TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Comets (Los Angeles Dodgers affiliate) gear up for their fourth game of the six-game series on Friday night. Oklahoma City won their first game of the series by a score of 5-4 on Thursday night. RF Zach Erhard hit solo homers in the first and third inning to give Oklahoma City a 2-0 lead. The Express got on the board with four runs in the fourth. 2B John Taylor drove in two runs with a double and RF Gilberto Celestino's groundout scored a run to give the E-Train their first lead of the game. LF Trevor Hauver drove in Taylor to tally another run for the Express in the inning. In the fifth, Erhard drove a run in, cutting the deficit to one. CF Alek Thomas drove in two with a base hit, pushing Oklahoma City to a 5-4 edge. Round Rock was held to two hits through the final five frames, dropping Thursday night's contest 5-4.

WHERE WE STAND

With their loss on Wednesday, the Express hold a 2-1 advantage halfway through the six-game set at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark...are now 15-15 in road games...have won 6 of last 10, 9 of 15, 10 of 20 G since 5/13.

TURNING THE CORNER

Since May 19, the Express have scored 7.2 runs per game (109 runs/15 games) with a 9-6 record...previous 18 G (4/27 - 5/18), had scored 3.3 runs per game (61 runs) with a 4-14 record.

BRICKTOWN BLUES

Express looking for their first series win in Oklahoma City since August 9-14, 2022...in six-game sets, E-Train are 0-8-2 vs OKC since the start of 2023...8 of 13 games played between the two teams have been decided by one run this year.

SAVED BY SUPAK

RHP Trey Supak is set to make his 12th start of the season on Friday night...owns a 2-3 record and a 5.47 ERA...tossed 11.0 IP allowing 5 runs and striking out 9 over his 2 wins...owns the lowest hard-hit rate (27.3%) among PCL starting pitchers (min. 200 PA)...is 0-1 with a 2.89 ERA (3 ER/9.1 IP) with 5 strikeouts and 3 in 2 starts against the Comets this year... He is 24.2 innings away from 900 in his pro career and 40 strikeouts away from 800.

GO, DIEGO, GO

INF Diego Castillo extended his hitting streak to 10 games on Thursday night, the longest streak for the Express this season...slashing .476/.500/.619 with 6 2B, 16 RBI, 7 R, 4 BB and 6 SO during the streak...hit .238 (10-42) in 1st 12 games with Round Rock...batting .408 (29-71) in 17 games since.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK

Since making his Triple-A debut with Round Rock on May 29, INF John Taylor has appeared in 6 games with an RBI in 4 of the 6...slashing .238/.385/.524 with 5 H, HR, 7 RBI and 5 BB...driven in 5 runs through 3 G against Oklahoma City with a 1.021 OPS.

THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 1981

34-year-old Nolan Ryan tossed a complete-game shutout against his former team as the Houston Astros defeated the New York Mets, 3-0 at the Astrodome. Ryan allowed only five hits while walking two and striking out 10. He improved to 5-3 and lowered his ERA to a miniscule 1.39, much of the postgame discussion centered around his fourth-inning walk to Lee Mazzilli. Ryan became the all-time Major League leader in walks with 1,776, passing Early Wynn.

"I'm not ashamed of the record," Ryan said postgame. "It means I've been around long enough to pitch a lot in the major leagues." It was the 134th time Ryan struck out 10 or more batters in a game, also a Major League record. Luis Pujols, cousin of Albert Pujols, drove in Houston's first run with an RBI single in the second inning that scored Art Howe. Cesar Cedeño added another run in the sixth on a sacrifice fly before a Terry Puhl sacrifice fly in the seventh brought home the final run of the game.

While Ryan's fastball was always a problem for hitters, it was his curveball that baffled the Mets on this day. "When his curve is working, it's a 50-50 thing in the batters' minds," catcher Alan Ashby said postgame. Ashby watched from the bench while Pujols handled the catching duties. "They don't know which pitch to look for, and that's when he's almost unhittable."

MANAGER KYLE MOORE
The 2026 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kyle Moore's first season with the E-Train. In 2025, Moore served as the bench coach for Triple-A Iowa of the Chicago Cubs organization. He previously served as the skipper in the Baltimore chain with Short-Season Aberdeen (2018), Low-A Delmarva (2019), High-A Aberdeen (2021) and Double-A Bowie (2022-23) - combining for a 321-286 (.529) record over five seasons. The 2019 Delmarva Shorebirds were named the 2019 MiLB Team of the Year, finishing with a 90-48 record, the most wins across all of MiLB that season.
A catcher in his playing days, Moore signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He played collegiately at University of Alabama after winning three high school state titles with Edgewood (Ala.) Academy. Moore transitioned to coaching in 2012 as a strength and conditioning coach with Delmarva.

