On this day in 1981, the Sounds set a new franchise record with 20 runs scored in against the Knoxville Blue Jays at Greer Stadium. That mark has been equaled once since then (May 20, 2000 at Colorado Springs).

Urías On the Mend: Luis Urías continued his rehab stint, playing shortstop for the first time with Nashville last night. He has hit safely in back-to-back games, batting .174 (4-for-23) with a double and RBI. Urías has been on the 60-day injured list with a strained left hamstring since March 31.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Brice Turang and OF Joey Wiemer. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 625-544 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Gasser took the loss in his last start on May 25 vs. Iowa. The southpaw gave up seven runs (5 ER) over 4.0 innings. He tied a career high in hits and runs allowed in the defeat. Gasser threw 88 pitches and 56 strikes in the 12-5 loss to the I-Cubs.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Gasser's second start all-time against Charlotte, with both starts coming at Truist Field. He picked up the win on September 9, tossing 6.2 innings of one-run baseball with eight strikeouts. He totaled 95 pitches and 57 strikes in his then first Triple-A win.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Is on Nashville's Opening Day roster for the first time in his career.
- Did not allow a run in 4.0+ innings in first start of season against Memphis.
- Was first Nashville starter to pitch into the sixth in a start this season with 5.1 frames on April 12.
- Is averaging 5.375 strikeouts a start and has the most strikeouts by a Sounds starter this season (8, three times, last was on May 19 at Durham).
- Allowed a career-high three home runs on April 30 vs. Omaha one each 5/25 in the third, fourth and fifth innings.
