YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 17-10, and set season highs in runs and hits (16). In the third, **Blake Sabol** brought in a run with a groundout, **Grant McCray** hit an RBI bunt single and **Andy Thomas** hit a grand slam to open a 6-0 lead. The Baysox answered with four runs in the bottom of the third, including a three-run homer by Samuel Basallo. In the fourth, **Victor Bericoto** hit a three-run homer, his second of the series, to extend the Richmond lead to 9-4. The Baysox scored three runs on a double by TT Bowens in the fifth to close within two runs and took a 10-9 lead with a three-run homer by Silas Ardoin in the bottom of the sixth. **Adrián Sugastey** tied the game with an RBI single in the seventh and **Luis Toribio** followed with a run-scoring groundout to move Richmond back in front, 11-10. In the eighth, Thomas hit a two-run single, extending the lead to 13-10. Thomas tied his career high with six RBIs in the game, the most for a Richmond batter this season. In the top of the ninth, **Will Wilson** hit a two-run double, McCray hit an RBI double and Sugastey added a sac fly to open a 17-10 lead. **Tyler Myrick** closed his third save of the season, striking out three while recording the final six outings. **Tanner Kiest** improved to 3-1 on the year, throwing 1.2 innings and striking out three.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the fourth of a six-game series. This is the first of two visits to Bowie for Richmond. They will return for a three-game series at Prince George's Stadium from July 1-3. Richmond won four-of-six against Bowie at The Diamond earlier this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 8-2 in their last 10 games after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on the last road trip to Akron and Erie. They had lost eight straight games before winning last Wednesday night, starting a five-game winning streak.

THE BAYSOX are in fourth place in the Southwest Division, 4.5 games behind first-place Akron. They won four-of-six last week at Binghamton. Bowie's roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C/IB Samuel Basallo (No. 2), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 7), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 12), INF Max Wagner (No. 14), RHP Trace Bright, (No. 16), OF John Rhodes (No. 23), RHP Alex Pham (No. 24) and INF Frederick Bencosme (No. 27). Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list features 10 Baysox players, including Basallo (No. 2), Johnson (No. 9), Beavers (No. 10), Fabian (No. 12), Wagner (No. 14), Bright (No. 20), Rhodes (No. 26), Pham (No. 27), Bencosme (No. 28) and RHP Keagan Gillies (No. 29). On Baseball America's "Best Tools" list for Orioles prospects, Basallo is rated as the best over hitter, Pham is rated as having the best curveball, Silas Ardoin is rated as the best defensive catcher and Fabian is rated as the best outfield arm.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his ninth appearance and his eighth start of the season. It is also his second start against the Baysox this year. Frisbee last pitched on Sunday at The Diamond against the Fightin Phils and allowed two runs over four innings in a no-decision. In his last two starts dating back to May 12, Frisbee has posted a 3.38 ERA (3 ER/8.0 IP). He last faced the Baysox on April 24 at The Diamond and allowed a season-high five runs over 3.1 innings in a loss. Frisbee is ranked third in Flying Squirrels franchise history in career strikeouts (260), fourth (min. 150 IP) in K/9 (8.76) and tied for sixth in wins (17). On May 13, 2021, Frisbee threw six perfect innings in a combined no-hitter with Joey Marciano, Matt Seelinger and Patrick Ruotolo, the first nine-inning no hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history and the second overall no-hitter in team history. On August 10, 2022 at Portland, Frisbee set a single-game franchise record with 13 strikeouts and allowed one hit, a fourth-inning single by rehabbing Red Sox outfielder Kiké Hernández, over six scoreless innings. Last year, Frisbee spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-0 with a 4.54 ERA in 27 appearances, his first season working primarily as a reliever. Frisbee was selected by the Giants in the 15th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of UNC Greensboro. *For more on Frisbee, see page two.* page two.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Cameron Weston makes his first Double-A start and his fifth appearance. He last pitched on Sunday at Binghamton and was charged with a loss after allowing one run over 4.2 innings out of the bullpen. Weston began the season with High-A Aberdeen and went 1-0 with a 0.54 ERA (1 ER/16.2 IP) in four starts. He was promoted to Double-A on April 30. He has allowed one-or-less run in each of his eight outings this year between Aberdeen and Bowie. He was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on April 14 after throwing five hitless innings and striking out nine batters on April 11 against Wilmington. Weston spent most of his season in 2023 with Aberdeen and went 3-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 12 outings (three starts). He was selected by the Orioles in the eighth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of Michigan.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked second among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (8,009).

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: Over the last 10 games since May 14, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .276 (90-for-326), best in the league, and have scored 66 runs, an average of 6.6 runs per game. Over the previous 13 games from April 28-May 12, the Richmond offense hit a league-worst .171 (69-for-407) and averaged 1.7 runs per game (22 runs/13 games). The Flying Squirrels broke the slump with a four-run eighth inning in a 6-4 win last Wednesday night. In winning eight-of-their-last-10, the Flying Squirrels have outscored Reading and Bowie, 66-34.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: There are three relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers, two Richmond pitchers rank in the top-10 in ERA (min. 18 IP), including **Evan Gates** (3rd - 1.17 ERA - 3 ER/23.0 IP) and **Nick Garcia** (8th - 1.45 ERA - 3 ER/18.2 IP). **Wil Jensen** is 12th (1.91 - 6 ER/28.1 IP) and **Tanner Kiest** is 13th (2.21 ERA - 5 ER/20.1 IP). Jensen, who was promoted to Triple-A on Friday, is second the league in relief innings pitched.

SETTING THE TABLE: Carter Howell is batting .333 (21-for-63) over his last 17 games since May 3 with three doubles, a homer, six RBIs, 11 walks and 10 runs scored. Last Thursday night in the second game of a doubleheader against the Fightin Phils, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer in the fifth inning in a 3-1 win. In his 12 games batting first in the lineup, Howell is batting .340 (16-for-47) with two doubles and seven walks. When leading off an inning, Howell is batting a team-best .424 (14-for-33). On Friday, Howell scored a career-high four runs. Howell is now ranked eighth in the Eastern League in batting average (.288) and 10th in OBP (.386). Dating back to Tuesday, Howell is second in the league in batting average (.438) and OBP (.550) and ranks tied for fourth in hits (7), tied for fifth in walks (4) and tied for first in runs scored (7).

GRANTING WISHES: In his last nine games since May 15, **Grant McCray** is batting .500 (14-for-28) with two homers, five doubles, a triple, seven walks, nine RBIs and 14 runs scored, raising his season batting average from .135 to .212. He picked up a season-high three hits on Tuesday night at Bowie and matched it on Friday night. For the season, McCray is batting .135 (14-for-104) when batting first in the lineup compared to .500 (14-for-28) when batting third, fifth or sixth in the order. McCray is fifth in the Eastern League in extra-base hits (17), tied for fifth in runs scored (26) and tied for eighth in doubles (10).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas is batting .367 (11-for-30) over his last eight games since May 15 with a homer, three doubles and 11 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .237. Thomas has picked up two hits in four-of-his-last-six games played dating back to the second game of last Thursday's doubleheader and has picked up three doubles in that same stretch. WILL POWER: Will Wilson has reached base 10 times in the first four games of this series. On Tuesday, he went 1-for-4 with a two-run homer. He followed with a 2-for-5 performance on Wednesday and added a solo home run. On Thursday night, Wilson went 0-for-1 but walked three times. He picked up three hits and a walk on Friday night. In this week's series, Wilson is batting .400 (6-for-15). Wilson is now ranked seventh in Flying Squirrels franchise history with 26 career homers.

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).
