I LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn secured a series victory with a 7-2 triumph over Winston-Salem on Saturday night...C Omar Narváez went 1-for-3 with a walk as part of a Major League rehab assignment, adding a 2-run single in the 2nd and scoring twice...LF Jaylen Palmer picked up a sacrifice fly in the 1st and 3B Mateo Gil added an RBI of his own...RHP Christian Scott set a new career-high with 8 strikeouts, hurling 5 frames of 1-hit ball for his first victory...RHP Joshua Cornielly punched out a season-high 6 over 2 innings of relief...2B Loidel Chapellí registered 2 hits — a double and a triple — driving in a run for the Dash...Winston-Salem committed 5 errors leading to 4 unearned runs

TUNE-UP TIME: C Omar Narváez joined the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment on Thursday...He is 1-for-4 in 2 games with 2 walks, 2 RBI, and 2 runs scored...Narváez played a scheduled 5 innings on Thursday and 7 frames on Saturday...The 31-year-old landed on the Mets' 10-day injured list on April 7 (retro 4/6) with a left calf strain...Narváez was transferred to the 60-day IL on May 4...In 5 games with New York, the Maraçay, Venezuela native was 4-for-14 with the bat (.286), adding a pair of RBI...Narváez has appeared in 605 Major League games, slashing .258/.343/.385 and a .728 OPS with the Mets, Milwaukee Brewers, Seattle Mariners, and Chicago White Sox...He was named a National League All-Star with Milwaukee in 2021...Narváez last played on Coney Island with the Hudson Valley Renegades in 2013, when both were members of the New York-Penn League...He was 1-for-8 with 3 strikeouts in 2 games. strikeouts in 2 games.

BIG STU: RHP Tyler Stuart has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 14.2 innings with 6.1 spotless frames in game one at Hudson Valley last Sunday...Stuart punched out 8 batters for his first pro win and would lead the SAL in ERA (1.13) by more than a full run over Hickory's RHP Josh Stephan (2.17) if he had enough innings to qualify...Stuart would also be 3rd in the league in batting average against (.197) and 4th in WHIP (1.13)... Analytically, the right-hander is also among the SAL's best.

GREAT SCOTT!: RHP **Christian Scott** set a new career-high with 8 strikeouts in his first win of year on Saturday night vs. Winston-Salem...The right-hander hurled 5 innings of 1-hit shutout ball...Over his last 2 starts dating back to Game 2 of last Sunday's twinbill in Hudson Valley, Scott has not allowed a run on 2 hits over 9 innings...The right-hander has not issued a walk and punched out 10 batters in that span.

PITCHABILITY: The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 10 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 14 earned runs (20 total) on 57 hits through the last 87.2 innings...That is good for a 1.44 ERA...Cyclones' pitching has walked 35 and struck out 108 in that span...Brooklyn's team ERA during the stretch is the bet by a South Atlantic League club since that date...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 49-20, over the 10-game stretch...Brooklyn is 8-2 during that span...On the year, the Cyclones have the only sub-3 ERA and lead the SAL in that category (3.92)...Hudson Valley (4.01) is 2nd.

BULL-PEN ON PARADE: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.31) in the entire South Atlantic League...Wilmington (3.54) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and at the High-A level...The 3.28 ERA is 6th best in all of Minor League Baseball...Double-A Richmond holds the best mark (2.83).

THRILL OF THE 'CHASE': After a bumpy month of April, INF Chase Estep HRILL OF THE 'CHASE': After a bumpy month of April, INF Chase Estep has picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...Entering Sunday, former Kentucky Wildcat has an 9-game hitting streak stretching back to May 14 at Wilmington...Estep is hitting .355 (11-31) with 6 runs scored, 4 doubles, 2 triples, and 7 RBI with a 1.025 OPS...In his last 16 games played dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old is slashing .327/.383/.564 with a .947 OPS...Estep has accumulated 10 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, a home run, and 10 RBI in 60 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 151 wRC+...Estep has garnered at least one knock in 13 of those 15 games...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21.

