LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox used the long ball to win their series opener over the Altoona Curve 10-4 on Tuesday night. Dylan Beavers smashed his first homer of the season to open the scoring. Right-hander and Orioles starting pitcher Kyle Bradish went three shutout innings and allowed only one hit and no walks with four strikeouts over 44 pitches. The Baysox scored five runs in the bottom of the seventh to take the lead for good. Samuel Basallo ripped his first Double-A homer and Bowens hammered a two-run homer to right-center. Bowens and Frederick Bencosme drove in three RBI each.

SEASONING FROM BEYOND THE WALL

The Curve sport a well-seasoned roster to open 2024, with 20 players who share previous Double-A experience with Altoona. The Curve are 4-4 to open the series after taking three of five from their opening home series against Harrisburg last week. Altoona's roster includes seven of the Pirates' top 30 prospects (two Top 100), per MLB Pipeline - LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4/No. 75), RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 5/No. 85), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 6), RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 7), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 9), OF/1B Jase Bowen (No. 20), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 27).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Chris Gau gets the start for Altoona in a bullpen game for the Curve. The former Rays farmhand is in his first season with the Pirates organization after previously spending six years in Tampa Bay's system. Last season, Gau split time between Double-A Montgomery and Triple-A Indianapolis, pitching 54.1 innings with 66 strikeouts over 21 walks to a 2.48 ERA. This will be his eighth career start in the minors and his 145th appearance overall.

TERRY TATERS

OF/1B TT Bowens has homered in back-to-back games after a two-run shot in the seventh last night. The New London, Connecticut native enjoyed a successful week in Hartford last week, going 6-for-14 at the plate with four extra-base hits (three doubles and a home run) and nine RBI in his first professional action back in his home state. Bowens matched a career-high with 4 RBI on Friday. He played four years collegiately at Central Connecticut State prior to being signed by the Orioles in 2020.

BRINGING THE POP

Baysox hitters sit with the third-most extra-base hits in the Eastern League (34) through 10 games this season. Only New Hampshire (37) and Somerset (36) have more extra-base knocks than Bowie so far this season. The Baysox lead the league in triples (5) and have the second-most doubles (21).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers is off to a solid start in his second stint with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect hit his first homer of the season last night in the first inning to extend his on-base streak to eight consecutive games, which is tied for fourth-longest in the league. Beavers won Orioles Minor Leaguer of the Month in August 2023 for his debut month at the Double-A level, after hitting .337 with a .443 OBP. The outfielder's .321 average ranked second-highest in the Eastern League through the final two months of the 2023 season (min 130 PA), while his .417 OBP led the way.

BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) Samuel Basallo hit his first Double-A homer last night with a line drive shot in the seventh to put Bowie ahead for good. The 19-year old is coming off a monster season in 2023 where he finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels. Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

READY, FREDDY

IF Frederick Bencosme has enjoyed his start to life in Double-A. Bencosme has hits in seven of his first nine Double-A contests, including four multi-hit contests. The middle infielder collected his second three RBI game at the Double-A level with a three-RBI night yesterday. Bencosme clubbed his first Double-A home run on Saturday as part of a 5-4 victory against the Hartford Yard Goats. Still just 21 years old, Bencosme was signed by the Orioles as an international free agent out of Moca in the Dominican Republic in August of 2020.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell.

2023: Team MVP in High-A Aberdeen, finishing ninth in the O's system with 103.1 IP. Acquired by the Orioles from the Athletics organization on 1/26/23 in a trade where Cole Irvin also joined Baltimore in exchange for SS Darelle Hearniz. 2022: Led the A's organization in strikeouts and had the second-most starts and innings. Became primarily a starter in the A's organization, splitting time between Single-A Stockton and High-A Lansing. Started 15 games for Stockton and pitched across 86.2 innings to a 4.78 ERA. After getting called up to Lansing on 7/26/22, had a stronger finish to the season, pitching to a 4.31 ERA across 7 starts and holding opponents to a .236 average. 2021: Allowed 6 ER through 16 innings for Lansing in his debut season. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
