TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints eliminated a pair of one-run deficits and scored seven unanswered runs in an 8-6 victory in Toledo to snap their six-game losing skid. After Toledo took a 1-0 after three and a 2-1 lead after the fourth, the Saints scored a pair of runs in the fifth on a Payton Eeles home run and a Chris Williams RBI single. In the sixth, Dalton Shuffield and Rylan Bannon hit two-run singles, followed by a Williams sacrifice fly. Williams drove in three, going 3-for-4 on the night. Randy Dobnak picked up his eighth win, tying the league lead, throwing 5.0 innings of two-run ball. Jeff Brigham picked up his first save of the season by getting the final four outs.

WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH: Chris Williams hit his 11th home run of the season on Friday and the 42nd of his Saints career. He is now just one away from tying Mark Contreras for the franchise lead at 43.

In the month of July, Williams has clubbed six home runs, tied for the most in the International League. He also ranks among league leaders with his .707 slugging percentage, good for sixth and his 29 total bases, also tied for the sixth most in July. His 1.061 OPS this month is the best of any month he's had in 2024 and nearly double his .544 OPS in June.

BRIGHAM BRINGING IT: Over his last five appearances, Jeff Brigham has been locked in, allowing one earned run over his last 7.2 innings (1.17 ERA), striking out 10 in that span. All 10 of those strikeouts have come in his last three outings and also rank as the most among Saints' relievers in July.

TROUBLE IN TOLEDO: Fifth Third Field has historically been a tough place for the Saints to hit in over the last four seasons. Here is how the Saints offense stacks up among road venues they have played at least 12 games in since 2021, sorted by batting average:

REHAB ROUNDTABLE: After the Minnesota Twins reinstated Zack Weiss and sent him outright to St. Paul, the Saints now have one Major League Rehab assignment on their roster in Brock Stewart. Stewart has made three appearances, most recently on July 19. Over the three outings, he has pitched 3.0 innings, allowed one hit, one earned run, walked two and struck out five.

ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .450 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in nine of the 11 games he's played in, drawing six walks and been hit by a pitch four times. <u>He is fourth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .454 across three levels.</u>

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 44 games since May 21, he has hit .342 (55-for-161), with 10 home runs, drawing 32 walks to 46 strikeouts, owning a 1.027 OPS. Since June 1, Severino is second in the IL in batting average at .352, second in on-base percentage at .464 and third in OPS, at 1.041, ranking fifth in slugging percentage with a .579 mark. His 27 walks since the start of June are the fifth-most in the league.

TWINS UPDATE: The Minnesota Twins return from the All-Star Break tonight with a two-game series against Milwaukee. In the All-Star Game, Willi Castro went 0-for-1 as the Twins' lone representative to play in the game.

LAST APPEARANCE: 7/12 @ LOU...made first relief appearance of the season, entering the game in the fourth, throwing the final 5.0 innings of the game...allowed one run on a solo home run, giving up two hits, walking none and striking out two...retired 15 of the 17 batters that he faced, allowing a solo home run to Jacob Hurtubise with one out in the fourth...only other batter to reach was PJ Higgins on a two-out single in the fifth...went on to retire the final 10 batters faced...recorded eight outs in the air and three on the ground...primarily used his cutter, throwing it 27% of the time, getting four of his five whiffs on it...did not factor into the decision in a 5-1 Saints loss.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 7/5 v GWN...made eighth start of the season, pitching a season-high 6.0 innings, allowing four runs on six hits, walking two and striking out four...three of four runs allowed scored in the second inning with two outs...allowed five consecutive hits, four singles and a double...in the third, gave up a triple to Eddie Rosario, who scored on a sacrifice fly...retired nine of final 10 batters, with the lone runner reaching on a dropped third strike...received third win in 11-5 Saints victory.

FROM THE TWINS TO THE TWINS: The last 2 seasons for Plutko have been spent in the KBO, where he has dominated for the LG Twins, going 26-8 between the 2022 and 2023 seasons. After signing for \$500,000 in 2022, he went 15-5 in his first season, re-signing for \$ 1.4 million in 2023. He followed that campaign with a season that saw him go 11-3, but did not make it to the championship series due to a hip injury.

REMEMBER THE PAC 12: Plutko finished his career as one of the best pitchers in program history at UCLA, where he finished his three-year stint there with second-most wins (29), starts (52) and IP (351.1) in school history. His career ERA of 2.25 and 272 career strikeouts both rank 7th on UCLA's all-time lists. His sister, Sara, was a three-year soccer letterwinner at University of Oregon and his wife, Allison, was a four-year gymnast at UCLA and was on same team as gold medalist Carly Patterson.

LEAVE A MESSAGE AFTER THE TONE: When he was promoted to Triple-A Columbus (Cleveland organization) in September, 2021 he missed the phone call from Cleveland's Director of Player Personnel Carter Hawkins because he was at a friend's wedding. They had just got done saying, "I Do" and got done taking the bridal party photos. Got a call from Cleveland and he put it straight to voice mail. When the call came again his wife Allison prodded him to answer because it could be important, so he did.

NOT PERFECT, BUT STILL PRETTY GOOD: On June 2, 2018, Plutko was spinning a gem with Columbus, not allowing a baserunner until the ninth inning at Syracuse when he issued a one-out walk. He followed that with a fly out and a strikeout to finish off the no-hitter. It was just the ninth complete-game no-hitter in the IL since 2005. It continued a stellar stretch for Plutko, who took a no-hitter into the sixth just two starts prior with Cleveland against the Chicago Cubs
