FISHER CATS SQUANDER EARLY LEAD, DROP SERIES FINALE: Despite jumping out to an early lead, the New Hampshire Fisher Cats fell to the Hartford Yard Goats 10-5 in Sunday's series finale at Delta Dental Stadium. In the loss, Samad Taylor went 2-for-3 with two runs scored, LJ Talley hit a homer and Demi Orimoloye went 3-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored. A costly eighth inning saw the Yard Goats score five runs to complete their 10-run comeback.

UP NEXT: Next week, the Fisher Cats will head to Hartford to conclude the season series with the Yard Goats. This is New Hampshire's second and final 12-game road trip of the year. The Fisher Cats have won or split ten of the last eleven series played.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: August 10, 2011—The Fisher Cats blanked Erie 8-0 in Manchester in the first of what would be back-to-back shutout wins. Dustin McGowan, in his first start for New Hampshire in six years, worked four shutout innings. Rey (ray) Gonzalez earned the win in relief. Anthony Gose homered, and John Tolisano drove in three runs.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays were dormant last night as they prepare to face Los Angeles in a doubleheader today. Buffalo returns home to Sahlen Field tonight for the first time this year as they host Rochester this week. Dunedin hosts St. Lucie and Vancouver visits Everett. The FCL Jays beat the Yankees 12-3 and the DSL Jays beat the Diamondbacks 12-3.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: August 9: RHP Kyle Johnston and RHP Fitz Stadler transferred to Triple-A Buffalo. RHP Jeremy Beasley added from Buffalo and RHP Nicholas Frazee added from A+ Vancouver.

STARTERS:

Fisher Cats all time wins leader Casey Lawrence will open the series on Tuesday. Lawrence will be making his 66th start and 71st appearance in a New Hampshire jersey. Lawrence picked up a quality start his last time out, going six innings and allowing two runs on five hits while fanning five. This will be his fourth start since joining the Fisher Cats this season.

Former first round pick Seth Romero will get the start for Harrisburg. This will be just his seventh appearance of the year, and just his third for Harrisburg. Romero missed the first two months of the season with a stress fracture in his ribs. His last appearance was on July 29th, where he took the loss after allowing four runs on four hits while striking out eight.

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed two earned runs in six innings last Thursday night against Hartford. Did not figure in the decision in a game New Hampshire won late 6-2.

Transferred from Triple-A to Fisher Cats on July 21.

OF NOTE: Lawrence is New Hampshire's career wins leader with 25 and has made 68 starts, the most in Fisher Cats history. Made at least two starts for New Hampshire each season 2012-2016.

v. HARRISBURG: First appearance this season (see stat box on right for previous numbers vs. Senators).

2019-21: Pitched in Japan in 2019- and started this year with York (Atlantic League). Signed back by Blue Jays May 19 and sent to Buffalo.

2018: Appeared in 30G combined with Seattle (11 relief) and Tacoma.

2017: Given a chance on Blue Jays opening roster, but struggled in four starts, and sent back to Buffalo. Mariners would claim him on waivers and he spent the rest of the year between Seattle and Triple-A Tacoma.

2016: Made 13 starts for the Fisher Cats---including six more quality starts (31 for 61). Spent second half of season in Buffalo's rotation, finishing 5-6 there.

2015: Made 26 starts for the Fisher Cats, finishing with a 12-13 record and for the second consecutive season, notched more than 160 IP. Tossed a nine-inning complete game on 5/29 in a win at New Britain – 13 of his starts were quality starts. (25 of 48 over two seasons).

2014: First full season in the Fisher Cats rotation, went 9-9 in 26G, including 22 starts. Had back-to-back eight inning starts July 20 vs. Portland and July 25 at Harrisburg. 12 of his 22 starts were quality starts.

Early Years: Progressed through the Blue Jays system, advancing from Auburn (Short-Season) to Class-A Lansing to Adv. A Dunedin. Made his Double-A debut with the Fisher Cats on April 20, 2012 at New Britain, and first start with NH April 28, 2012. Would spend most of 2012-13 with Dunedin.

Career/Personal Notes: Originally signed as non-drafted free agent 6/17/2010 (Albright College, Reading, PA). Claimed off waivers by Mariners 5/11/2017. Signed as minor league free agent by Twins 1/28/2020. Started this season with York Revolution. Back with Blue Jays as of 5/19/21 and pitched in Buffalo until July 22.
