NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- After an 0-4 start to the year, the Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, then went 3-11 from April 22 to May 8 ... Omaha won 10 of 15 from May 9 to 24 but have gone 3-9 in the last 12 games since May 25.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- Omaha has been under .500 following 36 of their last 37 games (since April 24) and the Storm Chasers have spent just 18 days at or above .500.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Storm Chasers have 17 comeback wins this season, tied for the 5th-most in the International League and tied 8th at the Triple-A level.
- Prior to Friday, Omaha's previous 10 wins (from May 13 to June 4) had all been comeback wins (games the team won despite trailing at some point in the game) ... Friday's 11-2 win was the first game the Storm Chasers won without trailing at any point since a 9-0 win on May 10 @ Indianapolis ... Friday was also the first time the Chasers won by more than 2 runs since an 11-3 win on May 21 @ St. Paul.
- On the flip side, Omaha has lost 19 games in which the team led, tied 2nd-most in the league and tied 4th-most in Triple-A ... the Storm Chasers have led at some point in 7 of their last 10 losses, including for the first 8.5 innings on Sunday and by 7 runs for nearly half of that game.
- In the last 27 games (since May 9), Omaha is 13-14 ... they have trailed at some point in 10 of 13 wins and led at some point in 9 of 14 losses, meaning 19 of Omaha's last 27 games have been a comeback win for one of the two teams.

WHAT HAPPENS IN OMAHA...

- This week, the Storm Chasers welcome the Pacific Coast League's Las Vegas Aviators to Werner Park for the first interleague series in the ballpark's history.
- These games mark the first visit to Werner Park by a PCL team since Omaha joined the International League in 2021 ... the last PCL team to play at Werner Park was the Round Rock Express, from August 30 to September 2, 2019.
- This week also marks the first time Las Vegas has played in Omaha since August 10-13, 2019 - during the Aviators' first season affiliated with the Athletics - when Las Vegas took 3 of 4, with Omaha's lone win coming on a **Kelvin Gutiérrez** walk-off single in the 10th inning on August 11 for a 4-3 victory.
- Las Vegas joined the PCL in 1983 and played alongside Omaha in the league from 1998 through 2019 ... this week marks the Aviators' 7th visit to Werner Park ... from 2005 to 2019, the clubs met in one 4-game series per season, alternating home ballparks annually ... while Omaha has not played a regular season game in Las Vegas since 2017, the Chasers did participate in the 2024 Triple-A National Championship Game at Las Vegas Ballpark.
- This is the second straight year the Storm Chasers have participated in Triple-A interleague play and the first of two interleague series on the schedule this season ... Omaha lost 5 of 6 at Salt Lake from May 20-25 last year ... the Chasers return to Salt Lake City July 21-26.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

- Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.
- Omaha's 84.0% success rate (68-for-81) ranks tied 3rd in the IL and tied 5th in Triple-A ... however, the team has the 11th-most steals in the 20-team IL.
- John Rave** leads Omaha in steals (15) ... **Gavin Cross** has 12 steals in as many tries, the 2nd-most steals in the IL without being caught ... **Kameron Misner** has swiped 11 bags, while **Drew Waters** has 6 steals and **Peyton Wilson** has 5.

STREAK HEAT

- 2 of the 3 longest active hitting streaks in the International League are from Omaha hitters, including the league's reigning Player of the Week.
- Kameron Misner** enters today on a 12-game hitting streak ... since May 26, he's hitting .370 (17-for-46) with 3 doubles, 6 homers, 15 RBI and a 1.270 OPS ... he's also reached base in 16 straight games, since May 20.
- Misner was named the IL's Player of the Week for the week of June 1-7, as he went 10-for-24 (.417 average) at the plate in Columbus ... he had 3 doubles and 5 home runs for a Minor League-leading 28 total bases, with 10 RBI and 8 runs scored ... he led Triple-A last week with a 1.167 slugging percentage and 1.648 OPS.
- Abraham Toro** enters today on an 11-game hitting streak ... since May 24, he's hitting .409 (18-for-44) with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 8 RBI and a .992 OPS ... he's also reached base in 15 straight games, since May 20.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- + **Kris Bubic** was a first-time All-Star in **2025** with the Royals, recording a 2.55 ERA that ranked 4th in the American League (min. 20 starts).
- + Named American League Pitcher of the Month for May **2025**, during which he went 3-0 in 5 starts with an AL-best 0.56 ERA (2 ER in 32.1 IP)...it was the 3rd-best ERA in any month in Royals history (min. 5 starts).
- + Was limited to 46.1 regular season innings in the Majors from **2023-24** due to **Tommy John** Surgery... was reinstated from the Injured List on July 6, **2024**, 447 days after he was placed on the IL.
- + Made his Major League debut in **2020**, after recording just 187.1 innings over 36 starts in the minors...according to Royals Hall of Fame Director, **Curt Nelson**, Bubic became the seventh known player in club history (excluding Rule 5 picks) to make the jump from A-ball to the Majors.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- + Recorded 116.1 innings over 20 starts, surpassing his total from **2024**, when he pitched 70.2 innings (Majors and minors) in his return from **Tommy John** Surgery...the 116.1 innings in **2025** were his most since **2022**, when he threw 129.0 innings.
- + Allowed 3 runs or fewer in 16 of his 20 starts and had 6 starts of at least 5.0 scoreless innings.
- + One day after his start on July 26 (Game 2), he was placed on the Injured List with a left rotator cuff strain, ending his season.
- + Despite the injury, he set a career high with 8 wins and made 20 starts, his most since **2022** (27 starts).
- + Had 3 straight starts of 7.0 innings and 1 run or fewer from May 19-June 1, after which he owned a 1.43 ERA (12 ER in 75.1 IP) through 12 starts, which led the Majors and was the best mark through 12 starts of a season in franchise history.
- + Allowed just 6 home runs in 116.1 innings for a 0.46 HR/9, the lowest mark in the Majors (min. 20 starts)... he didn't allow more than 1 HR in any game and had a career-best 32.0-inning homerless streak from May 13-June 24.
- + Despite allowing only 6 HR, 12 of the 38 runs he allowed came via home runs (31.6%).

