the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (Miami Marlins) at Coolray Field. It is the 13th of 24 meetings between the two clubs IP, 7 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 SO). In four starts in July, this season, including the first of 12 games to be played in Georgia. Tonight is Family Value Tuesday, presented by Coolray Heating & Cooling (\$2 hot dogs, \$1 desserts).

VS. JACKSONVILLE: Gwinnett is 1-3-0 in four series alltime vs. Jacksonville since first meeting in 2021, including 1-1 in two series at Coolray Field (4-7 record overall). The Stripers enter play looking to snap a three-game losing streak to the Jumbo Shrimp, having been outscored 17-7 since last winning 5-1 on 6/9 at 121 Financial Ballpark.

JULY TRENDS: The Stripers are 2-1 since returning from the All-Star Break, improving their July record to 10-8 (.556). Gwinnett has a +2 run differential (outscoring opponents 62-60) this month, and has played in 14 games decided by three runs or less (GWN is 8-6).

- Dominant Arms: Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in July in WHIP (1.14) and fewest runs allowed (60), and rank second in ERA (3.37) and BAA (.220)
- Struggling Bats: Even after scoring 20 runs and blasting four homers in the last three games, Gwinnett in 31.1 IP), 0.96 WHIP, and .167 BAA in 30 games hitters still rank last in Triple-A in July in runs scored (62), homers (9), and total bases (197).

STRIKEOUT ARTISTS: The Stripers rank second in the International League in strikeouts with 917 in 93 games (9.86 SO/game), two behind Worcester (919 SO in 93G) for the top spot. Gwinnett has not led the IL in strikeouts since 2011 (club record 1,223 SO in 143G). Entering play, Kyle Muller (1st, 117), Tucker Davidson (4th, 89), Huascar Ynoa (T-10th, 77), and Bryce Elder (T-13th, 75) all rank among the IL top 15 in strikeouts.

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel gave the Stripers a temporary 4-3 lead in the eighth inning on Sunday with a three-run homer off Memphis RHP Aaron Brooks. It was Casteel's 14th extra-base hit this season, as 63.6% of his hits have been either a double (5), triple (1), or homer (8). For his Gwinnett career, 49.1% of his hits have been for extra bases (28 of 57, including 11 2B, 1 3B, 16 HR).

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: In three games since the All-Star Break, Braden Shewmake is batting .500 (6-for-12, 2 2B, 1 HR, 4 R, 4 RBI, 1.450 OPS). With the strong series in Memphis, he's now batting .311 (42-for-135, 9 2B, 4 HR, 18 R, 17 RBI, 4 SB, .814 OPS) in 36 games on the road. In 70 games overall on his Triple-A debut, Shewmake is batting .261 (67-for-257, 14 2B, 1 3B, 6 HR, 35 R, 23 RBI, 9 SB).

DELINO DE-STEALS: Delino DeShields Jr. recorded his 20th stolen base (T-7th in IL) on Sunday at Memphis. He is TUI AT THE FUTURES GAME: On 7/17, Stripers manager 20-for-28 (71.4%) in steal attempts this season. DeShields also ranks among IL leaders in walks (T-11th, 45) and has reached base safely in 52 of 64 games with at least one plate appearance this year (81.3%).

OFFENSIVE ODDS & ENDS: Ryan Goins is batting .347 (25-for-72, 6 2B, 7 R, 9 RBI, .828 OPS) in 21 games since 6/14. Hernan Perez enters play riding a five-game hitting streak, batting .500 (9-for-18, 1 2B, 1 HR, 6 R, 2 RBI, 1 SB, 1.293 OPS) with three multi-hit efforts in that span. Preston Tucker is in the midst of a five-game RBI streak (has 7 RBI since 7/13, batting .333, 6-for-18 in that span).

TONIGHT: The Stripers open a six-game series against **THE ELDER STROLLS:** Bryce Elder delivered a quality start for the third straight outing on Sunday in Memphis (ND, 6.0 he is 2-0 with a 2.36 ERA (7 ER in 26.2 IP) and .240 BAA.

• IL Leaderboard: Elder leads the league in GO/AO ratio (2.25) and ranks in the top 10 in WHIP (6th, 1.21), BAA (T-7th, .241), and innings (10th, 85.0).

FERGUSON DEBUTS: 28-year-old Tyler Ferguson has posted a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 4.0 IP) over four outings (2 H, 2 BB, 7 SO) since joining Gwinnett for his Triple-A debut on 7/12. He has not allowed a run to his own line over his last 12 outings (12.2 IP, 2 H, 1 HB, 4 BB, 21 SO) since 6/16 with Double-A Mississippi.

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin locked down his eighth save (T-6th in IL) on Friday at Memphis, pitching a perfect ninth (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 SO). He is now riding a 16.2-inning scoreless streak over his last 15 games since 6/5, the fourth-longest scoreless streak in the IL this season. In that span, Tonkin is posting a 0.54 WHIP (6 H, 3 BB), .107 BAA, 14.04 SO/9.0 IP ratio (26 SO), and five saves (5-for-5). Overall, he's 3-0 with a 1.72 ERA (6 ER

DEMERITTE DELIVERS: Travis Demeritte led the Stripers to a come-from-behind 7-6 win on Friday at Memphis, driving in the tying and winning runs with a two-out double in the eighth. It was just his third multi-RBI game with Gwinnett this season (first since 4/14 vs. NAS, 1-for-5, 1 HR, 2 RBI).

GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 175 of 208 career games (84.1%) with Gwinnett since 2019. batting .274 (197-for-720, 53 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 131 R, 142 RBI, 17 SB, .904 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

MULLDOZING: Over his last eight starts, Kyle Muller is 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA (13 ER in 52.0 IP), 0.88 WHIP, .202 BAA, 10.56 SO/9.0 IP (61 SO), and seven quality starts.

• IL Leaderboard: Muller leads in strikeouts (117, 7th in MiLB) and ranks among the top 10 in ERA (2nd, 2.96), BAA (2nd, .223), WHIP (2nd, 1.08), innings (T-2nd, 94.1), CG (T-2nd, 1), and GO/AO ratio (9th, 1.28).

Matt Tuiasosopo served as the third base coach for the National League in the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles. He was the first Gwinnett coach ever to participate in a Futures Game. The NL, led by former MLB manager Mike Sciocia, lost 6-4 to the American League (OAK's Shea Langeliers was MVP).

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... On 7/16, he served third base coach for the NL Team for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium ... Began his career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year.
