FRANCISCO ALVAREZ REHAB ASSIGNMENT: New York Mets catcher Francisco Alvarez began a rehab assignment with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies on Thursday. Alvarez drilled a three-run homer in the second inning and walked and scored in the first on Thursday. He went 1-for-2 with three runs batted in and caught the first five innings of the game. He caught seven innings on Saturday and threw a potential base stealer out at second. Alvarez played in 16 games and hit .236 with a homer and eight runs batted in for the Mets, before being placed on the 10-day injured list on April 20. Alvarez has played parts of the last three seasons with the Mets and hit 25 homers with 63 runs batted in across 123 games last season. He set the Mets franchise record for home runs by a rookie catcher and his 25 homers were the second-most by any catcher in the Majors. Alvarez hit 18 homers and hit .277 with a .921 OPS in 67 games for Binghamton in 2022 and was named an Eastern League All-Star, before making his major league debut later that season on September 30. Alvarez was one of five players who began the 2022 season with Binghamton and made their MLB debut with the Mets in the same season, along with Brett Baty, José Buttó, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca.

**SPROAT KEEPS SPROUTING:** Mets No. 13 prospect **Brandon Sproat** is slated to make his second start of the series tonight. Sproat allowed one run over seven innings with five strikeouts and earned his first Double-A win on Monday in the series opener against Harrisburg. Sproat has tossed a career-high seven innings in back-to-back starts. Over his first nine professional appearances, across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton, Sproat ranks fifth in all of Minor League Baseball with a 1.42 ERA. In each of his first three Double-A starts, the 23-year-old has gone at least five innings and has allowed three runs or fewer. Sproat is 1-0 with a 1.89 ERA and a 20-to-5 strikeout-to-walk ratio at the Double-A level.

**LAST TIME DUT:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies were blanked by the Harrisburg Senators, 6-0, on Saturday night at Mirabito Stadium. Joander Suarez struck out a season-high 10 batters over 4.2 innings. The Ponies had five players hit a single (Matt Rudick, Alex Ramírez, Nolan McLean, JT Schwartz, & Jeremiah Jackson). Wilkin Ramos tossed a scoreless ninth and has not allowed a run over his first 12 appearances of the season.

LIGHTNING MCLEAN: Mets No. 19 prospect two-way Nolan McLean hit a single and drew a walk on Saturday night. He belted the first home run of his Double-A career with a solo shot to left field on Friday night in the ninth inning. McLean drove in both of Binghamton's runs with an RBI double, along with his homer. McLean hit five homers and seven doubles and had an .849 OPS in 25 games as a hitter for High-A Brooklyn. He has six hits over his first eight games as a hitter for Binghamton. The 22-year-old pitched five innings of two-hit ball on Wednesday against Harrisburg. McLean was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma State.

**RELIABLE RAMDS:** Right-hander **Wilkin Ramos** tossed a scoreless inning in relief on Saturday night. Ramos has not allowed a run over his first 12 appearances of the season. He is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA over 17 innings with an 18-to-3 strikeoutto-walk ratio. He ranks second in the Eastern League with six saves.



-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. -AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.
