JUMBO SHRIMP STRUGGLE IN 12-5 LOSS

The Jumbo Shrimp made four errors in a sloppy 12-5 loss on Friday to the Knights. Joe Mack started the scoring with a solo home run in the second. However, Charlotte scored twice in the second and once in the third to gain the lead. Jacksonville plated three in the fourth, only for the Knights to score four times in the bottom of the fourth to make it 7-4. A Kemp Alderman homer in the sixth cut things to 7-5, but Charlotte plated one in the bottom of the sixth and four in the seventh to set the margin at 12-5. The 12 runs allowed for Jacksonville were the club's most this season.

MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 280 this season not only lead the entire level, but they rank eighth in all of Minor League Baseball. Of the top 22 MiLB teams in steals, only two are Triple-A or Double-A teams (Jacksonville & Nashville, 275, 9th), The Jumbo Shrimp's 280 steals are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

FORMULA ONE

With a 27-14 (.659) record in one-run games, Jacksonville is one behind Indianapolis for the most one-run victories in Triple-A, and fourth among the 120 MiLB teams. The 27 one-run triumphs are the most for the Jumbo Shrimp since they went 27-18 in one-run games during the 2021 campaign. The last time a Jacksonville club had more than 27 one-run wins in a season was 2014, when the Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp are 51-31 (.622) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 63.8 percent of their 80 victories have come by those slim margins.

FOR IT'S ONE, TWO, THREE STRIKES, YOU'RE OUT

The Jumbo Shrimp have recorded double-digit strikeouts in 17 of the 29 games the club has played since August 5. During this stretch, Jacksonville has racked up 292 punchouts (10.1 per game), the second-most in Triple-A. Eleven of the club's top 25 strikeout games this season have come in the last 29 games.

SNOW WHITE

Left-hander Thomas White, MLB Pipeline's No. 21 prospect, will make his Triple-A debut in a start Saturday at Charlotte. The 20-year-old has made 19 starts this season between High-A Beloit and Double-A Pensacola, going a combined 4-3 with a 2.13 ERA. Over 80.1 innings between the two levels, White yielded only 52 hits (5.8 H/9), two home runs with 41 walks (4.6 BB/9) against 128 strikeouts (14.3 K/9).

AHOY, EIGHTY!

At 80-56 (.588), Jacksonville's 80 wins are tied with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and Lehigh Valley for the most in Triple-A. Over the last nine seasons (2015-present). Jacksonville has hit at least 80 wins only once, when they went 80-69 (.537) in 2022. The last time the club won more than 80 games in a season was 2014, when they registered a 81-59 (.579) record. Jacksonville's .588 winning percentage is their best since the 2006 Suns finished the campaign 86-54 (.614).

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

While the club has made 116 errors, the fifth-most in Triple-A, Jacksonville's rangy defense has helped the club yield the fewest hits and second-fewest runs in Triple-A this season. The Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A in defensive efficiency, which simply measures how many batted balls put into play that are turned into outs, at .716. Secondplace Durham (.710) closer to fifth-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (.705) than the Bulls are to Jacksonville.

YOUTH IS SERVED

Among position players on the club's active roster, only three Jumbo Shrimp (Jacob Berry, Deyvison De Los Santos and Joe Mack) have played in more than half of Jacksonville's 136 games thus far in 2025. The other nine players have combined for a total of just 139 games in Triple-A this season. Eight of those nine players have been called up from Double-A Pensacola since August 2, and none of those eight have tallied more than 25 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp.

SHRIMP BITES

With one more victory over Charlotte, Jacksonville will earn a series win - the Shrimp are 0-2-1 in their last three sets.

ABOUT THOMAS

- -A native of Rowley, Mass., White burst onto the national scene in middle school. When he was in eighth grade and only 14 years old, his fastball was clocked at 91 miles per hour, leading *Prep Baseball Report* to rank him as the top player nationally in the 2023 class when he was a high school freshman.
- -White had committed to Vanderbilt for college, but was selected in the supplemental first round (35th overall) by the Miami Marlins in 2023. He signed with Miami for an over-slot \$4.1 million.
- -In MLB Pipeline's midseason 2025 prospect rankings, White is ranked as the No. 1 Marlins prospect and No. 21 prospect in all of baseball. He is ranked as the third-best pitching prospect behind Bubba Chandler of Pittsburgh and Andrew Painter of Philadelphia.
- -White won Gatorade Player of the Year in the state of Massachusetts twice while at Phillips Academy Andover (Andover, Mass.) in high school. He went 6-1 with a 0.21 ERA as a junior. As a senior, he was 5-2 with a 1.66 ERA and 95 strikeouts with just 10 hits allowed over 42 innings pitched.
- -White has pitched in the Futures Game in both 2024 and 2025.

2025 SEASON

- -White began the season with High-A Beloit before earning a promotion to Double-A Pensacola on June 17. He was promoted on September 2 to Triple-A Jacksonville.
- -With the Blue Wahoos, White struck out a career-high 14 the second-most in Pensacola club history, including a run of 13 strikeouts over 14 hitters. According to the Elias Sports Bureau, a strikeout span of 13 across 14 batters -- in White's case, eight in a row, a single, followed by five more K's -- has never been recorded during the Expansion Era in the major leagues (since at least 1961).
- -With both Beloit and Pensacola, opposing left-handed hitters slashed .157/.272/.200/.472 against White in 79 plate appearances. Right-handed hitters batted .187/.298/.242/.540 against him in 252 plate appearances.

2024 SEASON

-In his first full season, White posted a 2.81 ERA across two Class A levels (Single-A Jupiter and High-A Beloit) and struck out nearly 30% of batters faced. He was named the Midwest League's Top MLB Prospect and earned post-season All-Star honors. He also received the organization's Pitcher of the Year and High-A MVP awards.