ADDITIONAL CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- + Bubic missed the 1st 90 games of the **2024** season while rehabbing an injury to his left elbow that required **Tommy John** Surgery in **2023**.

ADDITIONAL CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (CONT.)

- + He made 14 appearances (10 starts) in the minors while rehabbing the injury, and he posted a 3.53 ERA (14 ER in 35.2 IP) with 42 strikeouts and just 13 walks, making stops in the Arizona Complex League (3 starts), Double-A Northwest Arkansas (2 starts) and Triple-A Omaha (9 games, 5 starts).
- + He was reinstated off the Injured List on July 6, 447 days after he was initially placed on the IL, and made his return to a big league mound the next night at Colorado, logging a scoreless 9th inning.
- + Had 39 strikeouts and 5 walks in 30.1 innings for a 7.80 K/BB ratio, 4th best in the Majors (min. 30.0 IP).
- + He issued a walk to **Matt Chapman** with 2 outs in the 9th inning on Sept. 22, marking his 2nd unintentional walk of the season, and the 1st since July 20 vs. the White Sox (**Corey Julks**), snapping a streak of 92 consecutive batters.
- + Earned his 1st career save in his final appearance of the season on Sept. 29 at Atlanta.

ADDITIONAL CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (CONT.)

- + Finished the **2024** season with 30.1 innings pitched and 5 walks, 3 of which were intentional...he became just the third pitcher since 1955 to issue no more than 5 walks in a season—3 of which were intentional—(min. 30.0 IP), joining **Dan Otero** (2018) and **Dick Hall** (1968).
- + Added a slider to his repertoire in **2023** and held opponents to 2-for-14 (.182) with 6 strikeouts on that pitch through 3 starts, after which he underwent **Tommy John Surgery**.
- + In his 2nd start of the season on April 9 at San Francisco, he held the Giants to 2 hits over 6.0 scoreless innings and matched a career best with 9 strikeouts.
- + Bubic in **2022** tied **Daniel Lynch IV** for the team high with 27 starts, and for the second straight year he led the team in double plays induced (19).
- + Had a 13-start stretch from June 4-Aug. 10, **2022** in which he recorded a 3.59 ERA (29 ER in 72.2 IP), before going 0-7 over his next 7 starts.
- + On Aug. 21, **2021** at Wrigley Field, Bubic took a no-hit bid into the 7th inning...after he walked the second batter of the game, he retired the next 17, including 7 strikeouts in a nine-batter span...despite no raindrops falling, the game was interrupted by a 34-minute "rain" delay in the top of the 7th...once play resumed, he issued a walk to the first batter, followed by a 2-run HR.
- + Named Royals Pitcher of the Month for September/October **2021**, posting a 2.20 ERA (8 ER in 32.2 IP) in 6 appearances (5 starts) to mark the best ERA in September/October by a Royal (min. 5 starts) since **Zack Greinke** had a 1.38 ERA (6 ER in 39.0 IP) to end his 2009 **Cy Young** Award-winning season.

MINOR LEAGUE HIGHLIGHTS

- + Led the minor leagues with 185 strikeouts in **2019**, a season in which he was named to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, a Carolina League postseason All-Star and a *Baseball America* High-A All-Star.

MINOR LEAGUE HIGHLIGHTS (CONT.)

- + Named Advanced-A Wilmington Pitcher of the Year in **2019**, going 11-5 with a 2.23 ERA (37 ER in 149.1 IP) in 26 starts, including his time with Low-A Lexington.
- + Additional accolades in **2019** included being named the **Paul Splittorff** Pitcher of the Year, an MiLB.com Organization All-Star and the MiLB.com Fan Choice for Best Starting Pitcher.
- + Pitched back-to-back complete games in **2019**, on Aug. 8 and Aug. 15, including a 1-hit shutout in the latter, with the lone hit coming to begin the 9th inning.
- + Had 7 starts with at least 10 strikeouts in **2019**, including 12 strikeouts with Lexington on April 12.
- + Named a Pioneer League midseason All-Star in **2018**.

POSTSEASON HIGHLIGHTS

- + Bubic made 4 appearances during the **2024** postseason, and pitched in all 3 of Kansas City's wins.
- + Was credited with a hold in each of the Royals 3 wins, but suffered the loss in Game 3 of the ALDS vs. the Yankees, after he allowed a go-ahead, solo HR to **Giancarlo Stanton** in the 8th inning.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- + Kris resides in Cupertino, Calif.
- + Bubic pitches and bats left handed but does everything else right handed.
- + Since **2020**, he's donated proceeds from his Cameo account to Royals Charities (now The Kansas City Royals Foundation) and the Harvester Food Network.
- + Attended Stanford University, where he went 8-1 with a 2.62 ERA (25 ER in 86.0 IP) and 101 strikeouts in 15 starts as a junior in **2018** for the Pac-12 champions... named All-Pac-12 and was one of 40 players named to the Golden Spikes Award midseason Watch List.
- + Majored in communications at Stanford and aspires to one day be a sports color commentator.
- + Graduated from Archbishop Mitty HS (Calif.) in **2015**.
