TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve wrap up their series with Harrisburg today, the Senators swept the Curve in a 3-game series to open the weekend. Altoona and Harrisburg will play 15 games against each other in the first 33 games of the year.

Kyle Luckham is back after tossing 6.0 innings of 3-run ball on Tuesday. Today will be his 8th career start against Altoona, Luckham was Washington's 15th round pick in 2022 out of Arizona State after he began his collegiate career at CSU-Fullerton. Luckham told Fullerton Sports Information that he models his game after former Nationals RHP Max Scherzer.

WHERE THERE'S A WILL, THERE'S A WAY: Outfielder Will Taylor has reached base safely in each of his last 5 games (6-for-16) with 1 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI and 7 BB (.565 OBP) since April 19.

THERE IT IS: The Curve broke out with a season high 11 runs and 3 homers in the late innings on April 23 at Harrisburg. **Keiner Delgado** hit his second career Grand Slam and drove in a career-best 5 runs in the win.

SOLO SLAMS: Altoona has an odd propensity for hitting solo homers early in the season. Entering Sunday, the Curve have hit 18 homers, 14 of them have been solo.

In a 2-0 win over Portland on April 18 both of Altoona's hits were solo homers. The last time Altoona's only hit was a solo homer was June 21, 2023 when Liover Peguero hit a leadoff homer in a 6-inning rain-shortened win. The Curve last had a game with 2 hits and both were solo homers on May 29, 2021 in a 7-inning game against Erie. Altoona has not had a game where both hits were solo homers in a 9-inning game since 2005.

BAD TIMING: The Curve have struggled to get hits with men on the basepaths to begin the year, batting .208 with runners on base - 26th among Double-A clubs. The Curve have grounded into 16 double plays already in 18 games, most by a Double-A club.

Altoona's 73 runs are the 2nd-fewest by a Double-A team, tied for the 4th-fewest by any minor league team (San Antonio, 60 R in 20 games).

SEEING THE WOODS THROUGH THE TREES: Lefty **Jaden Woods** is off to a solid start to begin the season out of Altoona's bullpen. Since joining the club to begin the second half of the 2024 season (June 22, 2024) he has the most strikeouts by an Eastern League reliever (126 in 104.1 IP). This season Woods has picked up 16 strikeouts in 10.2 innings across 7 outings and he's been unscored upon 4-of-7 games pitched.

OH THAT WAS FAST: The Curve played the fastest game in franchise history on Saturday, April 18 against Portland, winning 2-0 in one hour and 47 minutes.

A SLOW START: The Curve set the franchise record for longest losing streak to begin a season with an 0-12 start, surpassing the 2009 Curve team that went 0-8 to start the year, a streak that finally ended on April 17 with a 5-3 win over Portland. Altoona was the only team in professional baseball without a win when they finally broke through.

MOSS IS BOSS: First baseman **Callan Moss** has a hit in 10-of-17 games to begin his Double-A career, reaching base safely in 13 games overall.

CAREER NOTES

2026: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Tossed 2.0 innings in the Pirates Spring Breakout game against Detroit, allowing 2 runs, 1 earned, with 3 strikeouts... Fired 5.0 strong innings on Opening Day (2 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 9 K, 1 HR on 64 pitches, 48 strikes)...

2025: Spent the majority of the season Greensboro and joined Altoona after their elimination in the postseason... Finished the season 3rd among PIT MiLB in K (119), 5th in IP (110.2)... Ranked 1st in the South Atlantic League in starts (26), 4th in strikeouts (116) and 4th in BAA (.222) at the time of his promotion to Altoona... Was named the SAL Pitcher of the Week on July 7 after tossing 6 perfect innings with 10 strikeouts against Aberdeen to start a combined Perfect Game, the first of two thrown by Greensboro in July... Took the loss in Game 1 of SAL Division Series: 6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 4 BB, 6 K (2 WP) on 88 pitches, 51 strikes... Tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in his Double-A debut on September 14 (3 K, no baserunners)... Threw 2.0 hitless innings in G2 of SWDS for Altoona at Erie...

CURVE CUTS: Signed with the Pirates for a bonus of \$497,500... Born in Beaumont, TX, attended Port Neches-Groves HS... Spent two seasons at Texas A&M and one season with ASU... As a Freshman at Texas A&M underwent a nerve transposition surgery, returned to the mound for 5 games with the Aggies as a sophomore before undergoing a second surgery, per Jonathan Mayo of MLB Pipeline: It turned out that stitches remaining from the first surgery were on his nerve, so every pitch he threw, the nerve was being further frayed. Curtis was likely just a small number of throws away from doing irreparable damage to his arm. The second surgery took five-and-a-half hours, and at one point, members of the medical team told Curtis' parents the nerve damage was so severe that not only might he not pitch again, he might not have full use of his arm...
