JUMBO SHRIMP FALL 4-1

Griffin Conine homered on Friday, but the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp dropped a 4-1 contest to the Norfolk Tides. The Tides plated a run on a double play in the first. Heston Kierstad blasted a solo shot in the fifth and then Maverick Handley hit an RBI double in the sixth inning. Kjerstad went yard again in the seventh before Jacksonville finally got on the board with Conine's solo home run in the bottom of the seventh. The Jumbo Shrimp, though, could get no closer, finishing 0-for-9 with runners in scoring position and stranding 10 runners on base.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE. NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jacksonville infielder Jonah Bride blasted two home runs on Wednesday, his second multi-homer game in five days. Bride began the season with Miami, batting just 1-for-7 in five games before getting optioned to Jacksonville. Since coming to the First Coast. Bride is 17-for-44 (.386/.526/.750/1.276) with four doubles. four home runs, eight RBIs, 10 walks and six runs scored. Bride leads the International League in OBP while ranking second in OPS, third in average, fourth in SLG, OBP and tied for 12th in home runs. He has at least one hit in each of his last seven games, batting 12-for-24 during that span.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

Jacksonville has scored a run in 43 of their 169 offensive innings thus far in 2024. Over those 43 innings, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored multiple runs in nearly half of those, a total of 20 frames. The club's biggest inning came during a seven-run fifth inning on April 17 against Norfolk. Outside of that, the Jumbo Shrimp have logged two five-run innings. five frames of three runs and 13 two-run innings.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD

In four games from April 12-16, Jacksonville's bullpen struggled, surrendering 14 runs, all earned, on 15 hits in 14.1 innings for an 8.79 ERA. During that stretch, the club's relief pitchers combined for 16 strikeouts against seven walks. In the last three games, however, the Jumbo Shrimp have righted the ship a hit Tacksonville relievers have ceded just four runs, all earned, on nine hits in 16.0 innings for a 2.25 ERA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has fanned 18 while walking only three during this three-game stretch.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 13 of Jacksonville's 19 games (68.4 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in these contests, going 10-3 (.769) in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22

TEN COMMANDMENTS

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won 10 of their last 16 games. Nine of those 10 victories have come by three runs or fewer, with Jacksonville outscoring their opponents by a thin 73-71 margin. The Jumbo Shrimp's pitching has excelled during this stretch, with the club placing sixth in ERA (4.06) in Triple-A during this stretch. Jacksonville has ceded the tied for the fifthfewest runs at the level.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 18 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 78 runs (4.3 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 31for-159 (.195/.310/.327/.637, ranking 29th, 29th, 29th and 30th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 112 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th. 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

SHRIMP RITES

Jacksonville has just five stolen base attempts and four stolen bases in the 13 games since April 5. Both figures are the fewest in Triple-A... Dane Myers owns a 15-game onbase streak entering play on Saturday, the third-longest in the IL this season. Over the first eight games of the streak, he went just 6-for-29 (.207/.343/.207/.550) with one RBI and four walks. In the seven games since, he is hitting 7-for-25 (.280/.379/.520/.899) with three doubles, one homer, three RBIs and four walks.

ABOUT MAX

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortned season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

2024 SEASON

-Optioned to Jacksonville on April 15.

2023 SEASON

-Did not pitch while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Meyer made his major league debut for the Marlins on July 16 by throwing 5.1 innings with five strikeouts in a game against the Philadelphia Phillies at loadDepot park. He made two starts before undergoing Tommy John surgery on August 9.

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

2021 SEASON

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in IP (101.0).

-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.

-Selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, Meyer threw just seven pitches to two batters, getting Adley Rutschman (Baltimore Orioles) to fly out to left before walking Nick Pratto (Kansas City Royals).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Meyer competed for the USA Collegiate National Team in both 2018 and 2019. In 2018, he picked up seven saves with a 3.38 ERA in eight appearances, striking out a team-leading 15 batters in 8.0 innings. In 2019, he appeared in four games, including three starts, and recorded a 0.64 ERA across 14.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. He was named Outstanding Pitcher of the 2019 USA vs. Cuba International Friendship Series.
