LATE LOSS ENDS WIN STREAK

Express starter RHP James Marvel escaped a bases-loaded jam in the first inning and his offense helped him out in the second as DH Yoshi Tsutsugo's groundout allowed C Sam Huff to score, giving the E-Train a 1-0 lead. Salt Lake posted five runs after batting through their whole lineup in the bottom of the third and took a 5-1 lead thanks to three hits, two walks and one hit batter. Round Rock answered back with three runs over the following two innings. SS Davis Wendzel recorded an RBI single in the fourth and a duo of RBI singles in the fifth from 3B Justin Foscue and 1B Blaine Crim cut the deficit to one run. The Express tied the game at 5-5 in the sixth thanks to a J.P. Martinez sacrifice fly that plated Wendzel. The Bees took the lead in the bottom of the eighth when CF Jordyn Adams launched a solo home run to right field to break the tie and put Salt Lake ahead 6-5. In the ninth, Foscue drew a two-out walk but Round Rock could not get him home and fell 6-5.

GOING FOR A WINN

Express RHP Cole Winn is the scheduled starter in Wednesday's matinee. His lone win on the season came during a day game on the road in Sacramento. He went five innings and gave up five hits and no runs for his only scoreless outing. He struck out a season-high seven batters. On the year, Winn's ERA is 8.93 after allowing 36 earned runs in 38 innings pitched.

THE PCL'S HOTTEST HITTER

Express outfielder Elier Hernandez is riding a season-high 11-game hitting streak, which dates back to May 24 and is the second longest active streak in the Pacific Coast League behind two batters who have 13. Over the 11-game span, Hernandez tallied 23 hits including five doubles and two home runs with 17 RBI and five walks. The 23 hits lead the PCL over that span and the 17 RBI is the third most among PCL players since May 24, 2023.

WELCOME BACK, J.P.

In his return to the Express lineup, CF J.P. Martinez went 1-for-4 with an RBI and a strikeout. Martinez had not played for Round Rock in over a month while dealing with a groin injury. During his minor league rehab with High-A Hickory, Martinez played in two games and went 2-for-3 with a double, four walks and three stolen bases.

REHABBERS IN ROUND ROCK

RHP Joe Barlow added to Round Rock on Tuesday on a rehab assignment after being added to Texas' 15-Day Injured List on May 30. The Rangers' rightly threw one scoreless inning and allowed no hits while striking out one batter.

CLOSE LOSSES

Tuesday's loss to Salt Lake after an eighth inning go-ahead home run with two out was just the fourth one-run game that Round Rock has lost after posting an 11-3 record in one-run games prior to last night. It is also just the fifth loss for the E-Train when out hitting their opponent, after posting eight hits to Salt Lake's seven. The loss snaps a three-game road win streak and an overall four-game win streak for Round Rock.

NEARING THE 700 MARK

In his first year coaching in the Pacific Coast League, Round Rock manager Doug Davis, who has been coaching in the minor leagues since his time with Short-A Pittsfield in 1996, is just one win shy of reaching the 700 mark in his career. His all-time record is 699-630, with 316 of those wins and 294 of the losses coming at the Triple-A level.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

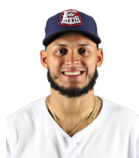
