The Nuts are 3-8 during a 12-game, 13-day homestand vs. Fort Wayne and Beloit. Right-hander **Osvaldo Berrios** makes his 11th start of the year for the Nuts, coming off a seven-inning stint last start, opposed by Beloit lefty **Zach King**.

Last Night: Sky Carp 14, Lugnuts 5. Trailing 5-2 going to the 6th inning, the Sky Carp scored 12 unanswered runs to win a rout in front of 7,007 fans in Lansing. In the loss, Denzel Clarke crushed a 452-foot two-run homer for the Nuts.

On Deck: After a day off tomorrow, the Lugnuts travel to Eastlake, Ohio, for a six-game series.

Welcome to Town: OF **Kevin Richards** has announced his presence to the Midwest League with authority after getting called up from Single-A Stockton due to **Lazaro Armenteros**'s injury, delivering a game-tying ninth-inning home run on the first pitch he saw on Friday night, then following up yesterday by going 2-for-3 with an outfield assist, a single, a double, a walk and two runs scored.

Back in the Order: OF **Gabriel Maciel** returns to the Lugnuts starting lineup today for his first appearance since leaving Thursday's game in his first plate appearance after fouling a pitch off his leg. The native Brazilian is slashing .322/.408/.433 in his first Lugnuts season with 12 walks compared to 12 strikeouts in 28 games.

Not a One: The Lugnuts are the only team in the Midwest League without a sacrifice bunt. Quad Cities and Peoria are tied for the league lead with 17 sacrifices.

Hit Parade: Beloit has compiled 35 hits (18, 17) in the last two games against Lugnuts pitching, and 47 hits over the last three games. Not coincidentally, the Sky Carp have scored 26 runs the last two games and 32 runs over the past three games.

Closing Things Out: Today is the final meeting of the 12-game season series between Beloit and Lansing, with the Sky Carp winning nine of the first 11 matchups with a team ERA of 2.78 in those games (compared to the Lugnuts' 4.61 ERA). The Sky Carp's best hitters in the season series: Nasim Nuñez (.389/.488/.556, 14-for-36, six walks, seven steals in 10 games), Davis Bradshaw (.387/.457/.484, 12-for-31 in nine games) and Marcus Chiu (.483/.545/.586, 14-for-29 in eight games). Victor Mesa, Jr., meanwhile, has drawn nine walks in ten games, posting a .477 OBP. The Lugnuts' most effective hitter against the Sky Carp has been Lawrence Butler (.353/.405/.559, 12-for-34 with four doubles and one home run in 10 games).

Nuts to the Show: 6-foot-2, 280-pound pitcher Max Castillo (2018) made his MLB debut for the Toronto Blue Jays on June 19, becoming the 169th all-time Lugnut to reach The Show. He is the 8th former Lugnut to reach the Majors this year, joining Oakland A's pitchers Zach Logue (2018) and Zach Jackson (2017) and infielder Christian Lopes (2013); Toronto Blue Jays utilityman Vinny Capra (2018) and catcher Gabriel Moreno (2019); Seattle Mariners reliever Danny Young (2016) and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher Josh Winckowski (2019) as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

2016: The first seven Lugnuts batters in the bottom of the eighth inning all reached base and scored, helping the Lugnuts complete a four-game sweep of the West Michigan Whitecaps, 12-9, to open the second half. The game ended with a 5-3-6 double play.

2017: In his first Midwest League game, catcher Javier Hernandez lined a gamewinning RBI single in the bottom of the ninth and the Lugnuts beat the Bowling Green Hot Rods, 4-3. The Hot Rods had erased a 3-0 deficit on a Josh Lowe three-run homer in the eighth.

Personal: Loves going fishing in his spare time... grew up rooting for the Yankees as an Alex Rodriguez fan and, just like Rodriguez, began as a shortstop before moving to third base (and eventually to pitching, unlike A-Rod, in order to get drafted)... drafted in the 20th round in 2017 from the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School (Gurabo, Puerto Rico) and signed away from Alabama State University commitment... was first scouted at the Perfect Game national showcase... said that he talked least to the Athletics of any MLB team approaching the draft.

PRBHS History: Founded in 2002 by Ed Correa, who first used the Los Angeles Dodgers' Dominican complex in Las Palmas, DR, in 1999 as what would become the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School three years later... produced Carlos Correa (1st overall in 2012), Hiram Burgos, Joe Jiménez, Vimael Machin, Jesmuel Valentin and Christian Vázquez... in 2021, produced one draftee, Astros 16th-rounder Gaby Nieves... in 2017, when Berríos was drafted, he was one of four players drafted from PRBHS.


Puerto Rican Baseball: Puerto Rico has produced four Hall of Famers thus far in Roberto Clemente, Iván Rodríguez, Roberto Alomar and Orlando Cepeda, with 1996 Lugnuts outfielder Carlos Beltrán and current catcher Yadier Molina each with their myn Hall of Fame cases... today's Major League stars from Puerto Rico are led by Javier Báez of the Tigers, Francisco Lindor of the Mets, José Berríos of the Blue Jays, and Carlos Correa of the Twins... Lindor, like Osvaldo Berrios, was born in Caguas.

