First career grand slam in 1<sup>st</sup> on 5/30 vs. WCH... 7G hit streak (11x25), 5/18-5/26... Currently ranked as #14 STL prospect by MLB.com... Finished 2019 with a team-high 43 extra-base hits for High-A Palm Beach, including 5G with 2 2B...ranked among FSL leaders in 2B (2nd), XBH (3rd), BB (7th) and TB (7th)... Won August, 2019 MiLB Player of Month - .346 (28x81), 4 HR, 14 RBI, 11 2B, 1 3B, 23 G...In 145 games at TCU, hit .347 in 145 games with 28 homers, 26 doubles, 109 walks, a .465 OBP and a .986 fielding percentage...ranked by MLB.com as Cardinals' No. 23 prospect entering 2021... 2nd round pick in 2018 out of Texas Christian University
