FOR STARTERS: The Rocket City Trash Pandas continue a six-game homestand against the Chicago Cubs affiliate Knoxville Smokies on Thursday with a doubleheader to make up Tuesday's postponement. Both clubs are looking to bounce back this week, as Knoxville dropped four of six to Chattanooga while Rocket City lost four of six in Biloxi.

FIRST SHUTOUT OF 2026: Joel Hurtado (W, 1-1), Leonard Garcia, and Kenyon Yovan combined for a four-hit shut-out—the club's first of the 2026 season on Wednesday morning, 6-0 in front of 6,086 fans on Education Day. Tucker Flint, and Matthew Lugo each had two hits while Wade Meckler hit his team-leading fourth home run.

MECKLER LEADS THE WAY: Wade Meckler has reached in 16 of 17 games played since joining the team on 4/7, and leads the league with a .377 batting average.

THE RBI MACHINE: Harold Coll has 10 RBIs over his last seven games, T-2nd in Double-A since 4/21. He became just the fourth Trash Panda to reach double digit RBIs in a series last week, and the first since Sam Brown in 2024 (joining Luis Avilés Jr. in 2021 and Orlando Martínez in 2022).

- The 10 RBIs led the league last week.
- His 22 RBIs lead the league, and is 2nd in all of Double-A ... it is also the most in club history, 22 games into a season..
- Coll has been hit by a pitch six times so far this season, which is T-1st in all of Double-A.

RUN SCORERS: Gustavo Campero has played in 17 of 22 games, but leads the league, and is T-2nd in Double-A with 22 runs scored ... Raudi Rodriguez is T-2nd in the league with 19 runs scored.

GETTIN' RAUDI: Angels No. 15 prospect Raudi Rodriguez is 9-for-27 (.333) over his last seven games with two home runs, five RBIs, six walks, and a Double-A-most 11 runs scored since 4/21.

- Raudi has reached base safely in 13-straight games, scored a run in seven-straight games.

SCORING RUNS: The Pandas are 2nd in the league, and rank 6th in Double-A with 138 runs scored (6.3 per game), and scored 4+ runs in 20 of 22 games.

SCORING IS UP IN THE SL: Through the first 22 games this season, Southern League teams are averaging 5.4 runs per game, over a run higher than last season through 22 games at 4.1 in 2025.

- It's the most runs per game in the digital era since 2005 ... One of the primary reasons is in 2026, the walk rate is 12.7% per plate appearance, by far the highest since 2005.
- The 189 home runs is the second-most through 22 games since 2005.

AGAINST THE SMOKIES: The Trash Pandas are 74-79 all-time against the Knoxville Smokies (formerly Tennessee Smokies), including a 38-35 mark at Toyota Field and 36-44 on the road in Knoxville/Kodak. In the first meeting this season (April 7-12 in Knoxville), Rocket City dropped four of six despite holding a lead in every game, surrendering advantages of 7, 4, 3, 2, and 1 runs. Last season, the Trash Pandas went 11-18 against the Cubs affiliate, including a 6-9 record in Madison. The clubs will meet 24 times in 2026, with Knoxville returning to Toyota Field July 21-26 and Rocket City heading back to Knoxville August 11-16.

RISP AND BASES LOADED BREAKDOWN: The Trash Pandas have a .408 OBP, and 110 RBI with runners in scoring position, which leads the league, and is T-3rd in Double-A.

- The numbers increase with runners in scoring position and two outs, with a .419 OBP and 46 RBIs, which is 2nd in Double-A
- With the bases loaded, Rocket City has a Double-A-best .487 OBP, a Double-A most 10 walks, and 30 RBIs.

ON THE MOUND: Through the first 22 games, the Trash Pandas pitching staff holds a 5.87 ERA, which is last in the Southern League, and 29th out of 30 teams in Double-A. Amarillo ranks 30th with a 6.33 ERA.

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Wade Meckler leads the league in batting (.377), and OBP (.493), 2nd in OPS (1.100), and slugging (.607), and T-5th in hits (23), and runs (16) ... Gustavo Campero is 1st in the SL with 22 runs scored ... Matthew Lugo is 7th in the league with a .419 OBP ... Nick Rodriguez is T-5th in the league in doubles (6) ... Raudi Rodriguez ranks T-2nd in runs (19), T-6th in walks (16), and T-8th in stolen bases (8) ... Harold Coll is 1st in HBP (6), and RBIs (22) ... Jose Gonzalez is T-7th in strikeouts (22), and T-10th in innings pitched (20.2) ... Austin Gordon is 9th in innings pitched (22.0) ... Camden Minacci is T-2nd in appearances (9) ... Aneurys Zabala is T-7th in appearances (8).

MR. PANDA: OF Tucker Flint and David Calabrese are second and third in club history in games played for the Rocket City Trash Pandas.

