FRISCO FIGHTS BACK, FALLS IN WALK-OFF FASHION TO MIDLAND:

The Midland RockHounds walked off against the Frisco RoughRiders in a 4-3 game to open the six-game series from Momentum Bank Ballpark on Tuesday afternoon. With the bases loaded in the ninth, Kyle McCann lifted a walk-off sacrifice fly, scoring Devin Foyle, to give Midland the 4-3 victory. The Riders dropped their fourth-straight game in the defeat. **Lucas Jacobsen** (0-1) took the loss, allowing Foyle aboard on a fielder's choice in the ninth inning before **Tai Tiedemann** replaced him and allowed the sacrifice fly in the ninth. The RockHounds found the scoreboard in the bottom of the first against Riders starter **Zak Kent** on an RBI single from Foyle that plated Zack Gelof. Jeremy Eierman then added on with an RBI double to make it 2-0. In the third, Eierman struck again with an RBI single to increase the lead to 3-0. Frisco put up a run in the fifth when **J.P. Martinez** blasted a solo home run, his third of the season, to draw within 3-1. In the eighth, the Riders walked three times to load the bases for **Jonathan Ornelas**, who grounded a ball to short with one out. Eierman was able to field get the first out at second, but Max Schuemann's throw to first was low, allowing both **Ezequiel Duran** and **Blaine Crim** to come in to score and tie the game at 3-3. Jack Wisenburger (1-0) earned the win for Midland.

POWER SURGE:

After the RoughRiders hit just three home runs through their first nine games, they have exploded on the power side over their last seven games. Over those games, the Riders have hit nine home runs and own a .416 slugging percentage as a team. Remarkably, their nine home runs are seventh in the 10-team Texas League over that span with the Tulsa Drillers leading the way with 17 home runs over their last seven games. The Texas League has averaged 14.4 home runs per day total (1.4 home runs per team per day) over the last seven games. Across all of Minor League Baseball in the last seven games, four of the top-11 teams in home runs are in the Texas League (Tulsa, 17, Amarillo, 13, Northwest Arkansas, 13, Midland, 12).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING THROUGH THE QUAD:

The RoughRiders have been extremely streaky to start the 2022 campaign. After going on a seven-game winning streak from April 12th through April 19th, the Riders have now lost four-straight games. In 2021, their longest winning streak was 11 games in late June while their longest losing streak was four games, which they did twice. The 11-game winning streak was the longest winning streak in franchise history while the longest losing streak in franchise history was 13 games back in 2005.

DUSTIN BUSTER:

After starting the season 0-for-8, **Dustin Harris** hit safely in the next 11 games before going 0-for-3 on Tuesday against Midland. Harris hit .366 (15-for-41)/.404/.488/.892 over his streak with a double, a home run and 10 RBIs. The 11-game hitting streak was the second-longest streak in the Texas League, trailing only Zack Gelof of Midland (14 games). Though the hitting streak has ended, Harris is still on a 13-game on-base streak where he owns a .375 on-base percentage. That on-base streak is tied for the fifth-longest active streak in the Texas League. The No. 6 prospect in the Rangers system was the Tom Grieve Ranger Minor League Player of the Year in 2021, hitting .327/.401/.542 with 20 home runs and 25 steals between Low-A Down East and High-A Hickory.

SETH'S RATH:

Riders reliever **Seth Nordlin** was flat out dominant in his outing against Northwest Arkansas on Friday. Nordlin threw four shutout innings, retiring all 12 batters he faced with four strikeouts. After throwing a first-pitch ball on his very first offering, Nordlin threw 22-straight strikes over the next three innings. Overall, he threw 34 pitches, 29 for strikes.

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 967 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

WELCOME TO THE LEIT SHOW:

Rangers No. 1 prospect, RHP **Jack Leiter** was as-advertised on Saturday in his first start of his professional career. Over his three innings, Leiter whiffed seven while allowing just one run on one hit with two walks. The second-overall pick out of Vanderbilt in the 2021 draft, Leiter was a unanimous First-Team All-American in his final season with the Commodores while tying the NCAA lead in strikeouts on the year. The son of two-time All-Star and two-time World Series champ Al Leiter, Jack is ranked as the No. 17 prospect in baseball by MLB.com. In his second start of the season, he went four innings, allowing just one run on one hit again, striking out four against San Antonio.

LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

While Leiter headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF **Ezequiel Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. INF **Justin Foscoe**, who joined the club after sustaining an injury during spring training, is the No. 5 prospect. OF **Dustin Harris** is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. LHP **Cody Bradford** is the No. 20 prospect. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season.

ABOUT AVERY

-Went to Coconino High School in Flagstaff.

-Attended Yavapai College in 2016 and 2017, going 6-4 with a 2.89 ERA over 18 outings while whiffing 87 over 65.1 innings his sophomore year.

-Transferred to University of Arizona for final two years of college, going 6-8 with a 6.46 ERA over 53 games with 17 starts.

-Selected by the White Sox in the sixth round of the 2019 draft. Even though his numbers were not the most impressive in college, the Sox saw positive analytics and pitch data from him. The scout that drafted Weems, John Kazanas, had seen him since high school and had faith in Weems despite the poor numbers.

-Weems was traded to Rangers from Chicago White Sox in December 8th, 2020 along with RHP Dane Dunning in exchange for RHP Lance Lynn.

2022 SEASON

-Made relief appearance in first series before starting his first game in San Antonio on April 13th. In that start, only threw two innings, allowing four runs (all earned) on four hits, including a three-run home run in the first inning to San Antonio's Jorge Ona.

2021 SEASON

-Ended the season as the No. 28 pitching prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.
