Looking Back

Reading fell 7-3 last night. Carlos De La Cruz homered in the third, but Somerset responded with an Austin Wells grand slam. It was the second grand slam Reading allowed this season. The Patriots tacked on three insurance runs in the eighth to secure the win.

Power Outage Restored

Carlos De La Cruz homered last night for the first time since June 18, snapping a 12-game homerless drought. His previous long homerless streak this season was eight games. De La Cruz was just two-for-22 from June 28 to July 3, but has responded by going four-for-six the last two games.

Collecting Accolades

R-Phils releiver Carlos Francisco was named Phillies Minor League Pitcher of the Month of June. With Jersey Shore in June, he had a 0.93 ERA and was four-for-four in save oppurtnities. Overall, Francisco struck out 15-of-40 batters he faced and walked just one, with a .205 opponents batting average. He led the South Atlantic League with four saves and was fifth with a 0.62 WHIP. Francisco was promoted to Reading on June 29.

Wonderful Wilson

Ethan Wilson is turning in the best season of his professional career. His .272 average sits 37 points higher than his .235 mark from 2022. Wilson is five-for-eight against Somerset, with a double and two runs scored. This comes after a brief 0-for-11 spell against Richmond.

Road Warriors

Reading has been vastly better on the road this season, then compared to at home. The R-Phils road winning percentage is .457 and it's just .341 at home. Reading is scoring over half a run more per game on the road and also has 20 more stolen bases in road contests. But, at home Reading's hit 56 home runs compared to 29 on the road.

Around the Organization

The Phillies won over the Rays 8-4 last night to clinch just the second series victory for a road team in Tampa. The Phillies have also won 11-straight road games. Lehigh Valley was shut out 14-0 at Scranton last night as Kody Clemens doubled. Jersey Shore fell 9-2 to Hudson Valley as Marcus Lee Sang had two hits. Clearwater lost 6-5 to Palm Beach as Justin Crawford hit his first professional home run.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 6, 2005: At Reading, Cole Hamels makes his long-anticipated Baseballtown debut against Akron. Hamels struggles in the 1st inning (WP, R, E, HB, BB), but settles down to finish with five hits, three runs (two earned) and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings. He gives up the first home run of his pro career to Brad Snyder in the 6th...also, Charlie Wagner receives his World Series ring at a pre-game ceremony.

'Sup Somerset

This is the second series of the season between Somerset and Reading, with the first being a split in North Jersey. Somerset won the first half title and is 5-3 in the second half. Last week, the Patriots took four-of-six at Bowie, and after this week, they'll head to the break and then play nine-straight on the road, with three at Binghamton and then six at Hartford.

Patriot Pitcher

Chase Hampton is making his fourth start of the season for Somerset. He was promoted to double-A on June 15 after posting a 2.68 ERA over nine starts with high-A Hudson Valley. He has a 4.15 ERA with 16 strikeouts over 17.1 innings so far with the Patriots. He went 5.2 innings at Bowie on July 1, getting roughed up for five runs on eight hits. The 21-year-old was drafted by the Yankees in the sixth round in 2022 out of Kilgore High School in Texas. He didn't pitch professionally in 2022 and made his double-A debut after just nine pro starts.

Phillies Number Four Prosepct. Started season on injured list.McGarry has been a prospect since his high school days, when he was a late-round pick of the Rangers before honoring his commitment to Virginia. With the Cavaliers, he showed off his premium arm strength as well as a lack of familiarity with the strike zone, making him an intriguing, yet enigmatic college arm in 2021. The Phillies thought McGarry's stuff was worth taking in the fifth round, and he pitched his way from High-A to Triple-A in his first full season of pro ball. If you're just evaluating pure stuff, McGarry could be considered one of the better pitching prospects in the game. He's flirted with 100 mph in the past and was up to 99 mph at the upper levels in 2022, averaging over 95 mph. It's an elite pitch not just because of velocity, but because of his vertical approach angle as well. His mid-80s slider can be plus at times, missing a ton of bats, and he fools hitters with an upper-70s curve too. He doesn't throw his changeup nearly as much as the breaking stuff, but it has characteristics of a plus pitch. He added a hard cutter at the end of last year to give him a potential five-pitch mix. How often McGarry can land his elite-level stuff in the strike zone will determine exactly what he can be in the big leagues. A 13.9 K/9 rate to start off his pro career shows he can fool pro hitters, but even with some improvements since joining the Phillies, he's walked 5.4 per nine entering 2023. There's hope that as he adds mass to his loose 6-foot-2 frame, he can keep refining his delivery and throw enough strikes to start, a role he'll continue for now unless there's a need as a reliever in Philadelphia.
