On July 4, the Nuts leave town... but Dark Side of the Diamond, with Echoes of Pink Floyd playing to Wizard of Oz will take over Jackson Field for a special Independence Day evening at the park.

Last Night: Whitecaps 15, Locos 9. Tigers 2023 2nd-rounder Max Anderson swatted two of West Michigan's four home runs in a 17-hit attack, powering the Caps to victory in the series opener. Lansing collected 11 hits in the loss, with leadoff hitter Jonny Butler going 2-for-4 with a walk, single, triple and three runs scored.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jaksa and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.

On Deck: Tomorrow's 90s Night / Coors Light Thirsty Thursday; Pink Out the Park / Breast Cancer Awareness Night arrives Friday with postgame LAFCU Fireworks.

Lug•Notes

Streaking: Euribiel Ángeles brings a team-high 10-game hitting streak into tonight after going 2-for-4 with a walk yesterday. Brayan Buelvas went 1-for-5 last night to extend his on-base streak to 13 games.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.260), runs (367), total bases (922), triples (29), slugging percentage (.401) and OPS (.752), and is tied for 1st in on-base percentage (.351) while ranking 2nd in base hits (597) and doubles (120).

On the Radar: Tonight's Lugnuts starter, Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang, is not yet listed among MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Athletics prospects, but he comes in as former Fangraphs prospect analyst Nathaniel Stoltz's No. 10 A's prospect. Stoltz writes, "I think he's probably the most underrated prospect in the system... Zhuang's two best pitches [fastball and splitter] + command are tough for anyone in the system to equal."

Stopping the Skid: Lansing enters tonight on a season-high eight-game losing streak, dropping weekend contests on June 15-16 to Cedar Rapids, losing all five games last week at Beloit, and falling in the series opener last night. The longest losing streak in team history is ten games, set from July 24-August 2, 2003 (and halted with a 9-4 six-inning victory at West Michigan on August 3) and equaled from June 27-July 7, 2013 (ended by a 6-2 win at Bowling Green in a game started by future Tiger **Daniel Norris**).

Prospecting: Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 24), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 29).

Nothing but Goose Eggs: 2022-23 Lugnuts pitcher Grant Holman has pitched 28 2/3 scoreless innings between Double-A and Triple-A this season, 19 1/3 with Midland and 9 1/3 innings with Las Vegas, the most scoreless innings for any MiLB pitcher. Holman tossed 2 1/3 scoreless innings last night, fanning two.

Today in Lugnuts History

2014: Trailing 6-5 to West Michigan with two outs and no one on in the bottom of the 9th, David Harris singled to left-center, Chaz Frank tripled him in to tie the game, and Zac Reininger tossed a wild pitch to give the Lugnuts a 7-6 walk-off win. It was Reininger's first wild pitch of the year.

2016: The first seven Lugnuts batters in the bottom of the eighth inning all reached base and scored, helping the Lugnuts complete a four-game sweep of the West Michigan Whitecaps, 12-9, to open the second half. The game ended with a 5-3-6 double play.

In a Nutshell: After not pitching in 2023, dominated in Stockton to open the season, earning promotion to Lansing May 29 and making his Lugnuts debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on June 2, becoming the 942nd all-time Lugnut and the 13th different starting pitcher this season... name is pronounced "Chen Jong-Ow Jwahng"... works with interpreter Yen Po "Rambo" Wang... nicknamed "Z."

First Start: Struggled in the first inning vs. Peoria, allowing three runs on two walks and three hits, including a two-out, two-run triple by Michael Curialle... set down the final ten batters faced, with five strikeouts, in a 5-3 Lugnuts seven-inning victory.

Last Appearance: Pitched the 4th, 5th and 6th innings at Beloit on June 21 in relief of Grant Judkins... took over with a 1-0 lead, but allowed the game-tying run on a Josh Zamora single, Jorge Caballero double and Torin Montgomery RBI groundout in the 4th inning... struck out the side in the 5th... struck out two in a perfect 6th... departed with a 3-1 lead, only to see Beloit rally to walk off against Mitch Myers in the 9th, 4-3.

Hometown Heroes: Giants pitcher Kai-Wei Teng is the only 2024 Major Leaguer from Taiwan, though Teng is currently with the Sacramento River Cats... there have been 17 Major Leaguers all-time from Taiwan, the first being Chin-Feng Chen of the Dodgers, who played from 2002-2005... the Yankees' Chien-Ming Wang (2005-09, 2011-13, 2016) has the most career wins (68), the Orioles/Marlins' Wei-Yin Chen (2012-19) has the most career innings pitched (1,064 2/3), and Cleveland's Yu Chang (2019-23) has the most offensive records, from games played (235) to runs (72) to hits (121) to homers (20).

Record-Setters: In Lugnuts franchise history, the first Taiwanese players were Po-Hsuan Keng, who pitched primarily out of the bullpen for the Nuts from 2005-2007, and Chi-Hung Chen, who a starting pitcher in 2005-06 and 2008... last year, Brock Whittlesey broke Keng's franchise record of most career appearances... Whittlesey pitched in 103 games from 2021-23, while Keng appeared in 94... Cheng owns the Lugnuts' franchise record for most career innings pitched (374), with Keng ranking second (202); Cheng also ranks first in games started (67), career wins (23), losses (20), starts (67), strikeouts (367), runs (188), hits (360), and walks (189).

Path to Lansing: Pitched at National Taiwan Sport University, signing with the Athletics in November 2021 for approx. \$500,000... debuted in 2022 with Stockton, making eight starts from April 12 - June 1, 2022... did not pitch again until April 10, 2024, a hiatus of 679 days between professional appearances... excelled with Stockton this season, never allowing more than one run in an appearance... of nine total appearances with the Ports, did not walk a batter in seven of them.

What's in a Name: CPBL Stats reports: Family Name: Zhuang Chen | Given Name: Zhang-Ao

"We received more information regarding this naming arrangement issue. According to the representative from the A's organisation, they are fully aware of the double-barrelled family name... the player's family decided to go with the "Chen Zhang-Ao Zhuang" format. He will be known in English romanisation as Chen Zhang-Ao (given name) Zhuang (family name)."

In a Nutshell: Thrilled that his Boston Celtics are NBA champions... wore his Bruins Patrice Bergeron sweater during NHL postseason.. one of four 2022 draft picks on the roster (Henry Bolte, 2nd; Jacob Watters, 4th; Blaze Pontes, 16th)... opened second Midwest League season in a pitching piggyback tandem with Grant Judkins... @JakeGarland25... notable splits:

- Home: 1.27 ERA, 3 BB, 15 K, .176 in 21 1/3 IP | Road: 4.56 ERA, 11 BB, 11 K, .274 in 23 2/3 IP

History: On June 13, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAAAII-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands thus all root for Boston-area teams.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall, 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.
