Today: It's a Coors Light Thirsty Thursday with \$2 domestic drafts and \$5 craft drafts, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, and the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers play the third game in a six-game series. Lansing and Great Lakes have split the first two games of the series. The Lugnuts are the only team in the Midwest League with a winning record against Great Lakes, bringing a 6-5 record into tonight's contest.

Yesterday: Loons 9, Lugnuts 7. Dalton Rushing swatted a two-run homer in the first inning, Frank Rodriguez knocked a three-run homer in a five-run third, and the Great Lakes Loons built a 9-1 lead and then hung on through a furious Lugnuts eighth-inning rally to win their first game of the series. CJ Rodriguez doubled twice in a six-run eighth for the Lugnuts in a loss.

Midwest League off day LUG•NOTES

Streaking: C Daniel Susac, Oakland's first round selection last year, has hit safely in ten straight games, collecting 18 hits in 38 at-bats during that stretch. Susac is third in the league in batting average (.304), base hits (85) and batting average on balls in play (BABIP,.380).

Singles Club: Susac's 61 singles is tied for second in the MWL with teammate Danny Bautista, Jr. Peoria's Nathan Church. is first with 75 singles.

Mercy: Mercer product Colby Thomas, the Oakland A's third round selection a year ago, has hit safely in all eight games he's played with the Lugnuts. Thomas is slashing .314/.351/.514 with five doubles, one triple and four steals since being called up from Single-A Stockton.

What Relief: In 25 2/3 combined innings since the All-Star Break, the Lugnuts' relief corps has allowed just three runs, two earned (0.70 ERA) while striking out 28 and giving up just 12 hits and seven walks (a 0.74 WHIP). Both of those earned runs were scored yesterday, provided by a two-out, two-run single in the eighth inning by Taylor Young off Christian Fernandez.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts' defense leads the league with 74 double plays this year, including one yesterday. That's six more than second-place South Bend. The Nuts' offense, meanwhile, has grounded into only 35 double plays this year, second lowest in the MWL to Dayton.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

2019: In front of 8,577 on Tribute to Burt Reynolds Night, Evan Edwards hit a two-run homer in the tenth to lift Clinton to a 5-4 victory. The Lugnuts wore special Burt Reynolds-themed black jerseys in the loss, plus there was a mustache competition, a car similar to the Bandit, dueling banjos, and more.

In a Nutshell: Opened season with Single-A Stockton... debuted in the MWL May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win over the Captains... one of ten starters for Lansing this season... family originally from New England, roots for Boston-area teams... @JakeGarland25.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg).

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.
