NUMERICAL QUICK ROSTER

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, seven players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Andrés Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Angel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was catcher Tyler Cropley and outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, development list player Holden Capps was on the Naturals' championship Series roster, while development list player Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021.

Follow The Leader

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the . Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Angel Zerpa.

STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- LHP Drew Parrish started yesterday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 38.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano starts today for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Angel Zerpa starts Saturday, April 16th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- LHP Asa Lacy started the home opener on Tuesday and will go ahead on Sunday, April 17th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 left-handed pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.
- RHP Alec Marsh started yesterday, Wednesday, April 13th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while *Baseball America* has him at No. 11.

TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in Baseball America's 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the <u>"Best Strike-Zone Discipline"</u> in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the "Best Defensive Catcher" in the system.
- SS Maikel Garcia is rated as having the "Best Infield Arm" in the system.
- RF Seuly Matias is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm" in the system.
- LHP Asa Lacy is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system. .
- LHP Angel Zerpa is rated as having the <u>"Best Control"</u> in the system.

WALK THIS WAY

NOTES

Shortstop Maikel Garcia has drawn 10 walks through the season's first five games, which is not just the most in the Texas League and all of Double-A, but tied for the third-most among ALL Minor League hitters as well.

- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more four times. He collected his first three-walk game on Wednesday 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
- In 27 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base times, for a cool .593 on-base percentage (6 hits + 10 walks) ... his OBP ranks fourth in the league and is the best among gualified Naturals hitters ... he is the only Natural that has reached base in all six games this season.

Last Saturday, right-handed pitcher Collin Snider made his Major League

- Snider is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 15 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas.
- Snider's first MLB appearance was a high-leverage situation, as he came on to pitch the 10th inning of a game tied 0-0 at Kauffman Stadium against Cleveland. He kept the Guardians off the board, with some defensive help from fellow 2021 Natural and 2022 debutante Bobby Witt Jr. and after the Royals walked it off in the bottom of the 10th for a 1-0 win, Snider was awarded his first MLB win in his debut.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: Scott Barlow, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont and Bobby Witt Jr. ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals.

FALL LEAGUE PHENOMS

The Kansas City Royals sent nine players to the Arizona Fall League in 2021 to play for the Surprise Saguaros ... of those nine, seven are on the Naturals roster.

- Zach Haake pitched in six games (five starts) and went 1-1 with a 6.61 ERA (12 ER in 16.1 IP) and 14 strikeouts ... Asa Lacy made four starts and went 2-0 with a 2.35 ERA (2 ER in 7.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts ... Alec Marsh made one start and went 1-0 with a 27.00 ERA (4 ER in 1.1 IP) and three strikeouts ... Stephen Woods Jr. pitched in 10 games (one start) and went 0-0 with a 4.67 ERA (9 ER in 17.1 IP) with 17 strikeouts.
- Nate Eaton played in 20 games, hitting .317 (26-for-82) with a .815 OPS and 13 runs batted in, he finished fourth on the team with 38 total bases ... Seuly Matias played in 22 games, hitting .188 (15-for-80) with a .712 OPS, six home runs and 20 runs batted in, both of which were tied for the team lead ... Jake Means played in 19 games, hitting .171 (12-for-70) with a .515 OPS and five runs batted in.

#36 CHRIS WIDGER • MANAGER

- Chris Widger will manage the Naturals after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by *Baseball America* following the 2021 season.
- 2022 marks Widger's seventh year in the Royals' organization, as he was slated to manage Advanced-A Wilmington in 2020 and led Burlington to the Appalachian League Championship Series in his first season as Manager in 2019. Prior to that, he was Wilmington's Bench Coach from 2016-18.
- Before joining the Royals organization, he managed the Independent League Camden Riversharks in 2015 and was their Pitching Coach from 2012-14.
- A third-round pick by Seattle in the 1992 Draft, Widger played in parts of 10 seasons in the Majors with the Mariners (1995-96, 2000), Expos (1997-2000), Yankees (2002), Cardinals (2003), White Sox (2005-06) and Orioles (2006), winning a World Series with Chicago in 2005.
- Widger and his wife, Whitney, reside in Pennsville, N.J., with their children: C.J., Ashlynn and Skylar.

#43 DERRICK LEWIS • PITCHING COACH

- Derrick Lewis is in his third season with the Royals' organization and second as pitching coach at Northwest Arkansas.
- He spent the previous 16 seasons in the Atlanta Braves' organization, the first 14 as a Minor League pitching coach and the last two as the Pitching Coordinator.
- Pitching coach timeline: 2004-07: GCL Braves (Gulf Coast League, RK)... 2008-10: Danville Braves (Appalachian League, RK)... 2011-13: Rome Braves (South Atlantic League, A)... 2014: Lynchburg Hillcats (Carolina League, A+)... 2015-2016: Carolina Mudcats (Carolina League, A+)... 2017: Mississippi Braves (Southern League, AA)
- He played seven seasons in the Braves' organization from 1997-2003, after being selected in the 20th round of the 1997 draft.
 - Lewis and his wife, Roslyn, reside in Charlotte, North Carolina, with their daughter, Skye and Son, Lake.



#6 ABRAHAM NÚÑEZ • HITTING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).

- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.

#23 MIKE JIRSCHLE • BENCH COACH








GAME-BY-GAME STARTERS (BY POSITION)






