TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas (San Diego Padres affiliate) get set for game two of their six-game series from Dell Diamond. First pitch is set for 7:05 p.m. CT. Express RHP Jack Leiter is slated to face Chihuahuas RHP Gabe Mosser.

OFFENSE OPENS UP

The E-Train rumbled to a 10-5 win in the series opener on Tuesday. Round Rock RF Sandro Fabian got the action going quickly with a leadoff home run in the first. El Paso put three aboard in the third to take a 3-1 lead. After CF Oscar Mercado hit a leadoff single, a sacrifice bunt and Round Rock error put SS Mason McCoy on base. A Nate Mondou single scored Mercado and a double from DH Matthew Batten scored McCoy. Batten crossed home on a groundout from 2B Graham Pauley. The Express pulled ahead 5-3 with four in the third. CF Jose Barrero knocked a leadoff single and rounded the bases on a stolen base, Fabian groundout and fielder's choice. Singles from DH Andrew Knapp and 1B Blaine Crim loaded the bases before a Chihuahuas error cleared the bases and allowed 2B Matt Duffy to reach second. Wendzel hit Round Rock's second solo home run of the night as he extended the lead to 6-3 in the fourth. The E-Train kept chugging along as LF Dustin Harris worked a walk then scored on another El Paso error which made it 7-3. Chihuahuas RF Cal Mitchell hit a single that scored two in the eighth, making it a 7-5 game. The Express responded in the bottom of the frame when Barrero launched a three-run home run.

LEITER LOADING

Express RHP Jack Leiter is slated to take the ball for Round Rock on Wednesday. The righty is making his first start at Dell Diamond since April 25 against Salt Lake. In his six appearances this year, he has gone at least 5.0 innings five times and he has not allowed more than three earned runs in any outing this year. He has 43 strikeouts in 30.1 innings.

SANDRO GETS US STARTED

Express RF Sandro Fabian batted leadoff for the fourth time this season and went 2-for-5 with a home run, a RBI and a run scored. When batting leadoff, he is hitting .438 (7-16) with a triple, three home runs, seven RBI, a walk and three strikeouts this year.

WE GO AS WENZEL DOES

Since the start of the 2023 season, the Express are 24-8 when INF Davis Wendzel hits at least one home run. In his last 177 games at the Triple-A level, Wendzel has hit 45 home runs with 114 RBI. Since he was optioned on May 21, the right-hander is 6-for-20.

MAY MEMORIES

The Express improved to 15-9 in May which is the best record in the Pacific Coast League. Round Rock leads the league with a 3.38 ERA (78 ER/207.2 IP) this month and they have issued only 85 walks which is the least among PCL squads. The Express have not lost three consecutive games since April 16-18.

STARTER SUCCESS

Express RHP Adrian Sampson tossed 5.0 innings and earned a win last night. Sampson is 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA (9 ER/27.0 IP) this month. Round Rock starting pitchers own a 4.11 ERA (105 ER/230.0 IP) this season. In May, starting pitchers are 6-2 with a 2.69 ERA (36 ER/120.2 IP). In 24 games this month, a starter has gone 5.0 innings or more on 16 occasions including in 10 of 11 road games.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

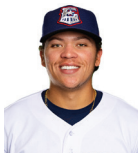
