### FRES-NOTES

**DOUBLE-TROUBLE AGAINST THE PORTS:** The Fresno Grizzlies (24-30, 62-57) dropped the finale of their six-game series against the Stockton Ports (18-36, 44-74) 12-7 Sunday evening from Chukchansi Park. The Grizzlies fell to 81-33 all-time versus the Ports with a 20-10 overall record this year. The 20 victories against Stockton are the second-most wins against an opponent in Grizzlies' single-season history. The Grizzlies went 26-4 against the Ports in 2022. With a San Jose Glants 9-8 loss to Modesto, Fresno still sits seven games back in the California League North Division second half standings with 12 contests left to play (six against one another). The Grizzlies offense started the contest red-hot, as the first five batters in the Fresno lineup all reached base. Leadoff hitter Aldan Longwells mashed a triple to right-center field and scurried home after a wild pitch. Robert Calaz extended the Grizzlies' advantage when he roped a double down the third base line, netting Caleb Hobson and Braylen Wimmer. Felix Tena supplemented a single, scoring Blake Wright to round out the five-run first inning. The Grizzlies were held scoreless until the bottom of the seventh, when Longwell added to his line, depositing a pitch over the center-field wall. Fresno was able to push across one last run in the ninth on a Calaz single to center, plating Longwell. Fresno righty McCade Brown was unhittable in his two innings of work, with the only baserunner allowed coming on a leadoff throwing error. Brown punched out four in his near-perfect outing, Four Grizzlies relievers followed Brown with a tough performance. The quartet of rams were tagged for a combined 12 runs (nine earned) on 13 hits (eight doubles, season-high) and two walks. Brady Hill (2-5) was pinned with the setback. Hunter Mann was the lone bright spot for the Fresno bullpen, striking out the side in his one frame of action. Overall, the Grizzlies struck out 15 batters, two shy of a season-high.

HIGHWAY 99: The Fresno Grizzlies and Visalia Rawhide (Arizona Diamondbacks Single-A affiliate) start a six-game series tonight at Valley Strong Ballpark. This is the last of two regular season series between the clubs in 2024 and the only meeting in Visalia. The Grizzlies are 26-4 at home (three sweeps) and 47-13 all-time against the Rawhide. The Grizzlies have also won 25 of their last 31 contests against their Highway 99 rivals. On the other side, four of the Rawhide's 13 wins have come via one-run walk-offs. The two cities are 39.26 miles from one another, or if you drive non-stop, 43 minutes or so. From Fresno to Visalia, you would drive in a southeast direction, following the CA 99 route.

STU MAKES THE START: LHP Stu Flesland III will toe the rubber tonight for the Grizzlies. Flesland III was selected by the Rockies in the 11th round (Pick 322) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Washington. He played three years at Washington, earning all Pac-12 honors in his final season Flesland III attended Mt. Spokane High School in Spokane, Washington and was teammates with fellow Grizzlies RHP Brady Hill.

**TRANSACTION-HEAVY MONTH:** Since July 30, the Grizzlies have had 29 transactions. Prior to that date, the Grizzlies had 27 total transactions for the season. Among those 29 transactions, 14 of them have been players added to the Grizzlies' active roster. Six of those other moves have been promotions to upper-levels, three have been Rockies' releases, four have been injury list placements and two have involved MLB rehab players.

THE 2024 DRAFT PICKS HAVE ARRIVED: The Grizzlies have added six 2024 Rockies' Draft Picks to their roster. 2nd-round OF Jared Thomas (Texas), 4th-round INF Blake Wright (Clemson), 6th-round LHP Konner Eaton (George Mason), 7th-round RHP Fidel Ulloa (LSU), 13th-round LHP Justin Loer (LSU) and 19th-round RHP Nathan Blasick (New Orleans).

**WELCOME KELVIN HIDALGO:** The Rockies have added 19-year-old Kelvin Hidalgo to the Grizzlies roster. In 2023, Hidalgo was named the Dominican Summer League MVP and is currently in his first season stateside. He is most likely the Grizzlies' 2025 starting shortstop.

CONGRATULATIONS TO ANDY PEREZ: The Rockies have announced that INF Andy Perez has been promoted to High-A Spokane. Perez, who has been a mainstay in Fresno for two years, has been one of the most reliable players in recent Grizzlies' memory. Being the youngest player for two years, Perez has shown immense development, beating most of his offensive statistics in his second season. In two years, Perez appeared in 228 games, batting .268/.302/.374/.676 with 10 homers, 14 triples, 38 doubles, 117 RBI, 127 runs, 41 walks and 36 stolen base: He also finished with a Fresno career .951 fielding percentage, which was between second base (1.000), shortstop (.959) and third base (.913). Perez finished tied for seventh all-time in Grizzlies career triples (14) and reached the Top-10 in Single-Season triples twice (7, 2023 & 2024). Congratulations to Andy Perez!

**NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP:** Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot (41 games), he has reached base 72 times in 193 plate appearances (37% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In 11 of those 41 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 36 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 9-for-35 (.273) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch (17-for-41, 41% of the time he reaches base in his first plate appearance). Eight of his nine hits have been singles with three of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 20 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (38/44 in stolen bases on the season).

**RUNNING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS:** Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson continues to climb the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Record Books with 38 stolen bases (Picked up his 35th on August 20, 6th inning vs. Stockton). He currently sits fifth all-time with those 38 stolen bases. Up next for Hobson is Dante Powell (1998), who had 41 stolen bases that year.

**TEN OUT OF TEN(A) FOR TRIPLES:** Grizzlies' OF Felix Tena is one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Record Books in Top 10 Single-Season Triples. Tena looks to catch former teammate Andy Perez (2023 and 2024), as well as Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jason Ellison (2004) and Calvin Murray (1999), who each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons.