RAMÍ ROCKETS: OF Alex Ramírez has reached base safely in 9-straight games since May 18...In that time, the 20-year-old is slashing .303/.410/.515 with a .926 OPS...Ramírez has 4 runs scored, 4 doubles, a home run, 6 RBI, and 6 walks in those contests...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in hits (102), doubles (25),

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game set against the White Sox High-A affiliate... The Dash posses 9 of Chicago's top 30 prospects per Baseball America...RHP Norge Vera (8), RHP Jonathan Cannon (11), RHP Kohl Simas (13), RHP Jared Kelley (14), OF Wilfred Veras (17), INF Wes Kath (18), OF Terrell Tatum (24), INF Loidel Chapellí (26), and RHP Andrew Dalquist (28) are featured...The Cyclones went dropped 5-of-6 to Winston-Salem in their first meeting at Truist Stadium from April 11-16...In last year's meeting at Maimonides Park, Brooklyn split the 6-game set from August 2-7.

IN THE 'PALM' OF HIS HAND: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Sunday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (177), at-bats (582), plate appearances (696), runs scored (92), walks (94), and stolen bases (44)... Palmer passed INF Ronny Mauricio '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) on Tuesday and is 5 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie native is 2nd all-time in total bases (188), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 6th in hits (110).

WALK (OFF) ON THE WILD SIDE: 1B José Mena's game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on Friday provided Brooklyn its 4th walk-off win of 2023...1B Chase Estep delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF Alex Ramírez registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF Omar De Los Santos provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign.

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP Jeffrey Colón matched his team season-high with 6.2 innings of 2-run ball in a no-decision on Friday night...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 2 home starts, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

CYCLONE SHUFFLE: Brooklyn made a series of roster moves prior to Saturday's affair...RHP Brendan Hardy rejoined the squad from Class-A St. Lucie, while LHP Daniel Juárez and RHP Kolby Kubichek were transferred to Double-A Binghamton...In 17 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez yielded only 2 unearned runs in 20.0 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 25 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Hardy made 17 relief appearances with Brooklyn in 2022, tallying a 1-0 record and a 3.48 ERA (8 ER in 20.2 IP)...Kubichek has garnered a 6.48 ERA (6 ER in 8.1 IP) and 1 save in 6 relief outings over 2 separate stints on Coney Island.

OMAR ON THE RUN: In addition to his 16 stolen bases in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 86 stolen bases in that span, which tied for 5th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (95), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (93), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (93), Aberdeeri or **Luis Valdez** (87), Malinis aliminal NF **Nasim Núñez** (93), and Mariners prospect OF **Jonatan Clasé** (88) and have nabbed more...De Los Santos has also snagged 49 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 37...Omar is already 16 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF Alex Ramírez (2/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (5/9)...INF William Lugo (24/26) and RHP Christian Scott (28/26) also appears on both lists...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

SCORELESS STUART: Tyler enters Saturday's start on an 14.2 inning scoreless streak...That is the longest by a Cyclones starter in 2023...Stuart last yielded a run on May 2 vs. Aberdeen on a 2-out RBI double by 3B Isaac De León in the top of the 4th.

NEW ROLE: Despite primarily serving as a relief pitcher in college, Stuart is expected to make his 9th professional start on Saturday...In those outings, he has no record and a 1.31 ERA (5 ER in 34.1 IP), adding 47 strikeouts...The Kankakee, III. native made only 4 starts throughout his collegiate tenure, all coming in his final season during 2022.

SOARING EAGLE: Stuart was selected by the Mets in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi...Was a 4th-year sophomore at Southern Miss in 2022 after redshirting as a true freshman and missing his sophomore campaign due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Accumulated a 4-0 record with a 3.38 ERA (15 ER in 40.0 IP) and 1 save in 22 outings (4 starts)...Whiffed 38 and walked
