# 3D PAPER FLOWER BOUQUET

## SUPPLIES:

- one sheet green construction paper
- scissors
- piece of plain white paper
- pen or pencil to draw the flowers
- markers to color the flowers
- tape
- glue
- cup or vase (i.e., plastic drinking cup)



### **DIRECTIONS:**

1. Cut the green paper in half. Take one of the pieces and fold that in half the long way, or horizontally.

 Use the scissors to make cuts (the flower stems)From the fold of the paper to about an inch or two from the bottom of the paper edges. Make the cuts at least 1/4 of an inch wide up to 1/2 inch wide.
Cut this into thirds

4. Roll and wrap the stems into a tube and tape well to secure at the bottom. Fluff out the stems a bit and set aside.

5. Use your pen or pencil to draw as many flowers as you need on the plain paper.

- 6. Color in your flowers using your markers.
- 7. Cut out your flowers.
- 8. Glue the flowers to the ends of the stems.
- 9. Put your bouquet into a cup or vase and give to mom!



## EGG CARTON FLOWERS

#### SUPPLIES:

- Paint
- Paint Brush
- Egg Carton (Not Foam)
- Paper Straw
- Pom Poms
- Scissors
- Glue



### **DIRECTIONS:**

 have an adult cut out four containers out of the egg carton.
Trim around the edges so that it gives it a rounder shape for the petals of the flower.

 Squirt some paint onto a paper plate and paint your flowers.
After the paint's dried you can attach the stem of the flower by gluing it to the back.

4. Lastly, you can choose a colored pom pom and glue that to the center of the painted egg carton!
