TUESDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats lost to the Portland Sea Dogs 6-4 in walk-off fashion on Tuesday night from Hadlock Field in the series opener. The Fisher Cats held a 4-1 lead heading into the bottom of the ninth but a five-run inning for the Sea Dogs gave them a come from behind victory in the end. Down to his final strike, Stephen Scott drove in the winning runs with a three-run walk-off home run off **Troy Watson**, his second home run of the game. **Damiano Palmegiani** recorded a game-high two RBIs for New Hampshire, tying the game in the sixth with a sac fly and extending the lead 3-1 in the eighth with a fielder's choice grounder to third. **Orelvis Martinez** drove in his 30th RBI of the season with a single in the eighth, bringing home Palmegiani. New Hampshire collected only two hits in the entire game but drew nine walks against Portland pitching. Starting pitcher **Adam Kloffenstein** threw six strong innings, allowing only one run on six hits and two walks while striking out five. The 22-year old right hander lowered his ERA to 2.20, which is fifth best in the Eastern League. He is also second in the Eastern League in strikeouts with 51.

CHUCKY CHEESE DALLAS: Chad Dallas was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after a dominant seven shutout inning, nine strikeout performance on Friday against Binghamton. It's the first time a Fisher Cat pitcher has been named with the weekly award since Max Castillo the week of April 8-17, 2022. Dallas's seven-inning start in his Fisher Cats debut was the longest start of his career.

30 FOR NUMBER 2: Orelvis Martinez drove in his 30th RBI of the season last night against Portland with an RBI single in the eighth. He is the third Eastern League hitter this season to drive in 30 or more RBIs behind Hartford's Hunter Goodman (43) and Erie's Colt Keith (33). 12 of Martinez's 19 hits this season have gone over the wall for home runs. His nine home runs this month ties a Fisher Cats record. Last season, Martinez had 23 RBIs in the month of May. This year, he has already 20 RBIs in May with seven games to go this month.

(OBP' – ON BASE PALMEGIANI: Damiano Palmegiani is in the top-10 of the Eastern League leaderboard in on-base percentage. The corner infielder is getting on-base at a .404 clip, eighth-best in the league. On Tuesday, he collected his 18th and 19th RBIs of the season, placing him second on the team behind **Orelvis Martinez**. Palmegiani has reached base in an impressive 30 of 35 games played this season.

GET SCHWECKED: Trevor Schwecke drove in a career-high five RBIs in the second game of the Sunday doubleheader, including a grand slam in the fourth to tie up the score 4-4 in the fourth. It was Schwecke's second career grand slam and the first grand slam hit by the Fisher Cats this season. The utilityman has played every position on defense except for catcher, center field and pitcher.

PARTY LIKE A ROCK-STAR: Dylan Rock has a knack for knowing when to hit the ball out of the park for the Fisher Cats so far this year. Three of his four home runs this season have been game winning hits, including his most recent homer in the second game of the doubleheader on Sunday, a two-run shot to break the 4-4 tie in the fifth. His very first Double-A homer broke a 5-5 tie in the eighth on April 25 vs Hartford in the continuation of a suspended game.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (May 24, 2012)- The Fisher Cats earned a split of the four-game series with Portland in Manchester with an 8-2 win. Brian Bocock went 3-for-5 with a double and three RBI, and John Tolisano added a two-run single in the second inning. Yohan Pino was the winner, allowed two earned runs in seven innings to improve to 4-1. Fernando Hernandez pitched two scoreless innings to finish up the game.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (26-23) snapped a five-game losing streak with a 20-1 win at Tampa Bay. The Blue Jays had 27 hits, including four by George Springer and three each for Bo Bichette, Vladimir Guerrero Jr., Whit Merrifield, and Danny Jansen. Guerrero drove in six runs and hit his eighth homer...Triple-A Buffalo (22-24) dropped the series opener at Lehigh Valley 6-3. Spencer Horwitz had three hits, including a two-run single in the first to put the Bisons up 2-0. The Iron Pigs responded with four in the bottom of the first and led the rest of the way...High-A Vancouver (21-17) swept a doubleheader with Spokane 5-4 and 6-4...Class A Dunedin (21-19) gave up 11 runs in the fifth inning and lost 13-3 at home to Fort Myers. Fitz Stadler worked a scoreless inning in relief in his second game back on a rehab assignment. The Blue Jays 18th round pick in 2018 (Arizona State) appeared in 39 games, 26 with the Fisher Cats in 2021 – but did not pitch last year when injured.

COMING UP: New Hampshire continues its six-game road trip at Portland this week, their first of two visits to the Sea Dogs this season. The next home game will be Tuesday, May 30 when the Fisher Cats host Reading.
