LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones used an 8-run 3rd inning to batter the Blue Rocks, 12-3, on Tuesday night...The Cyclones used an 8-run 3rd inning to batter the Blue Rocks, 12-3, on Tuesday night...The victory was Brooklyn's 7th straight...The Cyclones had all 9 batters pick up at least 1 hit, and 8 of 9 hitters register at least 1 RBI...Brooklyn sent 12 batters to the plate in an 8-run, 8-hit 3rd inning...SS Jesús Báez garnered 3 hits, including a double, and a pair of RBI... LF Chris Suero added 2 hits, reached base 3 times, and brought in a tally...DH Boston Baro doubled, tripled, and drove in a run...CF Carson Benge collected a pair of hits and brought in one, as well...18 Estarling Mercado tallied 2 hits, including a long solo home run...C Ronald Hernandez added a 2-run shot of his own in the 3rd...RHP R.J. Gordon allowed 1 run on 6 hits in 3.2 innings for Brooklyn, taking a no-decision...RHP Brendan Girton permitted 2 runs over 4.1 frames, collecting his 3rd win.

THE NUMBER ONE SPOT: The Cyclones are mired in a 3-team race for the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown...Entering play on Wednesday, Brooklyn holds a 1.5-game lead on Greensboro for 1st place in the division...The Cyclones are 5.5 games up on 3rd-place Hudson Valley with 14 games remaining in the first half...Brooklyn's magic number to clinch the first half division crown in 14...Any Cyclones wins or Grasshoppers losses will decrease the number... Brooklyn does not play Hudson Valley or Greensboro for the remainder of the half...Greensboro has played one series (April 15-20 vs. Jersey Shore) against a North Division foe and will not play another until the second half (July 1-6 vs./at Aberdeen).

CAN'T TUCC THIS: LHP Jonathan Santucci has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 3-0 over his last 3 outings, including a 5.1 scoreless inning performance in relief to earn the win on Thursday vs. Aberdeen...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has an 0.59 ERA (1 ER in 15.1 IP) with 6 hits allowed, 6 walks, and 17 strikeouts...Since that date, Santucci is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in wins (3), 2nd in batting average against (.115) and ERA (0.59), and 5th in WHIP (0.78).

MAGIC 8 BALL: Brooklyn erupted for a season-high 8 runs in the 3rd inning in Tuesday's 12-3 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones scored 8 runs on 8 hits and sent 12 batters to the plate...The 8-run frame was Brooklyn's biggest offensive outburst this year...The previous high had been 6 runs on 3 occasions, most recently on May 14 vs. Winston-Salem in the bottom of the 4th...The 8-run inning was the 'Clones largest frame since scoring 9 runs in the bottom of the 2nd inning in an 11-7 win vs. Wilmington on July 27, 2023...Brooklyn scored 9 runs on 6 hits in that inning, sending 12 to the dish...It was the Cyclones' biggest offensive inning on the road since tallying 10 runs in the top of the 6th in a 20-6 rout on May 27, 2022, at Bowling Green.

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 52 games of the 2025 season with Friday's win over Aberdeen, clinching another series victory... Through Brooklyn's first 9 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 7-0-2 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 4-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 9-0-2 in a series of any length.

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS: Brooklyn secured its 2nd-straight home sweep with a 4-3 walk-off win vs. Aberdeen on Sunday...The Cyclones secured their 1st sweep vs. Winston-Salem in walk-off fashion, as well...On May 18, C Ronald Hernandez's game-ending RBI fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th helped the Cyclones complete their first 6-game sweep since 2022 and their first at home since 2021...Prior to May 18, Brooklyn had not completed a 6-game sweep since taking all 6 contests at Jersey Shore from August 23-28, 2022...The Cyclones outscored the Blueclaws, 53-18, in that series...It was Brooklyn's first 6-game sweep on Coney Island since July 20-25, 2021, vs. Wilmington...The 'Clones outscored the 'Rocks, 41-22, in that set...Brooklyn's 6-game winning streak was snapped Tuesday at Jersey Shore...Additionally, the Cyclones' 37-15 record through 52 games is the franchise's best record through 52 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...Brooklyn's 36-16 mark through 52 games in 2007 is tied 2nd-best.

GOING STREAKING: The Cyclones enter Wednesday's matchup riding a season-high 7-game winning streak...Brooklyn won 6 in a row from May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...It is the 1st time the Cyclones have acrued multiple winning streaks of 6 more since the 2022 campaign...Brooklyn's last 7-game winning streak was from August 23-30, 2022, at Jersey Shore and vs. Wilmington...The Cyclones then won 6 consecutive contests from September 3-9 vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem...Brooklyn's winning streak from May 13-18 was the first time the team had won 6-straight since that stretch in 2022...During that win streak, the Cyclones clinched the Second Half South Atlantic League North Division crown at Winston-Salem.