PITCHING COACH DAVE BORKOWSKI
Former MLB pitcher Dave Borkowski (Boar-COW-ski) enters his fourth season on Round Rock's staff and 17th year in coaching. He will serve as the Express' pitching coach in 2026, reprising the role he held from 2023-24 after spending the 2025 campaign as the club's bullpen coach. Borkowski spent five seasons as a minor league instructor in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system.
His tenure also includes an 11-year stint as a minor league coach for the Houston Astros. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Borkowski enjoyed a 15-year professional playing career that saw him post a 13-20 record and 5.87 ERA across seven MLB seasons with the Detroit Tigers (1999-2001), Baltimore Orioles (2004), and Houston (2006-08). He was originally selected by Detroit in the 11th round of the 1995 MLB Draft out of Sterling Heights (Mich.) High School.

BENCH COACH CHASE LAMBIN
Lambin enters his sixth year on the Express staff and will reprise his role as bench coach for the fifth straight year (beg. 2022). The 2026 campaign will mark Lambin's 12th in the Texas organization. He has previous stops as a hitting coach for High-A Down East (2019), Low-A Hickory (2018), Short-A Spokane (2017), and the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers (2016). He first joined the Rangers as a member of the Spokane coaching staff in 2015.
Lambin was selected by the New York Mets in the 34th round of the 2002 June draft out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and played in the Mets, Marlins, Nationals, Twins, and Royals organizations. He also has international experience, spending the 2009 season with Chiba Lotte in Japan. The versatile defender appeared at every position except catcher over the course of his career.

BULLPEN COACH JULIO VALDEZ
Valdez enters his seventh year in the organization and first as the Rangers' Triple-A pitching coach after serving in the same role with Double-A Frisco (2025), High-A Hickory (2024), Low-A Down East (2023), Rookie-level ACL Rangers (2022), and DSL Rangers (2020-21). During the canceled 2020 campaign, Valdez worked with pitchers at the Dominican Republic complex and Fall Developmental League in Arizona.
The Florida native played baseball at Alabama State University from 2012-16. He attended Lake Howell (Fla.) High School, where he posted a career 15-4 record and 2.20 ERA, and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Valdez transitioned to an assistant coach role at Alabama State in 2017 before becoming Director of Pitching at the Texas Pitching Institute in El Paso, Texas. He spent two years at TPI before taking the same role at Baseball Rebellion in Durham, N.C., before joining the Rangers.

HITTING COACH MATT LAWSON
Former Rangers farmhand Matt Lawson returns for a fifth straight season as Round Rock's hitting coach. Lawson previously served as an assistant coach, hitting instructor, and recruiting coordinator at his alma mater, Missouri State University, from 2014-21. The Missouri native was selected by the Rangers in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft and played seven professional seasons as an infielder in the Texas (2007-10), Seattle (2010), and Cleveland (2011-13) organizations. With Texas, he was named Short-A Spokane's team MVP as a rookie in 2007 and a league All-Star for High-A Bakersfield (2009) and Double-A Frisco (2010) before he was involved in the 2010 trade that brought Cliff Lee to the Rangers.
He holds a degree in psychology and a graduate degree in sports management.

DEVELOPMENT COACH KAWIKA EMSLEY-PAI
Emsley-Pai enters his sixth year in the Texas organization and returns to the Express as a development coach, this after beginning his Rangers tenure in the same role during the 2021 season. He has also served as Double-A Frisco's bench coach (2025) and was a development coach with Frisco (2023-24) and High-A Hickory (2022). He served as the Centralia (Wash.) College head coach and education advocate from 2019-21. Prior to his stint at Centralia, Emsley-Pai had a three-year stint as an education advocate at a maximum-security juvenile rehabilitation facility.
A former catcher in the minor leagues, Emsley-Pai spent six seasons with the Diamondbacks (2010) and Pirates (2011-15) organizations, topping out at Double-A Altoona in 2014. He was originally selected by Arizona in the 10th round of the 2010 June draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho after spending his freshman year at the University of Texas in 2008.

Was named PCL Pitcher of the Month for Aug., posting a league-best 1.71 ERA (5 ER/26.1 IP) and 0.99 WHIP in 5 GS for RR during the month.
- Traded to the Milwaukee Brewers with minor league outfielder Keon Broxton for infielder Jason Rogers, December 17, 2015.
- Selected by Pittsburgh in Competitive Balance Round B of the First-Year Player Draft in 2014 (73rd overall).
- Helped La Grange High School win the 3A 2013 UIL Texas State Baseball Championship...3A was played at Disch-Falk Field...Supak was named to the All-Tournament team.
