### TUESDAY: ROUGHRIDERS FALL IN WALK OFF TO AMARILLO:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Amarillo Sod Poodles 7-6 in 10 innings on Tuesday from HODGETOWN. With the game tied at 5-5 in the top of the tenth inning, Frisco's (21-12) **Keyber Rodriguez** drove home **Josh Hatcher** with a two-out, RBI single to give the Riders a 6-5 lead against Mitchell Stumpo (2-0). **Robbie Ahlstrom** (2-1) then allowed a two-run, walk-off double to Amarillo's (14-20) Ivan Melendez in the bottom of the tenth. To open the scoring, Melendez blasted a solo home run in the bottom of the second inning against Frisco starter **Josh Stephan**. The Riders responded in the top of the third, tying the game at 1-1 on a Rodriguez homer. **Cody Freeman** gave the Riders a 3-1 lead with a two-run double to left, plating **Cooper Johnson** and **Aaron Zavala**. Amarillo used a three-run bottom of the fifth to regain the lead, scoring on an RBI double by J.J. D'Orazio and a two-run homer from Deyvison De Los Santos to make it a 4-3 game. **Abimelec Ortiz** led off the sixth frame with a single before **Frainyer Chavez** belted a two-run homer to left field, ping ponging Frisco to a 5-4 advantage. Melendez swatted his second homer of the game to pull Amarillo even with Frisco in the sixth inning, 5-5. Stephan exited the game after the sixth inning, spinning 6.0 innings and allowing five runs on seven hits with four strikeouts. **Steven Jennings** tossed a pair of scoreless frames for the RoughRiders, surrendering just one hit and a walk while striking out one. Offensively, Rodriguez led the way with three hits as Freeman and Strahm each collected two hits. Rodriguez, Freeman and Chavez added two RBI, accounting for all six Riders runs.

### TIMING MATTERS:

While the RoughRiders are eighth in the league in batting average (.239), they are second in the Texas League in average with runners in scoring position (.276). They also have the second-fewest individual left on base at-bats in the Texas League with RISP (331, 10.3 per game). **Josh Hatcher** is sixth in the league with a .375 batting average with RISP while **Aaron Zavala** is 11th with a .345 average.

### DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have seen a lot of runs this season in the first inning of games. Frisco is second in the Texas League with 25 first-inning runs while they have the second-highest first-inning ERA in the league as well (6.27).

### MAY FLOWERS:

The RoughRiders are 8-3 in the month of May, the best record in the Texas League. Frisco has the best overall ERA in the month (3.11) while they have a 1.77 bullpen ERA in the month. Out of their eight wins in the month, the Riders have recorded a league-best six saves. On the offensive side, they are second in the league with 19 steals and fewest strikeouts (77), but are sixth in OPS (.669) and sixth with just eight home runs.

### IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has the longest on-base streak this season for the RoughRiders, currently at 20 games. During the streak, he hit .321 (25-for-78)/.400/.423/.823 with a triple, two home runs, eight RBIs, 11 walks, five steals and 17 runs scored. The streak is the third-longest active streak in the Texas League. In his career, Strahm has the second-longest on-base streak in RoughRiders franchise history (37 games in 2022). His 157 career walks with the RoughRiders are the second-most in franchise history, trailing only **Guilder Rodriguez**, who walked 206 times over seven seasons from 2009 to 2015.

### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Part of the RoughRiders' dominance on the mound has been the Frisco bullpen. Over the last 12 games, the bullpen has allowed just eight earned runs over 44.0 innings (1.64 ERA). On the season, the bullpen is second in the Texas League with a 3.52 ERA.

### I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

**Cody Freeman** had a monster game on April 25th against Amarillo, going 5-for-5 with two home runs and a double. It was the first five-hit game in Freeman's Minor League career and the first one for the Riders since **Blaine Crim** accomplished the feat on September 2nd, 2022 at Amarillo. Over his last 19 games, he is batting .315 (23-for-73)/.359/.562/.921 with six doubles, four home runs, 11 RBIs and 10 runs scored. In his last 17 games, he has batted .333/.364/.619/.983 with all four of his homers.

### THE HATCHER HAMMER:

In an incredible win on April 27th, **Josh Hatcher** hammered a three-run, walk-off home run for a 4-3 win over Amarillo. Hatcher's capper was his third home run in as many games. He is slashing .337/.386/.500/.886. Hatcher is third in the league in batting average (.337), fourth in RBIs (22), ninth in slugging percentage (.500) and eighth in OPS (.886). Last Thursday, the Texas Rangers announced that Hatcher was named the Rangers Minor League Player of the Month for April. He slashed .373/.403/.576/.979 over 15 games for Frisco in April with three doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 11 runs and three steals. He finished third in the Texas League in batting average (.373), tied for eighth in RBIs (16), sixth in slugging (.576) and sixth in OPS (.979).

### ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

### 2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Threw 5.2 scoreless at CC on 4/30. Over four starts at Whataburger Field, Garcia has allowed just three runs over 20.2 IP (1.31 ERA).

### 2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

### 2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

### 2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

### 2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.

### ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior year, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

### 2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

### 2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

### 2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22

### 2021 SEASON

-Pitching mainly in an extended relief role, he combined to go 3-1, 3.70 (23 ER/56.0 IP) in 20 G/4 GS for Down East (A) and Hickory (A+), averaging 10.0 strikeouts per 9 innings.

-Began season with Down East and was promoted to Hickory on 7/7.

### 2019 SEASON

-Saw minimal pro action after being drafted. Posted a 9.9 SO/9 figure over 7 G for Spokane (A) and AZL Rangers (Rk.).