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn continued their dominance at Maimonides Park on Sunday with a 4-3 walk-off victory vs. Aberdeen...Sunday's triumph was the Cyclones' 13th-consecutive home win...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaigm...Entering play on Wednesday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 22-5 (.815)...No one else in the league has more than 17 home victoris (Greensboro and Greenville)...The 22 home wins are the most at the High-A level and tied with the Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas for the 2nd most in Minor League Baseball...Detroit's Triple-A Toledo is 1st (23)...Brooklyn's .815 home winning percentage is the 2nd best in MiLB...Detroit's High-A West Michigan (.818) is 1st.

REIMER SHINE: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Entering play on Wednesday, Reimer is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in runs scored (47) and tied for 6th in extra-base hits (27)...The former 4th-round pick also leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (47), OPS (.984), extra-base hits (27), hits (57), and doubles (16)...Reimer also ranks 2nd in total bases (103), slugging percentage (.572), and RBI (36), 3rd in batting average (.317), tied for 6th in games played (48), 7th in on-base percentage (.412), and tied for 8th in home runs (8)...Reimer was limited to just 35 games in 2024 with a hamstring injury.

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF **Jesús Báez** has slowly returned to form...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit .647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (.10.59) OPS (1.798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF **A.J. Ewing** won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's

vs. WILMINGTON: After sweeping their 2nd-straight home series, Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game series with the Blue Rocks...Wilmington enters the series after taking a 4-of-6 games in Wappingers Falls against Hudson Valley... The Blue Rocks are 12-13 at home this season...Brooklyn is 8-2 in 10 contests against Wilmington in 2025...The Blue Rocks boast 6 of the Nationals' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP Travis Sykora (1), LHP Alex Clemmey (5), C Caleb Lomavita (8), LHP Jackson Kent (20), OF Elijah Green (23), and OF Brenner Cox (29)...Green is currently on the development list...In 117 meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 65-52 (.474)...Brooklyn is 27-30 (.464) in 57 games at Daniel S. Frawley Stadium.

Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history...Báez also was recognized on Mil.B.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" for his efforts...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has reached safely in 24-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting, 3671,475,1544/1.019 with 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 23 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and 17 walks to 1strikeouts...On May 20, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF Ryan Clifford on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore...Since the start of May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in on-base percentage (.463) and RBI (26), is 2nd in batting average (.356) and OPS (1.015), 3rd in slugging percentage (.552), ited for 3rd in hits (31), tied for 6th in total bases (48) and runs scored (20), and tied for 8th in walks (17).

BENGE IT LIKE CARSON: OF **Carson Benge** has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" from May 20-25 after hitting. 412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore...The 2024 first-round pick enters Wednesday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also 2nd in runs scored (39), tied for 4th in batting average (.307) and extra-base hits (19), 5th in on-base percentage (.424) and OPS (.921), tied for 5th in doubles (11) and hits (50), 6th in walks (32) and total bases (81), and 7th in slugging percentage (.497).

EWING-ING IT: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season and was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week... He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Nick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024...Entering play on Wednesday, the Springboro, Ohio native is teid for the Minor League lead in triples (7)...He is also 3rd in batting average (.364) and stolen bases (39), 6th in on-base percentage (.457), and teid for 8th in hits (64)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (25), is 2nd in hits (38), tied for 2nd in triples (3), 3rd in batting average (.342), tied for 4th in runs scored (24), 5th in on-base percentage (.426), and 9th in total bases (52)...Overall, Ewing is 2nd in the SAL in stolen bags (25)...The 2023 4th-round pick had a 33-game on-base streak since April 18 snapped on Sunday...During the on-base streak, Ewing hit .359/.450/.500/.950 with 27 runs scored, 5 doubles, 5 triples, a home run, 18 RBI, 21 walks, and 30 stolen bases.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn enters play on Wednesday with 122 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (134)...The 122 steals are tied for 7th in Minor League Baseball...Cleveland's Single-A Lynchburg leads Mil.B (149)...The 122 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 52 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 44 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 78 steals through 52 games...The Cyclones' single-season franchise record is 181 steals set in 2024.

