### Heading to Jersey

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series on the road at the Somerset Patriots tonight. The series begins with three games in Somerset, then it shifts to Reading from Thursday-Saturday. It's the ninth-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and third-of-nine in Somserset. After this week, Reading returns to Somerset from Aug. 27-Sept. 1. The Fightin Phils won their first matchup of the season 4-2 over Somerset from Apr. 23-28. Reading leads the season-series 5-3.

### **Bounce Back Effort**

The Fightin Phils captured a 4-2 win on Tuesday night, thanks in large part to seven-strong inning from Matt Osterberg. Osterberg allowed a leadoff home run to Spencer Jones in the bottom of the first, then went on to scatter just six-more hits and just that one run. Reading was the beneificiary of walks and erros on Somerset's part, as the R-Phils put up three runs in the third and one in the fourth off Patriots' starter Zach Messinger. Carlos De La Cruz led the way with two hits for Reading, while also driving in a run. Marcus Lee Sang scored two runs and stole a base in the win. Otto Kemp also chipped in a RBI double.

### Marcus Mashing

Marcus Lee Sang continued his consistent season with a hit, two runs and stolen base on Tuesday night. Lee Sang had a slow start to the season, hitting just .197 in April. But since May 1, Lee Sang is hitting .303, with an .817 OPS. Lee Sang also has showcased some pop as well, as he is tied with Carson Taylor for the team lead in home runs at 10. Lee Sang also leads the team in: at bats (249), hits (68), runs (45) and triples (3).

### Ramos Rolling

Fightin Phils relief pitcher Eury Ramos has been on a roll as of late. Since returning from Triple-A Lehigh Valley and making his first appearance back with Reading on June 4, the righty owns a 1.74 ERA over seven appearances and 10.1 innings pitched. He's allowed just four hits and two-earned runs, which both came on June 18 at New Hampshire. When eliminating that New Hampshire outing, Ramos owns a 0.00 ERA over 9.2 innings pitched.

### Carlos De La Cruzin'

Carlos De La Cruz finished off the month of June slashing .300/.386/.560, with a .946 OPS for the month. He added 21 runs, six doubles, one triple, six home runs and 16 RBI for the month. It's a month that was completely turned his season around, as De La Cruz entered June hitting just .213, and after two more hits on Tuesday night, he is now up to .258 on the season.

## Marvelous Matt

Matt Osterberg turned in his best start of the season, and one of the best outings by a Reading pitcher, on Tuesday night. He matched a team-season high with seven innings, allowing just one run on a leadoff home run, scattering seven hits, and striking out three, with no walks. The seven innings matched a career-high for him, as he last went seven innings on Sept. 14, 2023, on the road at Binghamton.

### Next Crop

Two of the Phillies Top Prospects, and potentially futrue Fightin Phils, Aidan Miller and Justin Crawford were each named to the All-Star Futures Game on Tuesday morning. Crawford and Miller are both teammates with High-A Jersey shore and were the Phillies 2022 and '23 first round draft picks, respectively.

## Somerset Synopsis

Somerset enters tonight after finishing in fourth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Divison for the first half with a 32-37 record. They are first in the Northeast Division with a 6-2 record in the second half of the season. Somerset most recently took five-of-six on the road at the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Following this week, Somerset remains on the road for a six-game series at Erie. Somerset's roster features seven players ranked amongst the New York Yankees' top-30 prospects: Spencer Jones (2), Brock Selvidge (10), Zach Messinger (21), Trystan Vrieling (22), Tyler Hardman (25), Danny Watson (27) and Benmjamin Cowles (29).

### **Patriots Pitcher**

Lefty Ben Shields will make his Double-A debut tonight as he was called up from High-A Hudson Valley on Tuesday. With the Renegades, Shields went 3-2, with a 2.75 ERA over 14 games and seven starts (52.1 IP, 35 H, 10 BB, 71 SO). He also made one start for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on May 25, allowing seven-earned runs over 1.2 innings. In his alst game on June 28 against Wilmington, Shields earned the win over 5.1-scoreless innings, with nine strikeouts and just one hit allowed. This is Shields first pro season as he signed with the Yankees in July of 2023 after pitching for George Mason from 2022-23. He previously pitched at UMass from 2018-21. Ironically, there was a pitcher named Ben Shields who played for the Yankees from 1924-25 and for the Phillies in 1931.
