NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

Omaha's enters today's game in 1st place in the 20-team International League, an impressive 27 games over .500 at 47-20 (.697) and the best team in MiLB.
 47 wins are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, two ahead of the 45-win Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A).
 Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .701 winning percentage is also the best, just ahead of the Frisco Rough Riders (43-20 / .683 / Rangers Double-A).

I'VE GOT THE MAGIC (NUMBER) IN ME

Up by 5.5 games over the 2nd-place Syracuse Mets with 6 games to play, Omaha's magic number to clinch the 1st Half title in the International League is 1, meaning the Chasers need 1 win or 1 Syracuse loss to secure a playoff berth.
 Either an Omaha win OR Syracuse loss TODAY would win Omaha the first half.
 Omaha has not been to the playoffs in 10 years, when the team won its 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships ... the last postseason game the Chasers played was Tuesday, September 16, 2014 a 4-2 win over the Pawtucket Red Sox.
 The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

IT'S CALLED A WINNING STREAK

Winners of 5 straight games (the last 5 games of a series in Toledo), the Storm Chasers are attempting to win a sixth straight games this afternoon.
 Omaha has FIVE 5+ game winning streaks this season, a sixth straight win today would be the team's third 6+ game streak.
 The Chasers' 9-game winning streak between May 29 and June 6 is still the longest in Triple-A this year, tied for the 4th-longest among the 120 full season MiLB teams.

COMEBACK KIDS

Trailing 1-0 after the fourth inning yesterday, the win marked Omaha's 26th comeback-from-behind win this season, meaning over half (55%) of this year's wins have been comeback victories.
 The Storm Chasers trailed for 6 innings last Wednesday, tied for the 3rd-most innings the team has spent losing in a game they ended up winning this season.
 Wednesday marked the 9th time this year Omaha has trailed by 3+ runs and won.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has a 33-9 record over its last 42 games ... 28 of those 42 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 24 of the 33 wins in this stretch.
 Omaha is 17-6 in 1-run games this season, the most wins in 1-run games of any Minor League team ... the Storm Chasers have won their last seven 1-run games and 10 of their last 13 games decided by just a run.
 In total, 45 of Omaha's 66 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (67%), including 13 of 20 losses this season.
 As a team, Omaha's 23 saves are tied for the most of any Minor League team ... Will Klein's 9 saves individually rank third in the International League, while six players have 2 or more saves this year.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 387 to 303 this season, a +84 run differential.
 A +84 run differential ranks as the best in the International League and is the 2nd-highest mark at the Triple-A level trailing Oklahoma City (Dodgers Triple-A) at +95.
 Omaha ranks 5th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Modesto Nuts lead the Minors at +150 (425 to 275).

YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.
 When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 22-4 record (.846 winning %), compared to 24-17 (.585 winning %) when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
 When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 27-5 (.844 winning %), while the team is just 20-15 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starting pitcher (.571 winning %).

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.
 The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a Triple-A best .207 average (tied 3rd in MiLB) and level-leading .670 OPS, while a 3.62 ERA against the Omaha bullpen is 2nd-best in Triple-A.
 Including Sunday, Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 17 games this year ... this is an average of once every 3.94 games this year of the relievers combining for a shutout.
 Walter Pennington's 71 strikeouts in 27 games (2 starts) are tied for the 4th-most in the International League, while 59 strikeouts in relief lead all MAJOR AND MINOR LEAGUE RELIEVERS ... his 39.4% strikeout rate is 3rd in MiLB (min. 40.0 IP).

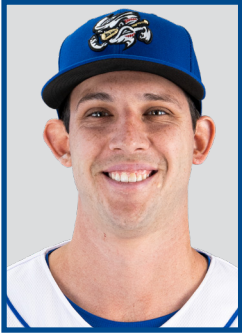

TODAY'S START

- Lynch is making his **15th overall appearance**, **13th overall start** and **10th Omaha start** this season ... today marks the start of his fourth stint in Triple-A with Omaha, previously with the Storm Chasers March 29-May 4 and May 10 to 29 and May 31 to June 1.
- Has improved his walk rate in each of his first three seasons in the Majors since debuting in 2021, lowering his BB% from 10.0% in 2021 to 8.7% in 2022 and 7.2% in 2023 ... walk rate in Triple-A this year is 7.1% (12 walks in 169 batters faced).
- Added the 'IV' to his surname before his July 18, 2023 start vs. Detroit to honor his father, Daniel Lynch III, and grandfather, Daniel Lynch II.

LAST OUTING: WEDNESDAY, MAY 12 vs. NEW YORK (AL)

Worked as the "bulk" pitcher behind opener Dan Altavilla and threw 6.2 relief innings ... Altavilla only recorded one out, Lynch inherited the bases loaded with one out in the top of the 1st inning and the Royals down 2-0 ... allowed all 3 1st inning inherited runners to score, plus one of his own for a 6-0 deficit after the 1st inning ... from the final out of the 1st to the end of the 4th inning, retired 10 of 11 batters, with 1-2-3 innings in the 3rd and 4th ... allowed a 2-run homer to Giancarlo Stanton in the 5th inning and a 3-run flomer to Gleyber Torres in the 7th.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Optioned to Triple-A Omaha on March 20 and started Opening Day for the Storm Chasers, March 29 @ Iowa, his first of 5 Omaha starts that have been 5.0 innings.
- In his second stint with Omaha, threw back-to-back quality starts for the Chasers, May 19 @ St. Paul and May 25 vs. Columbus ... combined to allow 2 earned runs on 10 hits with 1 walk over 13.2 innings.
- Opened his MLB season with 10.0 scoreless innings, between his first stint that start on May 5 and the start of his second stint on May 30 ... after 5.0 scoreless innings in his Royals season debut May 5, made his first true MLB relief appearance with 2.0 scoreless innings May 9 @ Los Angeles (AL).

CAREER NOTES
