**PAPILLION, NEB.** – The Omaha Storm Chasers took the series lead two games to one with a 6-5 win against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp Thursday at Werner Park.

- Omaha got the scoring going in the bottom of the 1st inning as **Nick Loftin** grounded out into a double play but was able to bring home **John Rave** for a 1-0 Chasers lead after he got on base off of a single to right field.
- The Jumbo Shrimp answered quickly and took the lead right back as they put four runs on the board in the 2nd inning ... a **Nate Eaton** fielding error plated one, a single that scored a second run and a double drove in two more for a 4-1 Jacksonville lead in the 2nd.
- Omaha starting pitcher **Luis Cessa** worked two outs into the 4th inning and struck out four, allowing four runs (two earned) on six hits before left-handed reliever **Anthony Veneziano** relieved for Cessa.
- The Chasers added two more runs in the 4th and 5th innings as **Devin Mann** singled to right and plated Loftin ... The following inning, **Tyler Gentry** smashed his second home run of the season to left field and cut the deficit down to 4-3, still in favor of the Jumbo Shrimp.
- Veneziano took the mound in the 4th inning and struck out two batters, allowing just one hit in 2.1 scoreless innings, before **Colin Selby** took the reins in the top of the 7th inning ... Omaha's pitching staff held Jacksonville in check after the four-run 2nd inning, keeping the Jumbo Shrimp for te next five innings.
- Omaha knocked in two more runs down the stretch as **Cam Devaney** hit a soft bunt and was able to cross home Eaton in the bottom of the 7th inning ... two at-bats later, Rave singled to bring home Gentry for a 5-4 Chaser lead.
- Selby pitched 1.1 innings on two hits with no strikeouts before he handed the duties to **Evan Sisk** in the top of the 8th inning ... Sisk allowed the game-tying run to score in the 8th on a sacrifice fly, a run charged to Selby, but the Storm Chasers were able to charge ahead in the bottom half.
- Omaha took a 6-5 lead in the bottom half, as **Drew Waters** stole for home on bizarre play where Eaton and was called as ball three, but Jacksonville's catcher threw to first base to leave home plate open and Waters crossed home for the go-ahead run.
- Major League rehabber **Carlos Hernández** closed the game for the Chasers and earned his first save of the year with a scoreless 9th inning.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha won its 7th one-run game of the season yesterday, topping Jacksonville 6-5 ... the Storm Chasers are now 7-5 in games decided by just one run.

- The Chasers have won six of their last seven games ... five of those six runs have been decided by a save-worthy margin, with **Will Klein** and **Walter Pennington** picking up saves in the last 7 games, plus Carlos Hernández last night.
- 10 of the Chasers' 12 losses this season have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (a save situation) ... the Storm Chasers have only lost one game by more than 4 runs: a 9-1 loss on April 18 at Nashville ... In 5 of the 10 games that Omaha has lost by 3 or fewer runs, the Chasers have at the tying run either at the plate or on base.
- The Storm Chasers have not allowed more than 9 runs in a game this season ... of the 20-team International League, only Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and Omaha have yet to allow a double-digit run total, but SWB has 5 games of 9+ runs ... 16 of 20 IL teams have allowed 10 or more runs at least 3 times.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 198 to 153 this season, a +45 run differential.

- A +44 run differential ranks as the 2nd-best in the International League and is 3rd in Triple-A ... Oklahoma City leads the Triple-A lead at a +68 run differential.

#### GETTING OFFENSIVE

Omaha has been one of the top hitting teams in the International League in the month of May, with a 7-2 record so far this month.

- Omaha is tied for the league lead this month in total bases (141) and doubles (24), while the Chasers rank 2nd in May in runs scored (58) and hits (80) ... 13 stolen bases are tied for 2nd in the IL.
- Overall in 2024, Omaha's 198 runs scored rank 4th in the International League and 10th in Triple-A, with 6 of the 10 Pacific Coast League teams ahead of the Chasers.

#### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.

- The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .207 average (117-for-565), which is the 2nd-best mark among Triple-A teams, while the .000 opposing OPS also ranks second and a 3.89 ERA against the Omaha bullpen is the 3rd-best in Triple-A.
- With 30 strikeouts and just 3 walks, **Walter Pennington** boasts a Triple-A best 10.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min 20.0 IP) ... his 37.5% strikeout rate (30 K in 80 TBF) is 3rd in Triple-A (also min. 20.0 IP).
- Dan Altavilla** has recorded six consecutive scoreless games ... **Evan Sisk** has five straight with 9 strikeouts in his last 5.1 innings (16 outs), while **Sam Long** and **Carlos Hernández** have 3 straight scoreless appearances.
- John McMillon**'s slider has a 56.7 whiff % (17 whiffs on 30 swings), the best whiff% of any individual pitch on Omaha's staff (min. 25 pitches thrown with a pitch).

### LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, MAY 4 @ IOWA

Made his first start with Omaha since being optioned and held the Cubs to two unearned runs over 5.0 innings ... an error and pair of walks led to a sacrifice fly in the 1st inning, then he retired 11 of 12 batters from the sac fly through the end of the 4th inning, with 1-2-3 2nd and 4th innings ... two singles and an error led to another run scoring in the 5th ... 6 strikeouts is his 2nd-most in a game this year.

### 2024 HIGHLIGHT
