YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 6-1. Bowie took a 4-0 lead in the second inning with an RBI single by Joseph Rosa and a three-run double by Billy Cook. Two runs scored on an error in the fifth to extend the Baysox lead to 6-0. **Victor Bericoto** broke the shutout with a solo homer in the fifth, his first at Double-A. **Raymond Burgos** pitched 1.2 scoreless innings, his third straight scoreless outing. Bowie starter Cade Povich threw five innings and allowed one run with nine strikeouts.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-five at Prince George's Stadium from April 25-29, with the finale post-poned until June for rain. In their series in Bowie from June 13-18, the Baysox won four-of-seven. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will play a six-game series against the Baysox at The Diamond from August 8-13.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 14-4 in their last 18 games since June 18, including taking five-of-six in last week's series at Reading to open the second half of the season. They won six straight from June 23-30, their longest winning streak since a seven-game stretch from April 28-May 5, 2022, and matched that streak with six consecutive wins from July 1-6. Over the last 18 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .254 (148-for-582) with 22 homers, 28 doubles and have scored 98 runs. In that same stretch, the Richmond pitching staff has a 2.70 ERA (48 ER/160.0 IP), the best in the league, with 209 strikeouts. Over the last 23 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to go 2-4 with a 2.41 ERA (22 ER/82.1 IP). For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.65 ERA is the best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 283.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 409.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.19 ERA, which is second-lowest in Double-A and the sixth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE BAYSOX opened the second half dropping four-of-six in last week's series against the Patriots. They are 4-8 in their last 12 games since June 25. Bowie's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including 3B Coby Mayo (No. 9), LHP Cade Povich (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 13), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 15), OF John Rhodes (No. 26) and RHP Jean Pinto (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes Mayo (No. 7), Povich (No. 11), Fabian (No. 15), McDermott (No. 17) and Rhodes (No. 19).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Carson Seymour takes the mound for his 12th Double-A start and his fourth against the Baysox. He pitched Tuesday's series opener and surrendered two runs over 31 innings in a no-decision with a season-high six strikeouts. He first faced the Baysox on April 25 in Bowie and surrendered two runs over three innings in a no-decision. He made a second start at Prince George's Stadium on June 16 and allowed one run over four innings. Among Eastern League pitchers (min. 60 IP), Seymour has the eighth-lowest ERA (3.54) and the fifth-highest groundball percentage (48.9). He also has the lowest HR/9 (0.44) in the Eastern League (min. 60). A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 119 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Connor Gillispie makes his fourth start of the season. He worked out of the bullpen on Tuesday night against the Flying Squirrels and surrendered a career-high-tying seven runs over 2.2 innings, including three homers. After posting a 2.74 ERA through his first 13 outings of the year, he has a 15.43 ERA (12 ER/7.0 IP) over his last two appearances since June 29. Tuesday was his first professional outing in his college stadium at The Diamond, where he was a pitcher for the VCU Rams. He was a first-team all-conference pitcher his final season in Richmond in 2019 prior to being drafted by the Oroles that year in the ninth round. Prior to his time at VCU, he attended The Miller School in Charlottesville, where he played for head coach Billy Wagner.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels are again at the top of the level in average attendance (6,501) and total attendance (273,043). The team's average attendance is the 13th-highest among the 120 MiLB teams.

RETURN OF THE MECK: On Friday, **Wade Meckler** went 0-for-4, snapping his 24-game on-base streak. It was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by **Luis Matos** (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also saw his 11-game run scored streak end, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. For the season, Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 200 PA) in batting average (.402) and on-base percentage (.471). He leads the Eastern League (min. 100 PA) in on-base percentage (.453) and is second in batting average (.360).

VAUN GONE WILD: Vaun Brown saw his 11-game hitting streak end on Saturday night, one game shy of matching Carter Williams (12 games) for the longest hit streak by a Richmond player this season. It was also the longest active hit streak in the Eastern League. In his last 12 games, Brown is batting .327 (17-for-52) with five homers, four doubles, 16 RBIs, 10 runs scored and no walks. Brown homered in back-to-back games on June 28 and 29 at Reading, totaling six RBIs in the two games. This week, he hit a three-run homer on Tuesday and added a solo shot on Friday. Brown has seven RBIs in his four games played this week against the Baysox.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base in 17 consecutive games dating back to June 18. For that stretch, he is batting .295 (18-for-61) with six doubles, two homers and 11 RBIs, adding eight walks. He is batting .307 (8-for-26) with two RBIs since the calendar flipped to July. Matheny also hit solo homers in back-to-back games on Tuesday and Wednesday to begin this week's series. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 103 walks, which is the fifth-most in franchise history. He is one behind fourth-place **Skyler Stromsmoe** (104). His .361 career on-base percentage is fourth-highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history (min. 600 PA).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas has picked up 13 RBIs over his last 11 games since June 24. From June 24-29, he collected nine RBIs over a four-game span, including a two-run homer on June 29 night at Reading. Last Sunday night, he added a sac fly and a solo homer. In his last 11 games, Thomas is batting .342 (14-for-41) with two homers, three doubles, a triple and 13 RBIs. For the season, he leads the Flying Squirrels with 40 RBIs. His season-high 10-game hit streak was snapped on Friday night.

LOVE LUCI: In his last 12 games since June 23, **Marco Luciano** is batting .326 (14-for-43) with two homers, five doubles, seven RBIs and 11 runs scored. On June 24, he tied his career high in hits, going 4-for-4. On Tuesday, he hit his 11th Double-A homer, a solo shot in the eighth inning.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: Flying Squirrels pitcher Carson Whisenhunt worked a scoreless third inning in Saturday night's SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Seattle's T-Mobile Park. In his outing, he struck out Mariners prospect Jonatan Clase and Orioles prospect Jackson Holliday before surrendering a single to Baltimore's Heston Kjerstad, who was stranded after a groundout by Angels minor leaguer Edgar Quero. Whisenhunt and former Flying Squirrels pitcher Kyle Harrison were selected to represent the Giants. Harrison pitched in last year's Futures Game at Dodger Stadium. Former Flying Squirrels pitcher Dan Otero was a member of the National League team's coaching staff. Whisenhunt was the sixth player to participate in the Futures Game as a member of the Flying Squirrels, including Tommy Joseph (2012), Tyler Beede (2015), Shaun Anderson (2018), Heliot Ramos (2021) and Harrison (2022). Other players who were selected for the Futures Game before or after playing in Richmond include Collin Balester (2007), Gary Brown (2011), Kyle Crick (2013), Jorge Guzman (2018), Kieran Lovegrove (2018), Luis Alexander Basabe (2018), Joey Bart (2019), Marco Luciano (2019) and David Villar (2022). Ramos also went to the Futures Game twice (2018 and 2019) before being selected a third time as a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021. Villar was picked in 2022 but was not eligible because he was in the majors at the time.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 2), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), OF Wade Meckler (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
