OH IT'S THESE GUYS AGAIN: After being swept on the weekend in Salem coming out of the All-Star break, the FredNats return home to the friendly confines of Virginia Credit Union Stadium for the opener of the final series of the year with the Delmarva Shorebirds, Single-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Fredericksburg is 14-1 this year against Delmarva, and will play 18 out of the next 24 games at home as we head down the home stretch, with seven series and 42 total games remaining in the regular season. FXBG currently leads the North Division of the league by 2.0 games heading into play tonight and will send RHP Travis Sthele to the mound for the series opener. Two of Sthele's four wins this season have come against Delmarva.

ABOUT LAST WEEKEND: The FredNats were walked off in the the first two games of the series in Salem, falling 6-5 and 7-6. FXBG made a four-run comeback in the 9th inning of Saturday's game, but couldn't get the go-ahead run in and eventually lost in 10 innings. Sunday, Salem won 6-3 behind a strong start for their offense against Dustin Saenz.

COMPLETE DOMINATION: The FredNats are 14-1 this year against Delmarva, and one game under .500 against the rest of the Carolina League. In 15 games this year against the Shorebirds, FXBG has outscored Delmarva 96-39 this year and has swept two out of the three series the teams have played this year, including the second six-game series sweep in franchise history in the first week of July. FredNat pitching has 138 strikeouts of the Shorebirds in 139 IP this year against Delmarva.

STEADY SAMMY: Sammy Infante is currently working on a 17-game on-base streak for the FredNats, which was extended with a two-run single in the 9th inning Saturday night. It's the 2nd longest on-base streak of the season for a FredNat, second to only Roismar Quintana's 19. Infante also has a seven-game hitting streak going right now as well.

DOMINANT STARTS: After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last month. Since June 11, the beginning of the last Carolina series, FredNat starters have logged 147 innings and allowed just 26 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.59. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. In last series alone, FredNat starters pitched 16.1 scoreless innings, allowing a total of seven hits.

FORTY AND ONE: Last Tuesday's loss was the first time all season that the FredNats lost a game when leading after seven innings, and both doubleheader sweeps have pushed the team's record in that scenario to 40-1. FXBG's loss in Friday night's game was the first time all season the team has blown a lead after eight innings.

DOMINANT DAVIS: In his return season from Tommy John surgery that wiped out his entire 2023 campaign, Marc Davis is making the most of his time in Fredericksburg. After five more innings on Friday night allowing no earned runs, he's now allowed just one earned run in his last five starts. Covering 25 innings in that time frame, his ERA is 0.36, the opponents are hitting just .143 against him, and his WHIP is an excellent 0.88. Davis also has 25 strikeouts in that span.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 39-7 this season when scoring first, including 33 out of the last 35 wins. FXBG was beaten for the first time in a month when scoring first in Tuesday night's game by Carolina.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 192-159 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Frelich, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Frelich begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

TODAY'S START: Travis Sthele makes his 14th start of the year this evening, against the Delmarva Shorebirds. A 12th round pick by the Nats in 2023, Sthele joined the FredNat rotation late in the 2023 campaign. Sthele has been mainly a starter, but has worked in the piggyback role twice this season.

A YEAR AGO: Sthele took his lumps after joining Fredericksburg last season. He posted a 7.36 ERA over four starts, to go along with a 1.82 WHIP. Travis struck out six hitters over 11.0 IP but showcased strong command, walking just three men.

TRENDING UP: After a rough start to the season, Sthele has made marked improvements as the summer goes along. In his last four starts, covering 18.0 IP, Travis has allowed just four earned runs, which works out to a 2.00 ERA.

AGAINST THE SHOREBIRDS: Sthele was excellent when he faced Delmarva on July 5th, blanking the 'Birds over five one-hit innings. He did walk three men, but worked his way around traffic to earn the win. That was the second time this year Sthele shutout Delmarva.

LAST TIME OUT: Sthele continued his strong form as of late, tossing five innings and allowing just a pair of earned runs against the Mudcats before the All Star break. He tied a season-best with seven strikeouts, and walked just one batter.
