TODAY'S HEADL

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints could not get their offense going against Daniel Lynch IV in a 9-2 loss to Omaha on Saturday. The Saints scored just two runs off Lynch IV, coming from a Wynton Bernard home run in the fourth inning. Zebby Matthews allowed four runs on nine hits in his CHS Field debut, takign his first Triple-A loss. The Storm Chasers scored three in the sixth off Josh Winder, hitting a pair of home runs. Aside from the home run, the Saints got just three runners in scoring position in the game. Caleb Baragar and Hobie Harris retired the final six batters in order to finish the game

LOOOUUUUUU: Louie Varland has returned to form over his last two starts, throwing 11.2 innings of shutout baseball. In that time he has allowed just two hits, walked four and struck out 13 batters. His 13 punch outs over the last two starts are his second-most for a two-start span this season, short of the 16 he had between May 3-9. Over his last four starts, Varland has a 0.93 ERA (19.1 IP, 2 ER).

JULIEN JUMPING ON BASE: Edouard Julien has reached base in 24 consecutive games, riding the Saints' longest on-base streak this season. It is the third-longest streak in franchise history and the second-longest single-season streak, trailing only Trevor Larnach - 26 G (2022-23) and Jake Cave - 49 G (2022). During his 24-game streak, Julien is hitting .274/.465/.440 (.905 OPS).

WINK WINK: Patrick Winkel has been locked in since the start of July, hitting a team-best .361 this month. This July is currently the best month of his career (min. 20 PA's), beating out August of 2023, where he hit .333. His .993 OPS in July is the second-best of his career (min. 20 PA's), trailing his 1.024 OPS, also in August 2023. Winkel has hit safely in seven of his 11 July games, collecting multiple hits in four games, including three of his last four games.

RISPY BUSINESS: Coming out of the All-Star Break (seven games), the Saints have been able to capitalize with runners in scoring position. The Saints have hit a league-best .375 (33-for-88) with RISP since the break. Their 33 hits with RISP are the most in Triple-A that span. Of those 33 hits, 28 of them are singles.

TRIPLES IS BEST: Anthony Prato logged his fifth triple of the season on Wednesday, four of which have come in July. His four July triples tie the most for any Saints batter in any month in franchise history, matching the five hit by Jake Cave in June of 2022. Prato is the fourth International League batter to collect four triples in a month this season. His five triples on the season are now tied for the second-most in the IL. The Saints five triples in July are ties for the most in the league.

WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH: Chris Williams hit his 12th home run of the season on Sunday and the 43rd of his Saints career. He has tied Mark Contreras for the career franchise lead at 43 long balls. His 43 home runs since his Triple-A debut on July 17, 2022 are tied for the 11th-most in

the International League.

\$ In the month of July, Williams has clubbed seven home runs, tied for the most in the International League. He also ranks among league leaders in July with his 17 runs (third), his .667 slugging percentage (fourth), 10 extra-base hits (fourth), 42 total bases (seventh), .377 batting average (eighth), his 1.049 OPS (eighth). It is OPS also the best of any month he's had in 2024 and nearly double his .544 OPS

ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .397 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 15 of the 18 games he's played in, drawing 10 walks and been hit by a pitch four times. He is third among full-season wing leading the season base proportions at 400 across full-season. minor league players in on-base percentage at .440 across three levels.

TWINS UPDATE: The Twins took an early 2-0 after Royce Lewis hit a two-run home run off Tarik Skubal, but the Tigers scored the next seven runs in a 7-2 loss. Lewis finshed 2-for-4 with a double and home run as Joe Ryan took the loss in the quality start, allowing three runs over 6.0 inchiper and striking out of the start. innings and striking out eight.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 7/11 @ LOU...made 12th start of the season with the Saints, throwing 5.2 innings of shutout baseball, allowing two hits and three walks while striking out six...allowed an infield single in the first inning before retiring seven in a row into the third inning when he walked Jacob Hurtubise...allowed a two-out baserunner in each of the third, fourth, fifth and sixth innings...allowed only four balls to leave the infield, only one of which went for a hit...pitched into the sixth inning for the first time since May 21 at Buffalo...did not factor into the decision in a 3-2 Saints loss.

