Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.

HEATING UP: Esmerlyn Valdez was hit by a pitch on Tueday to extend his on-base streak to 15 games. During the streak, Valdez is hitting .275/.403/.529 with four doubles, three home runs, 14 RBIs, six walks, and 10 runs scored. Jesus Castillo previously owned the longest on-base streak by a Marauder this year when he reached base safely in his first 15 games of the season. It's currently the second-longest active streak in the FSL, only trailing Tarpons C Tomas Frick (16 games).
