### FRISCO MOUNTS COMEBACK WIN IN FRONT OF MASSIVE CROWD:

The Frisco RoughRiders scored seven unanswered runs, taking the lead on an **Evan Carter** three-run homer in the seventh inning, and beat the Springfield Cardinals 9-6 in front of 9,335 fans at Riders Field on Sunday. Frisco (31-37) closed the Springfield series on a three-game win streak to split the series and conclude the first half of the 2023 season. Springfield (34-35) had a chance to win the series with four-run leads on Friday and Sunday but the Riders erased both deficits. The Cardinals threatened Frisco's 9-6 lead in the ninth, putting the tying run aboard with one out on three straight singles. **Antoine Kelly** induced a double-play ball and got out of the inning unscathed to record the save. The RoughRiders struck first on Sunday, starting with Carter's leadoff double in the first inning. He scored on **Thomas Saggese's** RBI double, and **Aaron Zavala** chipped in a two-out RBI single to make it 2-0. Springfield, however, scored six unanswered runs and led 6-2 until the seventh inning. Frisco strung together four straight hits to open the seventh and knocked Springfield's starter Kenny Hernandez out of the game. Ryan Shreve (0-2) entered and allowed three more hits, including Carter's go-ahead home run to the lazy river in right field. **Alex Speas** (3-0) did not allow a hit or run in 1.2 innings for the win. **Justin Slaten** also had a scoreless appearance, holding off Springfield in the eighth inning without a base runner allowed. **Luisangel Acuña**, Zavala and Saggese all had two hits with a double. The RoughRiders racked up 13 hits and stranded just three runners, while nine different batters recorded a hit. That included **Josh Hatcher**, who added a pinch-hit single in the eighth inning. **Liam Hicks** followed with an RBI single to score an insurance run.

### CONSISTENCY NEEDED:

With **Juan Mejia's** start Saturday for the RoughRiders, he became the 10th different starting pitcher in June for Frisco, which is the most in the league this month. Over their last 12 games, the Riders starting staff has just one game of at least five innings with a 8.41 ERA (38ER/40.2IP). In June, Frisco has a starters ERA of 6.99 (65ER/83.2IP) over 22 games. The good news is the bullpen has been strong in June, owning a 4.03 ERA in June.

### RISP-ECT THIS:

This season, the Riders are just sixth in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .258, though Frisco is fourth with 265 RBIs with RISP. Over the last 11 games (5-6 record), Frisco is hitting .283 (30-for-106) in those situations.

### THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

**Thomas Saggese** has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over a 14-game hitting streak, Saggese is hitting .456 (26-for-57)/.515/.825/1.340 with four doubles, five home runs, 16 RBIs, seven walks, 13 runs scored and a steal. Since June 10th, he is fourth in all of MiLB in batting average, hitting .456. Among those who have played at least 50 games, Saggese is first on the team with a .312 batting average, 10 homers, 53 RBIs, 47 runs scored and .874 OPS. For his efforts against Springfield, Saggese was named the Texas League Player of the Week, hitting .591 (13-for-22)/.654/.955/1.609 with three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven RBIs, seven runs scored and four walks.

### AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

**Thomas Saggese** has been fantastic on first pitches this season, leading the Texas League with a .619 average (13-for-21) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.684 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .438 (21-for-48) on the initial offering while his 21 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

### SPEED KILLS:

**Luisangel Acuña** leads the league in steals with 30 and is on pace for a career-best 61 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 98 bases in 115 attempts (85 percent).

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)).

### ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .297 (77-for-259)/.359/.440/.799 through the first 60 games. Over his last 56 games, he is batting .307/.372/.461/.833. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (112).

### WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 338 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .355 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is still first in the league with 44 walks despite being promoted to Triple-A Round Rock on Tuesday.

### ABOUT SETH

-Seth went to Mountain View High School in Arizona, which has produced four MLB players. Scott Lydy (MLB in 1993), Brian Banks (1996-2003), Shea Hillenbrand (2001-2007) and Brad Mills (2009-2015) all were Mountain View Toros.

-Nordlin was the highest-drafted pitcher alumni (13th round in 2017) from of Mountain View since Spencer Moran was drafted in the 11th round in 2014 out of Concordia.

-In his sophomore season at GateWay Community College, Nordlin went 4-3 with a 1.91 ERA before being drafted by the Rangers. That season, he had 123 strikeouts to 17 walks in 88.0 innings for Geckos.

### 2023 SEASON

-Selected in the Minor League Rule 5 draft by the Minnesota Twins in December of 2022 and assigned to Double-A Wichita.

-Released by the Twins on June 4th and signed by the Rangers on June 6th.

### 2022 SEASON

-Designated as one of two "long relief" pitchers for Frisco, along with Tai Tiedemann at the beginning of the year.

-Promoted to Triple-A Round Rock for spot start on July 14th at El Paso, throwing 3.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits while striking out three and walking one.

-Made first Double-A start on July 27th at Springfield, throwing four shutout innings in a 5-2 win.

### 2021 SEASON

-Pitched in 20 games with 11 starts for High-A Hickory.

-Struggled as a starter, going 0-5 with a 6.48 ERA, but pitched well in relief: 3-0, 3.27 ERA.

-Nordlin's 83.0 innings were the second-most on the Crawdads, just trailing Avery Weems (85.1).

### 2019-2020 SEASON

-Missed entire 2019 season with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Was one of team's most-used relievers in Arizona Fall League in 2020, (16.0 IP, 14 H, 9 R, 5 BB, 20 K).