SOMEONE IS FLIPPING OVER A CHECKERS BOARD: During the 2023 offseason, Louie got engaged to Maddie Hentges, a former lacrosse player at Concordia-St. Paul (2017-20), the same school as Varland. Maddies brother, Sam, was a star forward on the Totino-Grace HS hockey team, played at St. Cloud State, and was a Minnesota Wild draft pick. Maddies Dad, Mark, was a Hobie Baker Award finalist in 1980 at St. Thomas, a 2x All-American (1980 & 81) and played in the Montreal Canadiens organization.

NOTHING TO RANT(Z) ABOUT X 2: Make it back-to-back years in which Varland was honored with the Jim Rantz Minnesota Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year Award. In 2021 he received it after going 10-4 with a 2.10 ERAin 20 games (18 starts) between Low-A Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids. In 103.0 innings pitched he fanned 142 while opponents hit .214 against him. In 2022, between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, he went 8-5, 3.06 (126.1 IP, 43 ER) with 42 walks and 146 strikeouts as opponents hit .242 against him across 24 games (23) starts. He also went 1-2, 3.81 ERA (26.0 IP, 11 ER) with six walks, 21 strikeouts, and a .261 opponents batting average in five starts.

WHO SAYS YOU CAN'T GO HOME: With the transfer from Double-A to Triple-A, on August 8, 2022, Varland returned home. He became the first player from St. Paul to play for the Saints since the team became a Triple-A franchise. Some of the players from the Independent days that were from St. Paul that played for the Saints include Jack Morris, Ryan Schlosser, Tim Thomas (1995), Chris Schwab, Steve Butler, Adam Larson, Brian Whinnery, Zach Peterson, Reid Mahon, Matt Schuld, Joe Bonfe, Jack Goihl, and Jake Esch.

HULKAMANIA: While in high school at North St. Paul High School, Varland was on the wrestling team. He was a two-time MSHSL State Tournament wrestler, two-time MVP, Most Improved Rookie of the Year, two-time section runner up and four-time captain of the

GET ON THE BUS, GUS: Louie's brother, Gus, is 13 months older than him. They played together at North St. Paul High School and Concordia, St. Paul. Gus was selected in the 14th round by the Oakland Atfiletics in 2018 out of Concordia, St. Paul. Gus was then traded to the Dodgers along with 3B Sheldon Neuse in exchange for LHP Adam Kolarek and RF Cody Thomas on February 12, 2021. He was claimed in the Minor League phase of the Rule 5 draft by the Milwaukee Brewers from the L.A. Dodgers on December 7, 2022

NOT MY BROTHERS KEEPER: - Louie faced off against his brother Gus in 2022 as the Wind Surge took on the Tulsa Drillers on May 6, 2022 in Wichita. It's the first time brothers started against each other in the Minors since at least the 2000s. Louie went 5.0 IP allowed two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out six. His brother went 3.0 IP allowing six runs on eight hits while walking two and striking out two in a 7-2 Wichita victory in game one of a doubleheader.

BROTHERLY LOVE: On June 15, 2022 the Wind Surge and Drillers met again in a doubleheader in Wichita. This time, the brothers pitched opposite ends of the doubleheader and each got a victory. Louie won Game 1 allowing two runs across 6.0 innings while walking one and striking out four in a 7-4 Wind Surge win. In the second game, Gus pitched 2.0 shutout innings of relief allowing one hit and striking out four in a 4-3 Drillers victory.

RUNS IN THE FAMILY: While Louie has more than made a name for himself, he might not even be the most athletic person in his family. His Aunt's Denise and Sue were legendary softball pitchers at North St. Paul High School.
