SAN ANTONIO TAKES SERIES OPENER IN FRISCO:

The Frisco RoughRiders traded runs in the first inning but could not keep up with the San Antonio Missions in a 9-2 loss on Tuesday at Riders Field. After San Antonio (24-22) scored in the top of the first, Frisco (20-25) responded with a run in the bottom half. **Evan Carter** doubled, **Thomas Saggese** bunted him over and **Aaron Zavala** brought Carter in on a sacrifice fly. Frisco, however, did not score again for the next six innings. **Ryan Garcia** (1-4) started for Frisco and needed 80 pitches to get through three innings. The last of which was a scoreless frame but was charged with three runs on the day and three walks. **Juan Mejia** entered in the fourth inning with the bases loaded and no outs; he ended the inning with just one inherited runner scoring. Mejia went two scoreless innings before giving up three runs in the sixth. The RoughRiders put a run on the board in the eighth inning when **Aaron Zavala** scored from first base on **Dustin Harris'** double to right center. Zavala had been hit by a pitch earlier in the inning. He went 1-for-1 in the ballgame with two free passes and the sac fly. Nolan Watson (3-2) pitched five innings for San Antonio with three hits and one run allowed. The Frisco bullpen was highlighted by **Michael Brewer's** 1.2 scoreless innings, followed by **Hever Bueno** holding San Antonio off the board in the eighth. With the win, San Antonio moved into a tie for first place in the South Division. The first half ends on June 25 with the top team in each division earning a playoff spot.

PLEASE CONNECT TO POWER:

Over the last 10 games, Frisco has hit just two home runs while batting .220/.332/.299/.631. The two home runs (from **Liam Hicks** and **Trevor Hauver**) are tied for the fewest in the league over the last 10 (tied with San Antonio). The Riders are averaging just 3.9 runs per game over the last 10 games, which is the second-fewest in the league (only in front of Northwest Arkansas, 2.2).

SCORE THEM ANY WAY YOU CAN:

The RoughRiders are hitting well this season with a .251/.354/.398/.752 slashline while being third in the Texas League in runs per game, averaging 5.5 runs per contest. They are fourth in average, third in OBP, fifth in SLG and fourth in OPS despite being tied for seventh with 42 home runs on the year.

DOESN'T GET BETTER THAN TREVOR:

RoughRiders utility man **Trevor Hauver** was hitting just .163 through April 26th, but he has been on fire since. Over his last 22 games, Hauver is hitting .300 (24-for-80)/.356/.475/.831 with two home runs and 15 RBIs. In his last 15 games, the former Arizona State Sun Devil is hitting .310 (18-for-58) with 14 RBIs. In 2022 with Frisco, Hauver hit .230/.432/.492/.924 over 21 games after starting the season in High-A Hickory.

DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 19 bags in 42 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 50 steals, which would be far by a career high. The RoughRiders are third in fewest caught stealings in the league with just eight while stealing 67 bases (89 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Liam Hicks** hitting Frisco's sixth grand slam of the season on Saturday. They are the only team with six grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball and the only team with more than four. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese**). Frisco also has a 1.230 OPS with the bags full, which is third in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.391 and Triple-A St. Paul, 1.255).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 29 games, he is hitting .359 (42-for-117)/.417/.521/.938 with eight doubles, a triple, three homers, 22 RBIs and 22 runs. In the month of May, he is batting .361/.411/.515/.926 and has four games with three or more hits to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .302 (51-for-169)/.374/.432/.806 through the first 40 games while ranking sixth in the Texas League in hits (51), tied for eighth in doubles (11) and tied for second in stolen bases (18). Over his last 36 games, he is batting .318/.395/.464/.859. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (119).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 229 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .354 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is tied for first in the league with 34 walks while **Evan Carter** is sixth in OBP (.416) in the league and third in the league with 32 walks.

ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2006), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2023 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2023 season as the No. 78 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Over three starts on May 5th, May 11th and May 17th, Leiter allowed just three earned runs over 17.0 IP (1.59 ERA) while striking out 25 and walking five.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No.1 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen as a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July 10th before his start against San Antonio.

-Pitched a 1-2-3 inning on nine pitches in The SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game from Dodger Stadium on July 16th.

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