It's A WALK-OFF: C Chris Suero provided Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off win in as many days in Sunday's 4-3 victory vs. Aberdeen...With 2nd and 3rd and 2 out, the 21-year-old reached on a run-scoring infield single, while a throwing error from 3B Anderson De Los Santos enabled the winning run to cross...On Saturday, C Ronald Hernandez helped Brooklyn complete another come-from-behind win, clobbering a walk-off solo home run with 1 out in the 9th in a 5-4 Cyclones win...The walk-off homer was Brooklyn's 1st since 3B Jefrey De Los Santos hit a game-tying 2-run blast and LF Omar De Los Santos smashed the game-ending solo shot on July 28, 2024, vs. Rome...Hernandez also delivered a walk-off winner with a run-producing fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th on May 18 vs. Winston-Salem...2B Marco Vargas collected Brooklyn's 1st walk-off win of the year, slapping a game-ending RBI single in the bottom of the 10th on April 29 vs. Wilmington.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 4, 2022, the Cyclones scored 6 runs in the top of the 9th to erase a 4-2 deficit, securing an 8-4 win at Jersey Shore...RF Joe Suozzi provided the go-ahead 3-run triple in the frame...In 2023, Brooklyn put up 6 runs in the 2nd inning en route to a 10-6 win at Jersey Shore...CF Alex Ramirez and SS William Lugo each homered in the win, while 2B Chase Estep collected 4 hits...In 2024, with C Francisco Alvarez behind the plate on a Major League rehab assignment, RHP Dakota Hawkins (5.0 IP), RHP Joey Lancellotti (1.0), and RHP Joshua Cornielly (3.0) combined for Brooklyn's first 9-inning no-hitter in franchise history during a 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...Cornielly closed out the no-no by getting LF Elio Prado to ground out to short.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 12 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Mate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), OF A.J. Ewing (27), and RHP Will Watson (29)...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), Dohm (23), Ewing (24), and RHP Raimon Gómez (26)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his 3rd-straight win pitching in relief last Thursday night vs. Aberdeen...Entered in support of RHP **Frankie Montas** (3.0 IP) who was making a Major League rehab start in the top of the 4th with Brooklyn leading 4-2...Did not allow a run on 2 hits over a career-high 5.1 innings...Walked 2 and struck out a career-high-tying 6...Retired the leadoff batter in 4 of 6 innings...Threw 69 pitches and 47 strikes (68.12%)...Relieved by RHP **Jace Beck** with a runner at 1st and 1 out in the top of the 9th and the Cyclones leading 6-2...Bequeathed runner did not score...Brooklyn went on to defeat the IronBirds, 6-2.

2025: Broke camp with Brooklyn...Suffered the loss in his professional debut on 4/9 vs. HV (4.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 BB, 5 K)...Struck out a career-high 6 in a no-decision on 4/15 @ABD (3.2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, ER, BB, 6 K)...Suffered the loss, but tossed a career-long 4.1 innings on 5/3 vs. WIL (4.1 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 3 K)...Tossed a career-long 4.2 innings and career-high 78 pitches in a no-decision on 5/9 @ASH (4.2 IP, 10 H, 5 R, 5 ER, BB, 4 K)...Posted a career-high 5.0 innings and earned the 1st win of his professional career on 5/16 vWS (5.0 IP, H, 2 BB, 5 K)...Collected his 2nd-straight win and tied career-highs in innings (5.0) and strikeouts (6) on 5/23-1 @JS (5.0 IP, 3 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...Earned his 3rd-consecutive victory, setting a career-high in innings pitched (5.1) and tying a career-high in K's (6) on 5/29 vABD (5.1 IP, 2 H, 2 BB, 6 K).

TUCC CHAINS: The Leominster, Mass. native has found his form over his last 3 outings...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has an 0.59 ERA (1 ER in 15.1 IP) with 6 hits allowed, 6 walks, and 17 strikeouts...Since that date, Santucci is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in wins (3), 2nd in batting average against (.115) and ERA (0.59), and 5th in WHIP (0.78).

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2025 season, Santucci was ranked as the New York Mets' No. 12 prospect by MLB Pipeline and No. 16 by *Baseball America...* He is also ranked the Mets' No. 15 farmhand by SNY's **Joe DeMayo...**Deemed to have the "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2024 draft class by *Baseball America* for his slider.

SPRING BREAKOUT: Santucci was a member of the Mets' 2025 Spring Breakout roster...While still awaiting his official professional debut, the southpaw entered in relief of RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** during the bottom of the 5th inning...Santucci tossed a scoreless inning of work, facing one over the minimum, allowing one hit and one walk, and inducing a double play.

DEVILISHLY GOOD: Santucci spent his three-year collegiate career at Duke University...As a junior in 2024, the 22-year-old compiled a 6-1 record with a 3.41 ERA (22 ER in 58.0 IP), 36 walks, and 90 strikeouts in 13 starts for the Blue Devils...Santucci was named to the All-ACC First Team and recognized on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list...Missed three weeks during the 2024 season with a rib injury...Punched out a career-high 14 batters against Akron on 3/1...Was the second of back-to-back 10+ strikeout performances, whiffing 11 against Northwestern on 2/23...Limited to only 7 starts as a sophomore due to elbow surgery to remove bone chips...During his career at Duke, Santucci accrued a 10-6 mark with a 3.86 ERA (55 ER in 128.1 IP), 72 walks, and 198 strikeouts in 40 appearances (27 starts).

DUAL THREAT: During his high school career, Santucci was a two-way player at Phillips Academy (Andover, Mass.)...The left-hander registered a .322 batting average in high school, adding six doubles, two triples, three home runs, and 29 RBI...Santucci also received opportunities at the plate during his time at Duke...At the plate in college, the Leominster, Mass. native posted a .217 average (5-23) with two doubles, a home run, and 5 RBI in 24 plate appearances...Santucci played four games in the outfield at Duke, with three in right field and one in center field.

FAMILY TIES: Jonathan is not the only athlete in the Santucci family...Dad, **Steven**, played baseball at Assumption University (Worcester, Mass.) from 1991-93...He was a 19th-round pick of the St. Louis Cardinals out of Assumption in 1993...Played 4 seasons of Minor League Baseball as an outfielder...Reached Double-A Arkansas in 1996...Spent parts of 2 seasons in the New York-Penn League with the Glens Falls (N.Y.)
