). Santucci allowed four runs (one earned) over 1.2 innings last time out on Saturday at New Hampshire. He allowed two runs, with eight strikeouts, over six innings in his Double-A debut on July 11 vs Altoona. Santucci is in his first pro season as the 22-year old was drafted by the Mets in the second round in 2024 out of Duke. He pitched for the Blue Devils from 2022-24
