OKLAHOMA CITY BASEBALL CLUB (32-23) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (16-39)

RHP Ben Casparius (2-1, 2.57) vs. RHP Noah Davis (0-2, 6.52)

TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque lost game four last night, 14-5, against Oklahoma Clty, who won the series after claiming the first four games of the set ... Noah Davis is scheduled to make his first start since April 14 while Oklahoma City is expected to send Ben Casparius to the hill.

ATTENDANCE: The Isotopes have tallied the highest total attendance in all of Minor League Baseball with 203,582 fans over 31 openings.

SERIES SETBACKS: Albuquerque has lost six-straight series at home-the longest series losing streak at home in franchise history.

AGAINST OKC: Albuquerque falls to 3-13 against Oklahoma City on the year. The 13 losses are the most in a season against the Oklahoma City franchise (previous high: 12, 2022) with eight games to go in the 2024.

LOSING STREAK: Albuquerque has lost five-straight games overall (one to Salt Lake and four against Oklahoma City), the third losing streak of at least five games (long: eight, April 5-13).

IN FRONT: The Isotopes have not led over the first four games of a series for the second time this year (also: April 9-13 vs. Sugar Land, five games).

FIRST INNING TALLIES: The Isotopes allowed three first inning runs last night. On the year, they've relented 48-the secondmost in all of Minor League Baseball (most: Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, 52).

RISP: The Isotopes were just 2-for-10 with runners in scoring position last night. For the series, the club is 4-for-35.

XBH: Albuquerque allowed nine extra-base hits last night, the fourth time the Isotopes have yielded nine-plus in a game to Oklahoma City this year.

TOPES RUNS: Albuquerque hasn't plated six-plus runs in six of their last seven games after tallying at least six tallies in nine of their last 10 contests.

FIRST FOUR: The Isotopes have lost the first four games of a series for the third time this year and second against Oklahoma City (also: April 9-13 vs. Sugar Land and April 23-26 vs. Oklahoma City).

TALLIES ALLOWED: Oklahoma City has tallied double-digit runs in six of their last 11 contests against the Isotopes.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk registered his 15th multihit game of the year last night, second-straight and third in his last four contests. Swatted his 17th double of the year. Is 7-for-17 over the first four games of the series. Over his last 11 games, slashing .333/.362/.489 with four doubles, a homer and nine RBI.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard recorded his 22nd multi-hit contest of the year yesterday, tying Coco Montes for the team lead. He also recorded an RBI, his first since May 23 at Salt Lake. Is 3-for-21 in his last five games.

FAN FAVORITE: Coco Montes went hitless for the fifth time in May Thursday ... Mashed his seventh homer of the season Wednesday, first since May 17 vs. Sugar Land. It was his 49th homer in 265 games with the Isotopes.

BIG MIKE: Michael Toglia tallied his eighth multi-hit game of the year last night and second in his last three games. Also struck out three times, his third game with at least three punchouts ... Has a hit in 11 of his last 12 games, slashing .298/.389/.511 with two doubles, one triple, two homers and six walks.

HIS NAME IS DREW: Drew Romo tallied a hit Thursday to end his two-game hitless skid ... Hasn't multi-hit game since May 18.

COOLIN' OFF?: From April 21 - May 18, Romo slashed .450/.459/.725 with eight doubles, one triple, four homers and 20 RBI ... Over his last nine games, is hitting just .166 (6x36) with a triple and two homers; average has drop from .382 to .335.

BIG WILLIE STYLE: Willie MacIver collected his ninth multihit contest of the year, second-straight and third in his last four games. Is 6-for-12 over the span with two doubles and a homer.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 4th in average (.335) Aaron Schunk is T-3rd in doubles (17) ... Coco Montes is 3rd in average (.339), T-3rd in hits (64), 5th in OBP (.423), 6th in OPS (.968), 7th in total bases (103) and slugging (.557) and T-10th in walks (30) ... Sam Hilliard is 2nd in runs (43), 4th in total bases (112), T-4th in walks (32) and XBH (26), 6th in homers (11) and slugging (.560), T-6th in hits (61), 7th in OPS (.956), T-9th in triples (3) ... Julio Carreras is T-5th in stolen bases (15).

TEAM STATS: Offensively in MiLB, the club is 1st in total bases (937), triples (27) and hits (552), 2nd in slugging (.479), average (.282), OPS (.842) and doubles (121), 6th in runs (328) and 8th in homers (70)

200 RBI: Coco Montes became the fifth Isotope to tally 200 RBI with the club Saturday night, six days after Sam Hilliard 06.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.

- Pitched for the 2017 Cotuit Kettlers of the Cape Cod League
