#### EIGHT-RUN FOURTH PUSHES JACKSONVILLE TO WIN

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp rode an eight-run fourth to an 8-5 win over the Charlotte Knights Friday night. Home runs from **Deyvison De Los Santos** (11) and **Troy Johnston** (11) highlighted an eight-run, 11-batter fourth inning for the Jumbo Shrimp. Jacksonville also got RBI singles from **Harrison Spohn** and **Jakob Marsee**. **Agustín Ramírez** contributed a two-run single in the frame. Charlotte's offense was sluggish until the fifth when they exploded for a five-spot but the offense couldn't overcome the deficit.

#### SLIP 'N SLIDE

Despite owning a 5.89 ERA through the first 15 games in August (third-worst in the International League), Jacksonville balanced that with the second-best batting average (.283) while going 8-7. On Monday, August 19, the Jumbo Shrimp were just 5.5 games behind first-place Columbus for the top spot in the IL. Since then, the Jumbo Shrimp have been free falling in the standings, falling to 10th in the International League. In their last 23 games, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .241/.304/.345/.649, which ranks 16th, 17th, 18th and 18th respectively. On the flip side, despite posting a 10-13 record, the pitching staff's ERA ranks sixth (4.38) and they're holding opponents to the fifthlowest batting average against (.248).

#### ONE RUN TO RULE THEM ALL

After Wednesday's 4-3 win, Jacksonville has now played in 51 one-run contests in 2024 and their 13th in their last 30 games. The Jumbo Shrimp are 8-5 in one-run games during this stretch. Jacksonville is being outscored by their opponents 146-121 since beating Toledo 7-6 on August 11.

#### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 31-37 (.456) record. Jacksonville has scored only 281 runs at home (4.1 per game), the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring over half-run more per game on the road, totaling 342 (4.7 per game). Meanwhile, also on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 336 runs (4.6 per game), the eighthfewest in Triple-A. They've yielded tied for the eighthfewest runs of any team at home (331, 4.9 per game). Thus, their run differential is +8 on the road, but -50 at home.

#### STRAIGHT AND NARROW

Of Jacksonville's 12 wins during the month of August, nine came by three runs or fewer, including six by just one run. The Jumbo Shrimp have played in 51 games this season decided by one run (24-27) the most in the International League. Jacksonville registered 85 contests (57.0 percent of total games, 39-46, .459) contests decided by three runs or fewer during the 2023 season. In 2024, their 91 games this season determined by these narrow margins represents 64.5 percent of the club's 141 games played thus far in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp are 48-43 (.527) in those tightly-decided contests.

#### LADIES FIRST

When Norfolk scored the game's first run on Sunday against Jacksonville, it marked the 17th consecutive home game for the Jumbo Shrimp in which the visiting team scored first. This streak, which dates back to July 30, has surprisingly seen Jacksonville go .529 in its contests at 121 Financial Ballpark, with a 9-8 record. Over the Jumbo Shrimp's 68 home games thus far in 2024, their opponent has scored first in 46 contests (67.6 percent). Jacksonville is 16-30 (.348) in those affairs.

#### IT GETS LATE EARLY OUT HERE

Over the last 23 games, Jacksonville's offense has really struggled against opposing bullpens. The relief corps of Nashville, Norfolk, Louisville and Charlotte have combined to surrender only 30 runs, 24 earned, on 69 hits (6.5 H/9) in 96.0 innings (2.25 ERA, 102 K, 37 BB) against the Jumbo Shrimp over this 23-game run. From the sixth inning on during this stretch, Jacksonville is a woeful 56-for-301 (.186) at the plate, scratching across only 22 runs in 78 innings.

#### SHRIMP BITES

With Charlotte scoring first in game two on Wednesday, opponents have opened the scoring against Jacksonville in 12 of the last 19 games. In nine of those contests, opponents have scored in the first inning...The Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff has a 4.60 ERA against the Knights this season, which ranks as the fifth-lowest among their 2024 foes. (NOR, MEM, NAS and GWN). Jacksonville has had 82 different players take the field in 2024, setting a new club record from (2022, 79)... They've also had 26 different starting pitchers take the hill in 2024, which ties a club record, also set in 2022.