MAKING THE JUMP FROM LOW-A: INF Harold Coll, INF Nick Rodriguez, and OF Raudi Rodriguez are all making the jump from Low-A to Double-A, bypassing High-A Tri-City altogether.

NEWEST TRASH PANDA: OF Elijah Dunham was reinstated from the Temporary Inactive List on Monday after he and his wife Kinley welcomed their second daughter, Josie Kate, on 4/16.

LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: RHP Coleman Crow became the 49th player in franchise history to make their Major League debut, doing so during the (cont Page 2)

2026 GAME INFORMATION

Milwaukee Brewers' game on on April 17 in Miami. Crow joins fellow pitching alums **Walbert Urena** (3/26 for LAA) and **George Klassen** (4/5 for LAA) on making their MLB debuts this season. Originally selected by the Angels, Crow was acquired by Milwaukee in December 2023 after prior stints in the Angels and Mets organizations. Crow spent part of the 2022-23 season with Rocket City, where he ranked among the franchise's career leaders in innings pitched (152), strikeouts (159), wins (11), and starts (27). He earned Southern League Pitcher of the Week honors three times in 2022 and was named Pitcher of the Month in June of that season. Notably, Crow threw six hitless innings in a combined no-hitter on April 8, 2023, vs. Chattanooga, in a seven-inning game at Toyota Field. The infamous game included Rocket City issuing five walks, four hit batters, and committing an error, allowing seven runs without surrendering a hit—one of the rare instances in professional baseball history of a team throwing a no-hitter and losing. RHP **George Klassen**, 24, made his Major League debut with the Los Angeles Angels on Sunday against Seattle at Angel Stadium, becoming the 48th former Trash Panda to reach the Majors, and second so far in 2026. A native of West Bend, Indiana, Klassen worked 2.2 innings, allowing two runs while striking out four, and the Angels went on to win the game 8-7 in 11 innings. Ranked as the Angels' No. 4 prospect by MLB Pipeline, Klassen was a key member of Rocket City's 2025 rotation, earning a Futures Game selection and ranking among the franchise leaders in starts during his first full Double-A season. **Walbert Urena** became the 47th player in franchise history to make his Major League debut, doing so during the Los Angeles Angels' Opening Day win over the Houston Astros on March 26.

HIGH SCHOOL TEAMMATES REUNITE: RHP **Camden Minacci**, and INF **Nick Rodriguez** reunite in Rocket City after being teammates at Tampa Jesuit High School. Minacci was the Florida 6A Player of the Year in 2020, and Rodriguez, a year younger, graduating in 2021. Both played under head coach Miguel Menendez.

2026 SCHEDULE: The complete 138-game schedule will run from April 3 to Sunday, September 13 ... The first half of the season will conclude with a six-game series against Montgomery at Toyota Field from June 16-21. The regular season will wrap up with another six-game series at Chattanooga, scheduled for September 8-13. The final home series at Toyota Field will take place from September 1-6 against Montgomery.

GLOBAL BASEBALL SERIES: The Trash Pandas wrapped up their final tune-up before Opening Night with a 6-3 win over Japan's Toyota Red Cruisers on April 1 at Toyota Field. Tucker Flint led the way offensively, homering twice and reaching base four times. The victory capped the three-game Global Baseball Series in front of a crowd of 4,355. The Red Cruisers opened the series with a win over Alabama A&M on Monday, while the Trash Pandas topped UAH on Tuesday before Wednesday's finale.

2025 SEASON IN REVIEW: The Trash Pandas, managed by **Andy Schatzley** concluded their fifth season with a 45-92 record, finishing fourth in the Southern League's North Division, 35.5 games behind the champion Birmingham Barons. Rocket City went 24-45 at Toyota Field and 21-47 on the road, being outscored 637-445 for a -192 run differential. In the first half, the Trash Pandas posted a 24-44 record, placing fourth, 15 games back of the Chattanooga Lookouts. The team went 13-26 at home and 11-19 on the road, ending the half on a nine-game losing streak, including a seven-game sweep by Chattanooga, a new club record. Rocket City scored 219 runs while allowing 310. The second half saw the team finish 21-48, again fourth in the division and 22 games behind Birmingham. The Trash Pandas went 11-19 at home and 10-29 on the road, scoring 226 runs while surrendering 327.

NEW COACHING STAFF: **Joe Krugel** was named manager of the Rocket City Trash Pandas prior to the 2026 season, becoming the third manager in franchise history following **Jay Bell** (2021) and **Andy Schatzley** (2022-25). Krugel enters the role with more than 30 years of coaching experience at the professional and collegiate levels. The 2026 season marks his first year managing in the Angels' system after serving four seasons in a developmental leadership role. His all-time managerial record is 473-472. Joining Krugel in Madison this season are **Daren Brown** (Coach), **Tim Leveque** (Pitching Coach), **Doug Henry** (Assistant Pitching Coach), **Tony Jaramillo** (Hitting Coach), **Dylan Culwell** (Athletic Trainer), **Chase Galloway** (Assistant Athletic Trainer), **Matt Gabriel** (Strength and Conditioning Coach), **Tristan Saglime** (Game Planning Strategist), and

Joe Wike (Video Assistant).

