ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Down 2-1 in the bottom of the eighth, Hudson Valley rallied for four runs to take a 5-2 lead en route to a victory, taking a two games to one series lead against Brooklyn. RHP **Sammy Tavarez** allowed all four runs (three unearned) in his second inning of relief. Brooklyn starter RHP **Carson Seymour** was masterful again, striking out nine over six innings of one-run ball. OF **Alex Ramirez** launched his third home run in the past six games, and OF **Stanley Consuegra** went 3-4 with a double and a run scored.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU FINISH: The Cyclones have a 3.45 ERA in July, good for second-best in the circuit behind Rome (3.33 ERA) and third best in High-A. However, the Cyclones have five blown saves, ranking as the most for a team in High-A with an ERA sub-4.00. In the month, Brooklyn starters have a 2.61 ERA (35 earned runs in 120.2 IP), while the bullpen has a 5.04 ERA (36 ER in 64.1 IP).

SCHWARTZ SWATTING: 1B **JT Schwartz** has two singles, three doubles, and a grand slam over the first three games of this series with the Renegades, going 6-12. The Mets' No. 19 prospect has hit two of his four home runs against Hudson Valley.

PALMER POUNDING HV: OF **Jaylen Palmer** leads the team with seven home runs. Four of those seven homers have come against Hudson Valley this season. Despite a .795 OPS against the Yankees affiliate, Palmer has a 44% strikeout rate in 18 games (28 strikeouts in 66 plate appearances).

RA-RA FOR RAMIREZ: No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** collected two more hits last night and has hits in 15 of his past 30 at bats with six multi-hit games over his past eight. In the span, Ramirez has a double, two home runs, and 13 RBIs.

CON SWAGGER: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has been

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The New York Yankees High-A farm club and the Cyclones have played 20 of 30 in the 2022 series. So far, the Renegades are 12-9. No. 3 prospect, and the No. 39 prospect in baseball, OF Jasson Dominguez has recently joined the team. on a tear since the start of the Greensboro series on July 12. Over his past 12 games, Consuegra is hitting .354 with a 1.093 OPS. In the span, the 21-year-old outfielder has been on base in 10 of the 12 games and has four multi-hit efforts.

NIC KNOWS: Last night, C/INF **Nic Gaddis** snapped a 13-game on-base streak, going 0-for-4. However, since June 21, the 2019 draftee has been on base in 23 of his past 26 games, posting a .422 OBP and a .878 OPS.

METS TRADE WATCH: Thursday night, the Mets made a deal with Cincinnati, bringing in OF **Tyler Naquin** and LHP **Philip Diehl** in exchange for two Low-A St. Lucie prospects 2B **Hector Rodriguez** and RHP **Jose Acuna**. The 2022 trade deadline is Tuesday, August 2 at 6 p.m. ET.

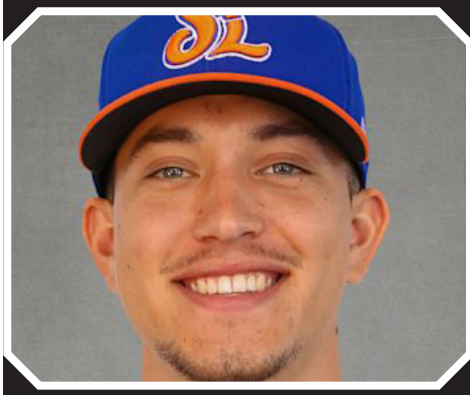
BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 48 home runs in the past 59 games (0.8 HR/G) after just seven over the team's first 34 games (0.2 HR/G).

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect.

SHINE BRIGHT LIKE A DOMIND: Dominic Hamel makes his fourth start with Brooklyn and first against Hudson Valley.

WALK CLUSTERS: Hamel's walks seem to come in bunches. In his July 9th start against Aberdeen, he walked back-to-back hitters in the fourth inning (one scored). In the July 16 start against Greensboro, Hamel walked the second and third batters back-to-back (one scored). In his July 23 start at Jersey Shore, Hamel walked both batters to start the second inning (both scored). Of the six runs allowed, four have been runners who reached on a walk.

PROMOTED: Dominic Hamel, who is the Mets No. 9 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie, joining the Cyclones on the Fourth of July.

ST. LUCIE: With the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, Hamel made 14 appearances and 13 starts, posting a 3.84 ERA in 63 1/3 innings. Hamel posted a 27% strikeout rate, 11% walk rate, and a 3.91 FIP.

DOM-INANT JUNE: Hamel posted a 2.84 ERA in June, making five starts. He struck out 30 and walked 10 in 25 1/3 innings.

BEGINNINGS: The Arizona native was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist, signing for \$755,300 and made two appearances for the Florida Complex League Mets last year.

COLLEGE DAYS: Hamel pitched at Dallas Baptist in 2020 and 2021 after two seasons at Yavapai College. At Dallas Baptist in his senior season, Hamel set a school record with 136 strikeouts in 91 2/3 innings.
