LOCK IT IN: After clinching the second half championship in the Carolina League North Division, the Fredericksburg Nationals begin the 2024 Carolina League Divisional Playoffs tonight at home in game one against the Carolina Mudcats, Single-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Fredericksburg and Carolina met 18 times in the regular season, with FXBG going 10-8 against the Mudcats. LHP Alex Clemmey gets the game one start for the FredNats. Clemmey was acquired in late July from Cleveland at the deadline in the Lane Thomas deal. In six FredNat starts, he has a 4.30 ERA in 23 innings pitched. He faced Carolina once so far with FXBG, pitching four innings and allowing just one run on one hit. Clemmey faces Daniel Corniel for Carolina, who went 1-1 a 6.60 ERA in 15 innings, allowing 11 earned runs against the Freddies this season.

PLAYOFF SCHEDULE: Fredericksburg hosts Carolina in game one of the best-of-three series tonight, and then travels to Five County Stadium for game two on Thursday and game three (if nec.) on Friday. If FXBG advances, they would play a road game on Sunday, September 15 at the winner of the Kannapolis/Charleston series, and then would host games two and three (if nec.) of the championship.

SEASON SERIES RECAP: Fredericksburg and Carolina finished the regular season with the two best overall records in the Carolina League, and played a tight regular season series. The two teams played three six-game series, splitting two. FXBG won four games out of six in Carolina's first trip to Fredericksburg back in July before the All-Star break. The FredNats narrowly outscored Carolina 70-67 during the regular season, posting a team slash line of .231/.337/.341/.678 compared to the Mudcats' .213/.326/.295/.621.

HE'S SOMETHING ELSE: Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Carolina League since arriving in Fredericksburg on May 1. In August alone, Sykora made six starts, going 4-0 with an 0.88 ERA. In 30.2 innings pitched, he struck out 49 hitters (11 more than the second-best pitcher) and walked just three the entire month. He was named Washington's FredNat Pitcher of the Month for August (duh), and today was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for August by Milb. Not only did he dominate in August, but among Milb pitchers with at least 80 innings pitched this year at any level, Sykora leads all of Milb in strikeout percentage (39.9%), WHIP (0.83) and is second in strikeout-to-walk percentage (32.3%), and FIP (1.78).

HE'S BACKKKK: After winning Carolina League Player of the Month for April, Brandon Pimentel got back to early-season form in August. He continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 84, and in August, Pimentel slashed .316/.386/.494 for an OPS of .880. He drove in 19 runs in August as well, his most in a month since he knocked in a whopping 33 runs in April.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 215-177 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, is in his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh is also in his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Alex Clemmey makes his seventh start as a FredNat tonight, in game one of the divisional series against Carolina. It's the lefty's 26th start overall, having made his first 19 starts with Lynchburg.

Alex was acquired as a key piece in the Nationals' return for Lane Thomas from Cleveland. Coincidentally, the trade was made right before the FredNats and Hillcats were scheduled to start a series, so Clemmey simply had to switch dugouts.

WELCOME TO PRO BALL: Clemmey faced a rude introduction to the Carolina league, as the southpaw struggled mightily in his first month playing professionally. Alex sported a 12.60 ERA over five starts (15.0 IP), as opponents hit .306 against him. But from May through June, Clemmey posted a 2.48 ERA in 54.1 innings.

AS A FREDNAT: Clemmey has been solid for FXBG since the trade, working to a 4.30 ERA in 23.0 innings. The big lefty has struck out 26 men and walked 16 in his six starts.

AGAINST CAROLINA: Clemmey has faced the Mudcats four times this year, three with Lynchburg and once with the Nats. In 15 innings, he's posted a 3.60 ERA, with 19 K's and 8 BB's. Most recently with FXBG, he held the 'Cats to one run over four frames.

LAST TIME OUT: Alex held his former team to just two hits and one run in four innings, while striking out five Hillcats.