ANGELS PROSPECTS: The veteran team has three players among the Angels' top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: OF **Raudi Rodriguez** (No. 15), RHP **Joel Hurtado** (No. 22), and RHP **Austin Gordon** (No. 26). Raudi impressed in 2026 Spring Training, batting .350 with an .835 OPS as a non-roster invitee. Last season, he dominated Low-A Inland Empire in 2025, hitting .281 with 49 extra-base hits and an .842 OPS across 125 games, earning multiple honors in 2025, including five Player of the Week awards, two Player of the Month selections, and the Angels Kenny Myers Memorial LAA Minor League Player of the Year. He also starred in the Arizona Fall League, batting .433 and earning AFL All-Star and Fall Stars Game MVP honors.

Hurtado pitched the majority of 2025 with Rocket City, going 5-6 with a 2.70 ERA (86.2 IP - 26 ER) and 56 strikeouts in 18 games (all starts). He led the staff in the first two months, recording five quality starts and 54.2 innings pitched. Before being shut down for load management in June, he ranked among the league leaders in starts, innings pitched, wins, ERA, WHIP, and groundouts.

In Gordon's first pro season in 2025 with Tri-City, he was 4-5 with a 5.44 ERA over 84.1 innings pitched, 27 walks, and 95 strikeouts.

NEW TO THE ANGELS ORGANIZATION: **Elijah Dunham** (NY), **Jose Gonzalez** (TEX), **Eybersson Polanco** (Rule 5, BOS), **Aneurys Zabala** (Japan), and **JJ D'Orozio** (ARI) are all making their Angels organizational debut this weekend. Nick Rodriguez becomes the first 2025 draft selection to reach the Double-A level.

SPORTS CENTER? MORE LIKE PANDA CENTER: The Trash Pandas grabbed national attention in 2025 with four highlights on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10 and one on the "Not Top 10," putting Rocket City in front of millions of viewers. Joe Redfield's leaping catch over the berm railing at Toyota Field landed at No. 6 on May 15, while intern Cason Clarke's tarp slip and barrel roll five days later earned a Not Top 10 nod. The team closed the season with three more Top 10 plays in the second-to-last week: Mac McCroskey's sliding stop at No. 8 on August 31, and Ben Gobbel earning back-to-back spots with a barehanded play (No. 9, Sept. 2) and diving snag (No. 7, Sept. 5). In total, Rocket City delivered four Top 10 moments—and one unforgettable blooper—that reached ESPN's massive national audience.

BUILDING THE BRAND: From January through August 2025, the Trash Pandas generated 41.3 million social media impressions—an average of 5.2 million per month—ranking second among all Double-A clubs and ninth across Minor League Baseball. The team's combined audience on Facebook, Instagram, Tik Tok, and X grew by 10% this year to 356,000 followers. Since debuting in 2021, the Trash Pandas have surpassed 200 million total impressions, establishing themselves as one of the most consistently engaging brands in MiLB. In addition, The Trash Pandas hit the West Coast in 2025 with four games (July 31 vs. Birmingham, August 14 vs. Knoxville, August 28 vs. Columbus, and September 10 vs. Chattanooga) televised and streamed live on FanDuel Sports Network West during the second half of the 2025 season.

THE 2025 ROSTER AND HISTORIC MOVEMENT: The Trash Pandas made a club record 128 roster moves during the 2025 season, reflecting a busy and ever-changing lineup. The moves were distributed throughout the year with eight in April, 13 in May, 28 in June—including 11 on June 17—plus 17 in July, 24 from August 1-6 (16 on August 2), six on June 2-3, and 16 in September. These frequent changes shaped the team's roster and contributed to the dynamic nature of the season. 57 players took the field for the Trash Pandas in 2025, which included 32 pitchers and 25 position players.

THE 2025 SHUFFLE: In May, the team added veteran pitchers Jordan Holloway, Sean Poppen, and José Quijada, while several positional moves included Christian Moore being promoted to Triple-A, Cole Fontenelle transferring to the ACL Angels, and Mitch Daly joining Rocket City. Injuries and development assignments also impacted the roster. June saw recalls, releases, and transfers involving players such as Sam Aldegheri, Oscar Colás, Jared Southard, Corey Holland, and AJ Block. Coach brought the promotions of Brady Choban, Denzer Guzman, and Nelson Rada, while injuries, releases, and new arrivals from Triple-A and High-A continued to shuffle the roster.