Pro Debut - 2017 in AZL: Made professional debut on July 1, 2017, vs. AZL Giants, allowing three runs on five hits in 1 2/3... final appearance of the year was his best (3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K) vs. AZL SD1 on September 2... gave up .302 avg. to lefties .. 366 to righties... base-stealers were 4-for-6.

2018 in AZL: Relieved Daulton Jefferies in the second game of the season, tossing 3 2/3 innings (6 H, 1 R, 5 K) vs. AZL Giants Black... pitched six-inning gem (3 H, 1 R, 4 K) on the 4th of July vs. AZL White Sox... gave up just two earned runs in final 17 2/3 innings... limited righties to .252 avg./.628 OPS while lefties hit .348/.860... base-stealers were 6-for-6.

2019 in AZL and the NYPL: Opened season with AZL A's Gold, making four appearances... in first game of the year, appeared in relief on June 17 and struck out six AZL Cubs2 in 3 2/3 innings, allowing only one hit... tossed five-inning gem (4 H, 1 R, 4 K) on July 1 vs. AZL Dodgers, earning promotion to Short-Season A Vermont... finished the year with best outing for the Lake Monsters, August 29 vs. Connecticut in Game 2 of doubleheader (5 IP, 1 H, 2 BB, 4 K)... with Vermont, gave up .326 avg./.855 OPS to right-handed hitters while lefties hit .241/.770... base-stealers went 1-for-1 in the AZL and 7-for-9 in the New York-Penn League.

2021 in High-A Central: Promoted to Lansing on August 19, replacing starter Jack Cushing (promoted to Double-A Midland; the RockHounds' 2022 Opening Day starter, coincidentally)... enjoyed a smashing debut, limiting Great Lakes to two runs in six innings, August 20 at Dow Diamond... followed up with six scoreless innings of seven-hit relief at West Michigan, August 26, earning the win... faced the Whitecaps in back-to-back home starts to end the year, allowing two runs in three innings in a no-decision September 15, and suffering the loss on the final day of the year, September 19: 2 1/3 IP, 6 H, 8 R, 3 BB, 3 K, serving up a solo HR to Jake Holton in the 1st inning and knocked out by a six-run whitecaps won the game, 19-4, to end the season with an identical 58-62 record as the Lugnuts.

Winter Ball: Pitched for Cangrejeros de Santurce – a cangrejero is a crabber – in Liga de Béisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente, who finished 17-15 in 3rd place and were knocked out in the playoff semifinals by champs Criollos de Caguas... appeared in six games in relief, his first time ever pitching regularly in relief: 5.87 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 2 BB, 6 K... the Santurce Cangrejeros were the same team that the great Clemente himself played for in the early 1950s... the 1954-55 Cangrejeros had both Clemente and Willie Mays in their outfield.

2022 - Return to Lansing: Followed Joey Estes to the mound and pitched the final three innings in relief against Michigan State in the 2022 Crosstown Showdown presented by Delta Dental, allowing one run and striking out three in Lugnuts' 3-2 win... moved into the starting rotation when Jake Walkinshaw and Hogan Harris landed on the Injured List just prior to the season... made 2022 debut April 12th at West Michigan, allowing fiver runs in four innings (one in the 1st, four in the 2nd)... departed with Lugnuts trailing 5-4... Nuts tied the game in the 9th on a pinch-hit RBI single from Jonny Butter and took a 10-6 lead in the 11th, only to see West Michigan walk off with 11-10 victory thanks to a five-run rally... May 13 vs. Dayton: Blanked the Dragons in the first two innings, but gave up a two-run HB in the 3rd to Jose Torres, an RBI double to Alex McGarry in the 4th, and two more runs in the 5th before departing... in defeat, struck out seven batters in 4 2/3 innings, setting a new season high... Lugnuts fell in defeat, 6-2, and struck out 16 times against Dayton starter Connor Phillips and two relievers... May 19 at Great Lakes: Used 98 pitches (64 strikes) to go 5 2/3 innings in an 8-5 loss to the Loons... allowed three runs in 2nd, (Edwin Rios 3-R HR) and two runs in 4th... May 25 at Beloit: tossed first quality start of the year, striking out eight while walking none in allowing three runs in six innings... bullpen allowed eight runs in the 7th, erasing a 4-3 Lugnuts lead in an 11-4 Sky Carp victory... June 1 vs. Cedar Rapids: gave up three runs in the 1st, an Alerick Soularie 3-run HR in the 3rd and a Kevin Fedko solo HR in a two-run rally in the 5th; pitches 4 1/3 innings in all, allowing eight runs (seven earned), as Lugnuts fall, 10-2... June 7 at West Michigan: victimized by a five-run second inning, then allowed two more in the 5th in a 9-5 loss to the Caps.
