SUNDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox finished their series in Altoona with a split in a 6-1 loss to the Curve on Sunday. **Levi Wells** pitched 2.1 innings, walked two, struck out two and gave up a three-run homer to Jase Bowen in the second inning. After a 46 minute rain delay in the fourth, Altoona scored three runs off **Trace Bright. Reed Trimble** drove home Chesapeake's only run in the eighth with a double to right-center. The Baysox committed a season-high five errors in the field.

REHABBING RIGHTIES

Orioles Major League rehabbers **Kyle Bradish** and **Tyler Wells** are scheduled to make rehab starts tonight and tomorrow afternoon, respectively. Bradish is recovering from Tommy John surgery on June 19, 2024. This will be the second start of his rehab assignment. The 28-year-old last rehabbed with Chesapeake on April 16, 2024 vs Altoona and struck out four in three scoreless innings. Wells is also recovering from UCL surgery on June 17, 2024. He last pitched for Chesapeake in August 2023.

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** has been red hot in the month of July. **The Orioles No. 14 prospect is second in the league in batting average (.352) and is sixth in the league in OPS (.954).** The 22-year-old is on a 16-game on-base streak and has collected a hit in 13 of 15 games this month.

ESTRADA IS ELECTRIC

IF **Aron Estrada** was promoted from High-A Aberdeen to Double-A Chesapeake today. The 20-year-old led the IronBirds in batting average, hits, doubles, triples, RBI and on-base percentage at the time of his promotion. The Orioles No. 18 prospect was named a Carolina League Post-Season All-Star last year with Single-A Delmarva.

Chesapeake has won just 14 games at home this season, which is tied for the second fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. The Baysox have dropped 20 of their last 27 home games since May 27. The last time the Baysox finished a season at least 10 games below .500 at home was in 2016 (30-41). 18 of the next 24 games for Chesapeake are at home.

CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL

Chesapeake won its 21st one-run game on Tuesday - which is the most in the Eastern League and tied for the second-most in full-season MiLB. Chesapeake has 11 extra inning wins, which is the most in full-season MiLB. The Baysox have played 36 one-run games this season. which is the most in all of Double-A.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 3.15 ERA, which is fourth-best in Double-A and fifth-best in full-season MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 459 hitters, which is sixth-most in Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

HERE COME THE CATS

The New Hampshire Fisher Cats - Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays - make their first trip back to Bowie since September 2023. New Hampshire finished the first half in fifth place at 29-40 and are off to a 10-16 start in the second half. New Hampshire's active roster includes five of the Blue Jays' top 30 prospects, per MLB. com - RHP Trey Yesavage (No. 2), RHP Juaron Watts-Brown (No. 10), OF Victor Arias (No. 13), IF Charles McAdoo (No. 15), and OF Dasan Brown (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Ryan Watson is set to make his 16th start of the season for New Hampshire. The 26-year-old has thrown the 8th-most innings in the Eastern League (88.1) as he has gone six or more innings in seven of his 16 starts this season. Watson last threw on July 20 vs Binghamton and gave up three runs on five hits in 3.2 innings of work. Watson signed with Toronto as an undrafted free agent in May 2024.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

2023: Finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting, the first Oriole to receive a Cy Young vote since Zack Britton in 2016...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 QS)... Became the first qualified O's pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA since Mike Mussina posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0 IP) in 1992...Had a 16.0-inning scoreless streak to end the regular season...Finished ranked among qualified MLB leaders in ERA and WHIP (4th), as well as opponent average (7th, .215), and among qualified AL leaders in opponent average (2nd), ERA (3rd), WHIP (4th), and winning percentage (T-8th, .632)...Led O's pitchers in ERA, strikeouts, opponent average, WHIP, and quality starts...His 168 strikeouts were the most by an O's hurler since Dylan Bundy fanned 184 in 2018...Pitched to a 2.23 ERA (19 ER/76.2 IP) in 13 starts at home this year, the best single-season mark in Oriole Park history among hurlers with at least 70.0 innings pitched at home...Went 4-4 with a 4.22 ERA (25 ER/53.1 IP) in 10 starts against AL East foes, including 4-3 with a 2.74 ERA (14 ER/46.0 IP) in his final eight outings against the division...Appeared on his first career Opening Day roster...Spent time on the 15-day Injured List with a right foot contusion from April 5-19 after being struck by a comebacker in the second inning of his season debut on April 3 at Texas; made one rehab start with Double-A Bowie on April 14...Struck out a season high 10 batters on June 8 at Milwaukee...Had a career-best five-game winning streak from August 1 to September 8...Posted five straight quality starts from June 6 to September 9, the longest such streak of his career and longest by an Oriole since Alex Cobb (6, 7/26-8/24/18)...Tossed a season-high 8.0 scoreless innings on September 26 vs. Washington, his longest start since September 22, 2022 vs. Houston (8.2 IP), and tied for the longest outing by an Oriole in 2023 (Rodriguez, 9/16 vs. TB and Gibson, 8/24 vs. TOR)...Made his Postseason debut as the starter in Game 1 of the ALDS on October 7 vs. Texas; dealt the loss after allowing two runs on seven hits with one walk and nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings; became the third player in O's history (since 1954) to strike out at least nine batters in his Postseason debut, joining Mike Boddicker (14, 10/6/1983 vs. CWS - ALCS G2) and Moe Drabowsky (11, 10/5/1966 at LAD - WS G1).

2022: Made 23 starts in his rookie season, 12 at home and 11 on the road...Began the year with Triple-A Norfolk and was named International League Pitcher of the Week on April 17...Recalled and made his MLB debut on April 29 vs. Boston (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 2 ER, BB, 2 K, HR, WP); became the first O's pitcher to start his MLB debut since LHP Bruce Zimmermann on September 17, 2020 (G2) vs. Tampa Bay and first to record a quality start in his debut since RHP Dean Kremer on September 6, 2020 vs. New York-AL...Earned his first career win on May 10 at St. Louis after pitching 7.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) with a career-high 11 strikeouts; became the first Oriole to pitch 7.0 innings with zero walks and 11 strikeouts since LHP John Means threw a no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle; was only the second pitcher in MLB history to have an outing with 11+ strikeouts and no walks in one of his first three career starts, joining Stephen Strasburg on June 8, 2010 vs. Pittsburgh (14 K); also the first O's rookie with 11+ strikeouts in a game since LHP Wei-Yin Chen July 29, 2012 vs. Oakland (12 K)...Went 3-3 with a 3.28 ERA (26 ER/71.1 IP) in 13 starts after being reinstated from the Injured List on July 29; placed on the 15-day Injured List

with right shoulder inflammation on June 24, retroactive to June 21...Began a rehab assignment on July 9 and made two starts with Bowie and one with Norfolk; went 1-1 with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER/12.2 IP)...Pitched a career-high 8.2 scoreless innings with two hits and 10 strikeouts on September 22 vs. Houston, retiring the first 17 batters faced... Ended the year going 3-2 with a 2.76 ERA (14 ER/45.2 IP) in his final eight starts...Spent Spring Training in big league camp for the first time

Manager

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League BaseballTM teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
