### EARLY DEFICIT TOO MUCH DESPITE LATE RALLY

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp sent 10 men to the plate and scored six runs in the top of the seventh but the eight-run deficit was too large to overcome as they fell 12-10 to the Nashville Sounds Thursday night at First Horizon Park. The Sounds took a 10-2 lead heading to the seventh. Jacksonville rallied with a six-run seventh, sending 10 men to the plate to cut the deficit to 10-8. Nashville added some space in the bottom of the seventh, to take a 12-8 lead. In the top of the ninth the Jumbo Shrimp brought the tying run to the plate but were unable to keep the rally going to fall short 12-10 in game three of the series.

### X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 36 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 58-for-151 at the plate, slashing .384/.430/.483/.913 with six doubles, three home runs, 22 RBIs and 34 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to the league leader in the International League in batting average (.358) and fifth in OBP (.431). Among the 276 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards ranks second in swinging-strike rate (3.7 percent).

### AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 46 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 49-for-162 (.302/.383/.704/1.087) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 47 RBIs and 33 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 14.2 percent of the time in 2023.

### NEED FOR SPEED

Xavier Edwards stole a base successfully on Thursday, pushing his personal streak to 23 attempts in a row without getting caught. The Jumbo Shrimp as a whole have been one of the best teams in baseball in stealing bases; Jacksonville's 84.7 percent stolen base success rate is second in Triple-A to Norfolk and fourth out of the 120 full season MiLB teams. No Jumbo Shrimp has been caught stealing since July 9.

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Following their 12-10 loss to Nashville on Thursday, 14 of Jacksonville's last 21 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 92 games played thus far in 2023, 51 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 23-28 (.451) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer.

### ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 - and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. In the other 12 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 4-8, with all four of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those eight defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 30 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -25 against their other second-half opponents (Durham, Worcester & Nashville).

### MINIMUM EFFICIENCY

Over the entirety of their six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9, the Jumbo Shrimp walked just 20 Knights. Jacksonville has followed that up with a whopping 49 walks over their last six games, including 11 on Saturday against Worcester, which matched a season-high. The Jumbo Shrimp have thrown 1117 pitches during the 52 innings they've played since that series (21.5 per inning). In comparison, the WooSox and Sounds have tossed 750 in 45 innings over the five games, an average of 16.7 per inning. Jacksonville has stunningly walked at least seven batters in six consecutive games.

### SHRIMP BITES

Following a four game winning streak to start their series in Charlotte from July 4-7, Jacksonville has lost five of their last seven games... The Jumbo Shrimp are 7-7 against the Sounds this season. Nashville has outscored Jacksonville 78-64 in those games... Devin Smeltzer has thrown at least five IP in four of his last five starts, the club is 3-2 in this span.

### ABOUT DEVIN

-In the summer of 2015, Smeltzer played collegiate summer baseball for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks of the Cape Cod Baseball League, where he was co-MVP of the league's all-star game, and tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in which he missed a perfect game by a single walk.

-The San Diego Padres selected him in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB draft, but he chose to enroll at Florida Gulf Coast University to play college baseball for the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles rather than sign with the Padres.
