The Fightin Phils finish a two-week road trip on Sunday afternoon at the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the last-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and final-of-nine at TD Bank Ballpark. Somerset leads the season-series 9-8, and can clinch it with one more win.

### Dominant Dub

The Fightin Phils rode a career-night from Moises Chace en route to a 7-1 win over Somerset on Saturday night. Chace went a career-high six innings and also struck out a career-high 13 batters. He face done above the minimum and retired the final 16 batters he faced. Reading did not allow a base runner from the bottom of the first, until the bottom of the ninth. In total, Reading pitching sent down 25-straight Patriots' hitters. Justin Crawford hit a three-run home run, and Ethan Wilson hit a two-run shot. Erick Brito also chipped in a RBI double in the all-around victory on Saturday night.

### Magical Moises

Moises Chace was nothing short of dominant in his third Double-A start. After setting a then-career high with 10 strikeouts over 4.2 innings last week at Binghamton, he followed that with a new career-high 13 strikeouts over a carerr-best six-innings pitched. His 13 strikeouts are the most by a Reading pitcher this season, with the previous high being 11, done three times. The last Reading pitcher with exactly 13 strikeouts in a game was Adam Walker on May 10, 2001, at Portland. His 13 strikeouts were also the most in a game by a Fightin Phil sine Spencer Howard had 12 on Sept. 4, 2019, against Trenton. In total, Chace retired 18-of-19 hitters and the final 16 he faced. Of those 19 hitters, 13 were retired via strikeout. 13 of his 18 outs were via a strikeout (72%). He collected 19 swing and missed on the night, with 13 of those coming against his fastball. His effort led to 16 strikeouts on the night for Reading pitching, matching a season high. Since his Double-A debut (August 17), Chace leads the Eastern League with 29 strikeouts, with second place over that stretch being Sunday's starter Eiberson Castellano, who has 21 entering today's start.

### Marcus Mashing

After a recent slow stretch. Marcus Lee Sang is swinging the bat well again. Sine August 13, Lee Sang is slashing .304/.333/.522, with an .855 OPS. He's added seven runs, two doubles, one triple, two home runs and four RBI. This comes after a stretch that saw Lee Sang go 7-72 (.097) from July 4-August 10. In Friday night's game, Lee Sang set a new career-high with three stolen bases. It also marked the second time this season a R-Phil stole three bags in a game. The other came from Gabriel Rincones Jr. on July 27 at New Hampshire.

Friday night was Reading's eighth shutout win of the season which by far and away surpasses last season's total of three. It's the most shutouts Reading has had in a season since posting 11 in 2022. Tommy McCollum also reached 10 saves in Friday night's ballgame. That mark surpasses last season's individual high of seven from Orion Kerkering. McCollum's 10 saves are the most by a Fightin Phil in a season since Brian Marconi had 18 in 2022.

This week's series matches up the two teams with the most home runs in the Eastern League this season. Somerset is in first place with 131 home runs and Reading sits in second with 129 long balls. Reading is on pace for 143 home runs this season, which would be the first time the R-Phils hit over 140 home runs in consecutive seasons since 2017 (153) and 2018 (141). Reading pitching has done an excellent job keeping the ball in the park this week. Somerset has not homered since the first inning of Tuesday's game, when Anthony Rizzo went deep off Noah Skirrow.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

September 1, 2004: At Citizens Bank Park, Philadelphia, Ryan Howard makes his Major League debut for the Phillies against Atlanta, going 0-for-1 in a pinchhit appearance. Howard hit 37 home runs for Reading earlier in the year and had 9 more for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre before being called up to the big Phils.

Somerset enters tonight after finishing in fourth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 32-37 record. They are second in the Northeast Division with a 32-22 record in the second half of the season. Somerset most recently took four-of-six at Portland. Following this week, Somerset goes to Binghamton. Somerset's roster features seven players ranked amongst the New York Yankees' top-30 prospects: Spencer Jones (2), Chase Hampton (6), Brock Selvidge (7), Zach Messinger (17), Cam Schlittler (25), Trystan Vrieling (28) and Rafael Flores (30).

Righty Luis Gil will make the start today for Somerset, as he makes a big league rehab appearance from the Yankees. This season with New York, Gil is 12-6, with a 3.39 ERA over 24 starts (124.2 IP, 83 H, 66 BB, 144 SO). He was placed on the 15-day IL on Aug. 21 with a lower back strain and is making his first rehab appearance since being placed on the injured list. This is Gil's first season of extended big-league action as he pitched briefly with the Yankees in 2022 (one start) and 2021 (six starts). Gil missed most of 2023 rehabbing from right-elbow surgery. He also rehabbed with Somerset in 2021, and recorded the start and first strikeout in Somerst's first game as a Yankees' affiliate on May 4, 2021. Gil, the 26-year old, originally signed with Minnesota in 2015 out of the Dominican Republic. He was traded to the Yankees in March of 2018 for Jake Cave, who formerly played for the Phillies.
