**Today:** The Lugnuts play their first road game of the year in the opener of a six-game set at the lovely and talented West Michigan Whitecaps, who would certainly never do anything to antagonize anyone else. A pair of returners make their season debuts, with 22-year-old Lansing sinkerballer **Osvaldo Berrios** (5.86 ERA in six appearances, five starts with the Nuts in 2021) matching up with 21-year-old West Michigan right-hander **Keider Montero** (5.28 ERA in 15 starts for the Whitecaps last year).

Last Series: The Lugnuts were swept in a season-opening Saturday doubleheader at Jackson Field, 3-0 and 7-5, but recovered to edge Lake County 6-5 on Sunday, avoiding the three-game sweep against the Captains. In the matinee finale, Lansing knocked out Caps starter Tommy Mace with a three-run first inning and never trailed. Zero home runs were hit by the two teams in the series.

Who's Hot? The best pitching performances over the weekend came from David Leal (7 K in 3 IP, 0 R) on Saturday and Stevie Emanuels (6 K in 3 IP, 1 R) on Sunday. Leadoff hitter Gabriel Maciel went 3-for-4 in his Lugnuts debut on Saturday before drawing two walks on Sunday. Second baseman Joshwan Wright enjoyed his own sparkling debut, going 2-for-3 with a walk on Sunday.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday, then turn around and come back home to welcome in the Fort Wayne TinCaps from April 19-24.

#### Lug•Notes

Talent Rich: The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in Tyler Soderstrom, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of six Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager Brayan Buelvas (No. 10) and Euribiel Ángeles (No. 11), starting pitcher Joey Estes (No. 19), first baseman/outfielder Lawrence Butler (No. 21) and pitcher Jeff Criswell (No. 22).

Meet the Boss: 31-year-old rookie Phil Pohl is the 17th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Pohl grew up in Cooperstown, starring at Cooperstown Central High School and earning the honor of 2008 New York High School Baseball Player of the Year. Pohl turned down the Tampa Bay Rays' contract offer as a 44th-round draft pick to attend Clemson University, where he distinguished himself as a two-time team captain and three-time ACC Academic Honor Roll selection. Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012, the same draft that netted Oakland Matt Olson and Max Muncy, and rose as high as Triple-A Sacramento in four MiLB seasons. Upon retiring following the 2015 season, Pohl rejoined the A's as MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his coaching debut.

Making Things Official: The first two starters of this series, Osvaldo Berrios and Joey Estes, have already pitched once this year in a Lugnuts uniform, taking the mound on April 6 against the Michigan State Spartans in the Crosstown Showdown. Estes struck out five batters in four innings, allowing a Peter Ahn solo home run, and Berriors followed with a three-inning save, striking out three, in the Lugnuts' 3-2 victory. Lansing is 12-2 all-time in the exhibition series against MSU.

No. 162: On April 9, reliever Zach Jackson, a member of the 2017 Lugnuts pen, made his MLB debut for the Oakland Athletics. In doing so, he became the 162nd all-time Nut to reach the Majors. There are currently 15 Major League teams with at least one Lugnut representing, totaling 31 players, including four (Jackson, Dany Jiménez, Kirby Snead and Kevin Smith) on the A's and one (Drew Hutchison) on the Detroit Tigers.

Record-Breaking: Last night, reliever Jordan Romano, a member of the 2016 Lugnuts starting rotation, broke Tom Henke's Toronto Blue Jays franchise record with his 26th consecutive save, closing out the Yankees in a 3-0 Blue Jays win.

Welcome Back: The Nuts return one coach (hitting coach Javier Godard) and 12 players from 2021, pitchers Osvaldo Berrios, Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and David Leal; catcher Jared McDonald; infielders Brett Harris, Patrick McColl and Drew Swift; and outfielders Lazaro Armenteros, Austin Beck, Jonny Butler and Lawrence Butler.

Recent Acquisitions: Three Lugnuts – pitcher Joey Estes, infielder Euribiel Ángeles and outfielder Gabriel Maciel – join the Athletics organization for the 2022 season from outside the system. Estes was picked up from Atlanta in a four-player package for first baseman Matt Olson on March 14, 2022; Ángeles was acquired from San Diego with a fellow prospect for pitcher Sean Manaea on April 3, 2022; and Maciel was selected in the Rule 5 Draft Triple-A portion from the Minnesota Twins on December 3, 2021. Both Ángeles (Fort Wayne TinCaps) and Maciel (Cedar Rapids Kernels) faced the Lugnuts in 2021, with Maciel hitting a walk-off grand slam against David Leal on June 23, 2021, one of his two home runs during the season.

International Appeal: In addition to the 15 states plus Puerto Rico represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, the Nuts hail from Brazil, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

2022 Champ: Outfielder Brayan Buelvas, the youngest player on the team at 19 years old, has already won a title this year. Buelvas started in all seven games in center field for Team Colombia, champions of the 2022 Caribbean Series, where he hit .273 (6-for-22, all singles).

## 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.


**Personal:** Drafted in the 20th round in 2017 from the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School (Gurabo, Puerto Rico) and signed away from Alabama State University commitment... signing scout: Hector Stewart.

**PRBHS History:** Founded in 2002 by Ed Correa, who first used the Los Angeles Dodgers' Dominican complex in Las Palmas, DR, in 1999 as what would become the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School three years later... produced Carlos Correa (1st overall in 2012), Hiram Burgos, Joe Jiménez, Vimael Machin, Jesmuel Valentin and Christian Vázquez... this year produced one draftee, Astros 16th-rounder Gaby Nieves... in 2017, when Berríos was drafted, he was one of four players drafted from PRBHS.

**Puerto Rican Baseball:** Puerto Rico has produced four Hall of Famers thus far in Roberto Clemente, Iván Rodríguez, Roberto Alomar and Orlando Cepeda, with 1996 Lugnuts outfielder Carlos Beltrán and current catcher Yadier Molina each with their own Hall of Fame cases... today's Major League stars from Puerto Rico are led by Javier Báez of the Tigers, Francisco Lindor of the Mets, José Berríos of the Blue Jays, and Carlos Correa of the Twins... Lindor, like Osvaldo Berrios, was born in Caguas.

**Pro Debut - 2017 in AZL:** Made professional debut on July 1, 2017, vs. AZL Giants, allowing three runs on five hits in 1 2/3... final appearance of the year was his best (3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K) vs. AZL SD1 on September 2... gave up .302 avg. to lefties, .366 to righties... base-stealers were 4-for-6.

**2018 in AZL:** Relieved Daulton Jefferies in the second game of the season, tossing 3 2/3 innings (6 H, 1 R, 5 K) vs. AZL Giants Black... pitched six-inning gem (3 H, 1 R, 4 K) on the 4th of July vs. AZL White Sox... gave up just two earned runs in final 17 2/3 innings... limited righties to .252 avg./.628 OPS while lefties hit .348/.860... base-stealers were 6-for-6.

2019 in AZL and the NYPL: Opened season with AZL A's Gold, making four appearances... in first game of the year, appeared in relief on June 17 and struck out six AZL Cubs2 in 3 2/3 innings, allowing only one hit... tossed five-inning gem (4 H, 1 R, 4 K) on July 1 vs. AZL Dodgers, earning promotion to Short-Season A Vermont... finished the year with best outing for the Lake Monsters, August 29 vs. Connecticut in Game 2 of doubleheader (5 IP, 1 H, 2 BB, 4 K)... with Vermont, gave up .326 avg./.855 OPS to right-handed hitters while lefties hit .241/.770... base-stealers went 1-for-1 in the AZL and 7-for-9 in the New York-Penn League.
